

# 1. Chronicles 21

1 And Satan<sup>H7854</sup> stood up<sup>H5975</sup> against Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and provoked<sup>H5496</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> to number<sup>H4487</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 2 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup> and to the rulers<sup>H8269</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, number<sup>H5608</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from Beersheba<sup>H884</sup> even to Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, and bring<sup>H935</sup> the number<sup>H4557</sup> of them to me, that I may know<sup>H3045</sup> it. 3 And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> answered<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> make his people<sup>H5971</sup> an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> times<sup>H6471</sup> so many more<sup>H3254</sup> as they<sup>H1992</sup> be: but, my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, are they not all my lord's<sup>H113</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup>? why then doth my lord<sup>H113</sup> require<sup>H1245</sup> this thing? why will he be a cause of trespass<sup>H819</sup> to Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? 4 Nevertheless the king's<sup>H4428</sup> word<sup>H1697</sup> prevailed<sup>H2388</sup> against Joab<sup>H3097</sup>. Wherefore Joab<sup>H3097</sup> departed<sup>H3318</sup>, and went<sup>H1980</sup> throughout all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 5 And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> the sum<sup>H4557</sup> of the number<sup>H4662</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>. And all they of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> were a thousand<sup>H505</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> and an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> that drew<sup>H8025</sup> sword<sup>H2719</sup>: and Judah<sup>H3063</sup> was four<sup>H702</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> threescore and ten<sup>H7657</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> that drew<sup>H8025</sup> sword<sup>H2719</sup>. 6 But Levi<sup>H3878</sup> and Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup> counted<sup>H6485</sup> he not among<sup>H8432</sup> them: for the king's<sup>H4428</sup> word<sup>H1697</sup> was abominable<sup>H8581</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup>.

7 And God<sup>H430</sup> was displeased<sup>H3415 H5869</sup> with this thing<sup>H1697</sup>; therefore he smote<sup>H5221</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 8 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup>, I have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> greatly<sup>H3966</sup>, because I have done<sup>H6213</sup> this thing<sup>H1697</sup>: but now, I beseech thee, do away<sup>H5674</sup> the iniquity<sup>H5771</sup> of thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>, for I have done very<sup>H3966</sup> foolishly<sup>H5528</sup>. 9 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, David's<sup>H1732</sup> seer<sup>H2374</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 10 Go<sup>H3212</sup> and tell<sup>H1696</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, I offer<sup>H5186</sup> thee three<sup>H7969</sup> things: choose<sup>H977</sup> thee one<sup>H259</sup> of them<sup>H2007</sup>, that I may do<sup>H6213</sup> it unto thee. 11 So Gad<sup>H1410</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Choose<sup>H6901</sup> thee<sup>3</sup>. 12 Either three<sup>H7969</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> famine<sup>H7458</sup>; or three<sup>H7969</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup> to be destroyed<sup>H5595</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thy foes<sup>H6862</sup>, while that the sword<sup>H2719</sup> of thine enemies<sup>H341</sup> overtaketh<sup>H5381</sup> thee; or<sup>H518</sup> else three<sup>H7969</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> the sword<sup>H2719</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, even the pestilence<sup>H1698</sup>, in the land<sup>H776</sup>, and the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> destroying<sup>H7843</sup> throughout all the coasts<sup>H1366</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. Now therefore advise<sup>H7200</sup> thyself what word<sup>H1697</sup> I shall bring again<sup>H7725</sup> to him that sent<sup>H7971</sup> me. 13 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, I am in a great<sup>H3966</sup> strait<sup>H6887</sup>: let me fall<sup>H5307</sup> now into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, for very<sup>H3966</sup> great<sup>H7227</sup> are his mercies<sup>H7356</sup>: but let me not fall<sup>H5307</sup> into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>. 14 So the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H5414</sup> pestilence<sup>H1698</sup> upon Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: and there fell<sup>H5307</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> seventy<sup>H7657</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>. 15 And God<sup>H430</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> an angel<sup>H4397</sup> unto Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> to destroy<sup>H7843</sup> it: and as he was destroying<sup>H7843</sup>, the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> beheld<sup>H7200</sup>, and he repented<sup>H5162</sup> him of the evil<sup>H7451</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> to the angel<sup>H4397</sup> that destroyed<sup>H7843</sup>, It is enough<sup>H7227</sup>, stay<sup>H7503</sup> now thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. And the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> stood<sup>H5975</sup> by the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup> of Ornan<sup>H771</sup> the Jebusite<sup>H2983</sup>. 16 And David<sup>H1732</sup> lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> his eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, and saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> stand<sup>H5975</sup> between the earth<sup>H776</sup> and the heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, having a drawn<sup>H8025</sup> sword<sup>H2719</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup> stretched out<sup>H5186</sup> over Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. Then David<sup>H1732</sup> and the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Israel, who were clothed<sup>H3680</sup> in sackcloth<sup>H8242</sup>, fell<sup>H5307</sup> upon their faces<sup>H6440</sup>. 17 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup>, Is it not I that commanded<sup>H559</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> to be numbered<sup>H4487</sup>? even I it is that have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> and done evil<sup>H7489</sup> indeed<sup>H7489</sup>; but as for these sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, what have they done<sup>H6213</sup>? let thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, I pray thee, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> my God<sup>H430</sup>, be on me, and on my father's<sup>H1</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>; but not on thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, that they should be plagued<sup>H4046</sup>.

