## 1. Kings 2

1 Now the days<sup>H3117</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> drew nigh<sup>H7126</sup> that he should die<sup>H4191</sup>; and he charged<sup>H6680</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 I go<sup>H1980</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> of all the earth<sup>H776</sup>: be thou strong<sup>H2388</sup> therefore, and shew thyself a man<sup>H376</sup>; **3** And keep<sup>H8104</sup> the charge<sup>H4931</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, to walk<sup>H3212</sup> in his ways<sup>H1870</sup>, to keep<sup>H8104</sup> his statutes<sup>H2708</sup>, and his commandments<sup>H4687</sup>, and his judgments<sup>H4941</sup>, and his testimonies<sup>H5715</sup>, as it is written<sup>H3789</sup> in the law<sup>H8451</sup> of Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, that thou mayest prosper<sup>H7919</sup> in all that thou doest<sup>H6213</sup>, and whithersoever thou turnest<sup>H6437</sup> thyself:<sup>1</sup> 4 That the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> may continue<sup>H6965</sup> his word<sup>H1697</sup> which he spake<sup>H1696</sup> concerning me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, If thy children<sup>H1121</sup> take heed<sup>H8104</sup> to their way<sup>H1870</sup>, to walk<sup>H3212</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> me in truth<sup>H571</sup> with all their heart<sup>H3824</sup> and with all their soul<sup>H5315</sup>, there shall not fail<sup>H3772</sup> thee (said<sup>H559</sup> he) a man<sup>H376</sup> on the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478.2</sup> 5 Moreover thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> also what Joab<sup>H3097</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zeruiah<sup>H6870</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> to me, and what he did<sup>H6213</sup> to the two<sup>H8147</sup> captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the hosts<sup>H6635</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, unto Abner<sup>H74</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ner<sup>H5369</sup>, and unto Amasa<sup>H6021</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jether<sup>H3500</sup>, whom he slew<sup>H2026</sup>, and shed<sup>H7760</sup> the blood<sup>H1818</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> in peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and put<sup>H5414</sup> the blood<sup>H1818</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> upon his girdle<sup>H2290</sup> that was about his loins<sup>H4975</sup>, and in his shoes<sup>H5275</sup> that were on his feet<sup>H7272.3</sup> 6 Do<sup>H6213</sup> therefore according to thy wisdom<sup>H2451</sup>, and let not his hoar head<sup>H7872</sup> go down<sup>H3381</sup> to the grave<sup>H7585</sup> in peace<sup>H7965</sup>. **7** But shew<sup>H6213</sup> kindness<sup>H2617</sup> unto the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Barzillai<sup>H1271</sup> the Gileadite<sup>H1569</sup>, and let them be of those that eat<sup>H398</sup> at thy table<sup>H7979</sup>: for so they came<sup>H7126</sup> to me when I fled<sup>H1272</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of Absalom<sup>H53</sup> thy brother<sup>H251</sup>. 8 And. behold, thou hast with thee Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Gera<sup>H1617</sup>, a Benjamite<sup>H1145</sup> of Bahurim<sup>H980</sup>, which cursed<sup>H7043</sup> me with a grievous<sup>H4834</sup> curse<sup>H7045</sup> in the day<sup>H3117</sup> when I went<sup>H3212</sup> to Mahanaim<sup>H4266</sup>: but he came down<sup>H3381</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> me at Jordan<sup>H3383</sup>, and I sware<sup>H7650</sup> to him by the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, I will not put thee to death<sup>H4191</sup> with the sword<sup>H2719.4</sup> 9 Now therefore hold him not guiltless<sup>H5352</sup>: for thou art a wise<sup>H2450</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>, and knowest<sup>H3045</sup> what thou oughtest to do<sup>H6213</sup> unto him; but his hoar head<sup>H7872</sup> bring thou down<sup>H3381</sup> to the grave<sup>H7585</sup> with blood<sup>H1818</sup>. **10** So David<sup>H1732</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. **11** And the days<sup>H3117</sup> that David<sup>H1732</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup> were forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>: seven<sup>H7651</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> he in Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>, and thirty<sup>H7970</sup> and three<sup>H7969</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> he in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>.

