1 To the chief Musician. On stringed instruments. A Psalm of David. When I call, answer me, O God of my righteousness: in pressure thou hast enlarged me; be gracious unto me, and hear my prayer. **2** Ye sons of men, till when is my glory to be put to shame? How long will ye love vanity, will ye seek after a lie? Selah. **3** But know that Jehovah hath set apart the pious man for himself: Jehovah will hear when I call unto him. **4** Be moved with anger, and sin not; meditate in your own hearts upon your bed, and be still. Selah. **5** Offer sacrifices of righteousness, and confide in Jehovah.

6 Many say, Who shall cause us to see good? Lift up upon us the light of thy countenance, O Jehovah. **7** Thou hast put joy in my heart, more than in the time that their corn and their new wine was in abundance. **8** In peace will I both lay me down and sleep; for thou, Jehovah, alone makest me to dwell in safety.