18 Then the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H559</sup> Gad<sup>H1410</sup> to say<sup>H559</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, that David<sup>H1732</sup> should go up<sup>H5927</sup>, and set up<sup>H6965</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup> of Ornan<sup>H771</sup> the Jebusite<sup>H2983</sup>. 19 And David<sup>H1732</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> at the saying<sup>H1697</sup> of Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, which he spake<sup>H1696</sup> in the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 20 And Ornan<sup>H771</sup> turned back<sup>H7725</sup>, and saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup>; and his four<sup>H702</sup> sons<sup>H1121</sup> with him hid<sup>H2244</sup> themselves.

Now Ornan<sup>H771</sup> was threshing<sup>H1758</sup> wheat<sup>H2406 6</sup>. **21** And as David<sup>H1732</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Ornan<sup>H771</sup>, Ornan<sup>H771</sup> looked<sup>H5027</sup> and saw<sup>H7200</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, and went out<sup>H3318</sup> of the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup>, and bowed<sup>H7812</sup> himself to David<sup>H1732</sup> with his face<sup>H639</sup> to the ground<sup>H776</sup>. **22** Then David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Ornan<sup>H771</sup>, Grant<sup>H5414</sup> me the place<sup>H4725</sup> of this threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup>, that I may build<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> therein unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: thou shalt grant<sup>H5414</sup> it me for the full<sup>H4392</sup> price<sup>H3701</sup>: that the plague<sup>H4046</sup> may be stayed<sup>H6113</sup> from the people<sup>H5971 7</sup>. **23** And Ornan<sup>H771</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, Take<sup>H3947</sup> it to thee, and let my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> do<sup>H6213</sup> that which is good<sup>H2896</sup> in his eyes<sup>H5869</sup>: lo<sup>H7200</sup>, I give<sup>H5414</sup> thee the oxen<sup>H1241</sup> also for burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup>, and the threshing instruments<sup>H4173</sup> for wood<sup>H6086</sup>, and the wheat<sup>H2406</sup> for the meat offering<sup>H4503</sup>; I give<sup>H5414</sup> it all. **24** And king<sup>H4428</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Ornan<sup>H771</sup>, Nay; but I will verily<sup>H7069</sup> buy<sup>H7069</sup> it for the full<sup>H4392</sup> price<sup>H3701</sup>: for I will not take<sup>H5375</sup> that which is thine for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, nor offer<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> without cost<sup>H2600</sup>. **25** So David<sup>H1732</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> to Ornan<sup>H771</sup> for the place<sup>H4725</sup> six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> shekels<sup>H8255</sup> of gold<sup>H2091</sup> by weight<sup>H4948</sup>. **26** And David<sup>H1732</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> there an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and offered<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> and peace offerings<sup>H8002</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> upon the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; and he answered<sup>H6030</sup> him from heaven<sup>H8064</sup> by fire<sup>H784</sup> upon the altar<sup>H4196</sup> of burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>. **27** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H559</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup>; and he put up<sup>H7725</sup> his sword<sup>H2719</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup> into the sheath<sup>H5084</sup> thereof. **28** At that time<sup>H6256</sup> when David<sup>H1732</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had answered<sup>H6030</sup> him in the threshingfloor<sup>H1637</sup> of Ornan<sup>H771</sup> the Jebusite<sup>H2983</sup>, then he sacrificed<sup>H2076</sup> there. **29** For the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, which Moses<sup>H4872</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>, and the altar<sup>H4196</sup> of the burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>, were at that season<sup>H6256</sup> in the high place<sup>H1116</sup> at Gibeon<sup>H1391</sup>. **30** But David<sup>H1732</sup> could<sup>H3201</sup> not go<sup>H3212</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> it to enquire<sup>H1875</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>: for he was afraid<sup>H1204</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup> of the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