12 Then sat<sup>H3427</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> upon the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup>; and his kingdom<sup>H4438</sup> was established<sup>H3559</sup> greatly<sup>H3966</sup>. 13 And Adonijah<sup>H138</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Haggith<sup>H2294</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Bathsheba<sup>H1339</sup> the mother<sup>H517</sup> of Solomon<sup>H8010</sup>. And she said<sup>H559</sup>, Comest<sup>H935</sup> thou peaceably<sup>H7965</sup>? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Peaceably<sup>H7965</sup>. **14** He said<sup>H559</sup> moreover, I have somewhat to say<sup>H1697</sup> unto thee. And she said<sup>H559</sup>, Say on<sup>H1696</sup>. **15** And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> that the kingdom<sup>H4410</sup> was mine, and that all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> set<sup>H7760</sup> their faces<sup>H6440</sup> on me, that I should reign<sup>H4427</sup>: howbeit the kingdom<sup>H4410</sup> is turned about<sup>H5437</sup>, and is become my brother's<sup>H251</sup>: for it was his from the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **16** And now I ask<sup>H7592</sup> one<sup>H259</sup> petition<sup>H7596</sup> of thee, deny<sup>H7725</sup> me<sup>H6440</sup> not. And she said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Say on<sup>H1696.5</sup> 17 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Speak<sup>H559</sup>, I pray thee, unto Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, (for he will not say<sup>H7725</sup> thee<sup>H6440</sup> nay<sup>H7725</sup>,) that he give<sup>H5414</sup> me Abishag<sup>H49</sup> the Shunammite<sup>H7767</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>. **18** And Bathsheba<sup>H1339</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Well<sup>H2896</sup>; I will speak<sup>H1696</sup> for thee unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>. **19** Bathsheba<sup>H1339</sup> therefore went<sup>H935</sup> unto king<sup>H4428</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup>, to speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto him for Adonijah<sup>H138</sup>. And the king<sup>H4428</sup> rose up<sup>H6965</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> her, and bowed<sup>H7812</sup> himself unto her, and sat down<sup>H3427</sup> on his throne<sup>H3678</sup>, and caused a seat<sup>H3678</sup> to be set<sup>H7760</sup> for the king's<sup>H4428</sup> mother<sup>H517</sup>; and she sat<sup>H3427</sup> on his right hand<sup>H3225</sup>. 20 Then she said<sup>H559</sup>, I desire<sup>H7592</sup> one<sup>H259</sup> small<sup>H6996</sup> petition<sup>H7596</sup> of thee; I pray thee, say<sup>H7725</sup> me<sup>H6440</sup> not nay<sup>H7725</sup>. And the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto her, Ask on<sup>H7592</sup>, my mother<sup>H517</sup>: for I will not say<sup>H7725</sup> thee<sup>H6440</sup> nay<sup>H7725</sup>. 21 And she said<sup>H559</sup>, Let Abishag<sup>H49</sup> the Shunammite<sup>H7767</sup> be given<sup>H5414</sup> to Adonijah<sup>H138</sup> thy brother<sup>H251</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>. **22** And king<sup>H4428</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> and said<sup>H559</sup> unto his mother<sup>H517</sup>, And why dost thou ask<sup>H7592</sup> Abishag<sup>H49</sup> the Shunammite<sup>H7767</sup> for Adonijah<sup>H138</sup>? ask<sup>H7592</sup> for him the kingdom<sup>H4410</sup> also; for he is mine elder<sup>H1419</sup> brother<sup>H251</sup>; even for him, and for Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and for Joab<sup>H3097</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zeruiah<sup>H6870</sup>.

