Selah.

5 For thou, O God, hast heard my vows; thou hast given me the inheritance of those that fear thy name. **6** Thou wilt add days to the days of the king: his years shall be as many generations. **7** He shall abide before God for ever: bestow loving-kindness and truth, that they may preserve him. **8** So will I sing forth thy name for ever, performing my vows from day to day.