**23** Then king<sup>H4428</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> sware<sup>H7650</sup> by the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> do<sup>H6213</sup> so to me, and more also<sup>H3254</sup>, if Adonijah<sup>H138</sup> have not spoken<sup>H1696</sup> this word<sup>H1697</sup> against his own life<sup>H5315</sup>. **24** Now therefore, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>, which hath established<sup>H3559</sup> me, and set<sup>H3427</sup> me on the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> my father<sup>H1</sup>, and who hath made<sup>H6213</sup> me an house<sup>H1004</sup>, as he promised<sup>H1696</sup>, Adonijah<sup>H138</sup> shall be put to death<sup>H4191</sup> this day<sup>H3117</sup>. **25** And king<sup>H4428</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoiada<sup>H3077</sup>; and he fell<sup>H6293</sup> upon him that he died<sup>H4191</sup>.

26 And unto Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, Get<sup>H3212</sup> thee to Anathoth<sup>H6068</sup>, unto thine own fields<sup>H7704</sup>; for thou art worthy<sup>H376</sup> of death<sup>H4194</sup>: but I will not at this time<sup>H3117</sup> put thee to death<sup>H4191</sup>, because thou barest<sup>H5375</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> my father<sup>H1</sup>, and because thou hast been afflicted<sup>H6031</sup> in all wherein my father<sup>H1</sup> was afflicted<sup>H6031,6</sup> 27 So Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> thrust out<sup>H1644</sup> Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> from being priest<sup>H3548</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; that he might fulfil<sup>H4390</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, which he spake<sup>H1696</sup> concerning the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Eli<sup>H5941</sup> in Shiloh<sup>H7887</sup>. **28** Then tidings<sup>H8052</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Joab<sup>H3097</sup>: for Joab<sup>H3097</sup> had turned<sup>H5186</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Adonijah<sup>H138</sup>, though he turned<sup>H5186</sup> not after<sup>H310</sup> Absalom<sup>H53</sup>. And Joab<sup>H3097</sup> fled<sup>H5127</sup> unto the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and caught hold<sup>H2388</sup> on the horns<sup>H7161</sup> of the altar<sup>H4196</sup>. 29 And it was told<sup>H5046</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> that Joab<sup>H3097</sup> was fled<sup>H5127</sup> unto the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; and, behold, he is by<sup>H681</sup> the altar<sup>H4196</sup>. Then Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoiada<sup>H3077</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, fall<sup>H6293</sup> upon him. **30** And Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, Come forth<sup>H3318</sup>. And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Nay; but I will die<sup>H4191</sup> here. And Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> brought<sup>H7725</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> word<sup>H1697</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Thus said<sup>H1696</sup> Joab<sup>H3097</sup>, and thus he answered<sup>H6030</sup> me. **31** And the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Do<sup>H6213</sup> as he hath said<sup>H1696</sup>, and fall<sup>H6293</sup> upon him, and bury<sup>H6912</sup> him; that thou mayest take away<sup>H5493</sup> the innocent<sup>H2600</sup> blood<sup>H1818</sup>, which Joab<sup>H3097</sup> shed<sup>H8210</sup>, from me, and from the house<sup>H1004</sup> of my father<sup>H1</sup>. **32** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall return<sup>H7725</sup> his blood<sup>H1818</sup> upon his own head<sup>H7218</sup>, who fell<sup>H6293</sup> upon two<sup>H8147</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> more righteous<sup>H6662</sup> and better<sup>H2896</sup> than he, and slew<sup>H2026</sup> them with the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, my father<sup>H1</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> not knowing<sup>H3045</sup> thereof, to wit, Abner<sup>H74</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ner<sup>H5369</sup>, captain<sup>H8269</sup> of the host<sup>H6635</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and Amasa<sup>H6021</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jether<sup>H3500</sup>, captain<sup>H8269</sup> of the host<sup>H6635</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. **33** Their blood<sup>H1818</sup> shall therefore return<sup>H7725</sup> upon the head<sup>H7218</sup> of Joab<sup>H3097</sup>, and upon the head<sup>H7218</sup> of his seed<sup>H2233</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>: but upon David<sup>H1732</sup>, and upon his seed<sup>H2233</sup>, and upon his house<sup>H1004</sup>, and upon his throne<sup>H3678</sup>, shall there be peace<sup>H7965</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup> from the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **34** So Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoiada<sup>H3077</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup>, and fell<sup>H6293</sup> upon him, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> him: and he was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in his own house<sup>H1004</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>.

35 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> put<sup>H5414</sup> Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoiada<sup>H3077</sup> in his room over the host<sup>H6635</sup>: and Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> did the king<sup>H4428</sup> put<sup>H5414</sup> in the room of Abiathar<sup>H54</sup>. **36** And the king<sup>H4428</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> and called<sup>H7121</sup> for Shimei<sup>H8096</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Build<sup>H1129</sup> thee an house<sup>H1004</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> there, and go not forth<sup>H3318</sup> thence any whither<sup>H575</sup>. **37** For it shall be, that on the day<sup>H3117</sup> thou goest out<sup>H3318</sup>, and passest over<sup>H5674</sup> the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Kidron<sup>H6939</sup>, thou shalt know<sup>H3045</sup> for certain<sup>H3045</sup> that thou shalt surely<sup>H4191</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>: thy blood<sup>H1818</sup> shall be upon thine own head<sup>H7218</sup>. **38** And Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>, The saying<sup>H1697</sup> is good<sup>H2896</sup>: as my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> hath said<sup>H1696</sup>, so will thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> do<sup>H6213</sup>. And Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>. **39** And it came to pass at the end<sup>H7093</sup> of three<sup>H7969</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>, that two<sup>H8147</sup> of the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> ran away<sup>H1272</sup> unto Achish<sup>H397</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> of Maachah<sup>H4601</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Gath<sup>H1661</sup>. And they told<sup>H5046</sup> Shimei<sup>H8096</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, thy servants<sup>H5650</sup> be in Gath<sup>H1661</sup>. **40** And Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and saddled<sup>H2280</sup> his ass<sup>H2543</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> to Gath<sup>H1661</sup> to Achish<sup>H397</sup> to seek<sup>H1245</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup>: and Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup>, and brought<sup>H935</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup> from Gath<sup>H1661</sup>. **41** And it was told<sup>H5046</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> that Shimei<sup>H8096</sup> had gone<sup>H1980</sup> from Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> to Gath<sup>H1661</sup>, and was come again<sup>H7725</sup>. **42** And the king<sup>H4428</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> and called<sup>H7121</sup> for Shimei<sup>H8096</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Did I not make thee to swear<sup>H7650</sup> by the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and protested<sup>H5749</sup> unto thee, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Know<sup>H3045</sup> for a certain<sup>H3045</sup>, on the day<sup>H3117</sup> thou goest out<sup>H3318</sup>, and walkest<sup>H1980</sup> abroad any whither<sup>H575</sup>, that thou shalt surely<sup>H4191</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>? and thou saidst<sup>H559</sup> unto me, The word<sup>H1697</sup> that I have heard<sup>H8085</sup> is good<sup>H2896</sup>. **43** Why then hast thou not kept<sup>H8104</sup> the oath<sup>H7621</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the commandment<sup>H4687</sup> that I have charged<sup>H6680</sup> thee with? 44 The king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> moreover to Shimei<sup>H8096</sup>, Thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> all the wickedness<sup>H7451</sup> which thine heart<sup>H3824</sup> is privy to<sup>H3045</sup>, that thou didst<sup>H6213</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup> my father<sup>H1</sup>: therefore the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall return<sup>H7725</sup> thy wickedness<sup>H7451</sup> upon thine own head<sup>H7218</sup>; **45** And king<sup>H4428</sup> Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> shall be blessed<sup>H1288</sup>, and the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> shall be established<sup>H3559</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup>. **46** So the king<sup>H4428</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> Benaiah<sup>H1141</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoiada<sup>H3077</sup>; which went out<sup>H3318</sup>, and fell<sup>H6293</sup> upon him, that he died<sup>H4191</sup>. And the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> was established<sup>H3559</sup> in the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Solomon<sup>H8010</sup>.
