

# 1. Samuel 15

1 Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> also said<sup>H559</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> me to anoint<sup>H4886</sup> thee to be king<sup>H4428</sup> over his people<sup>H5971</sup>, over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: now therefore hearken<sup>H8085</sup> thou unto the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the words<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 2 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, I remember<sup>H6485</sup> that which Amalek<sup>H6002</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> to Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, how he laid<sup>H7760</sup> wait for him in the way<sup>H1870</sup>, when he came up<sup>H5927</sup> from Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 3 Now go<sup>H3212</sup> and smite<sup>H5221</sup> Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>, and utterly destroy<sup>H2763</sup> all that they have, and spare<sup>H2550</sup> them not; but slay<sup>H4191</sup> both man<sup>H376</sup> and woman<sup>H802</sup>, infant<sup>H5768</sup> and suckling<sup>H3243</sup>, ox<sup>H7794</sup> and sheep<sup>H7716</sup>, camel<sup>H1581</sup> and ass<sup>H2543</sup>. 4 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> gathered<sup>H8085</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> together<sup>H8085</sup>, and numbered<sup>H6485</sup> them in Telaim<sup>H2923</sup>, two hundred<sup>H3967</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> footmen<sup>H7273</sup>, and ten<sup>H6235</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 5 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to a city<sup>H5892</sup> of Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>, and laid wait<sup>H7378</sup> <sup>H693</sup> in the valley<sup>H5158</sup>. 6 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the Kenites<sup>H7017</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, depart<sup>H5493</sup>, get you down<sup>H3381</sup> from among<sup>H8432</sup> the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup>, lest I destroy<sup>H622</sup> you with them: for ye shewed<sup>H6213</sup> kindness<sup>H2617</sup> to all the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, when they came up<sup>H5927</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. So the Kenites<sup>H7017</sup> departed<sup>H5493</sup> from among<sup>H8432</sup> the Amalekites<sup>H6003</sup>. 7 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup> from Havilah<sup>H2341</sup> until thou comest<sup>H935</sup> to Shur<sup>H7793</sup>, that is over against<sup>H6440</sup> Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 8 And he took<sup>H8610</sup> Agag<sup>H90</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup> alive<sup>H2416</sup>, and utterly destroyed<sup>H2763</sup> all the people<sup>H5971</sup> with the edge<sup>H6310</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup>. 9 But Saul<sup>H7586</sup> and the people<sup>H5971</sup> spared<sup>H2550</sup> Agag<sup>H90</sup>, and the best<sup>H4315</sup> of the sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, and of the oxen<sup>H1241</sup>, and of the fatlings<sup>H4932</sup>, and the lambs<sup>H3733</sup>, and all that was good<sup>H2896</sup>, and would<sup>H14</sup> not utterly destroy<sup>H2763</sup> them: but every thing<sup>H4399</sup> that was vile<sup>H5240</sup> and refuse<sup>H4549</sup>, that they destroyed utterly<sup>H2763</sup>. 2

10 Then came the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> unto Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 11 It repenteth<sup>H5162</sup> me that I have set up<sup>H4427</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> to be king<sup>H4428</sup>: for he is turned back<sup>H7725</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> me, and hath not performed<sup>H6965</sup> my commandments<sup>H1697</sup>. And it grieved<sup>H2734</sup> Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>; and he cried<sup>H2199</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> all night<sup>H3915</sup>. 12 And when Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> rose early<sup>H7925</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, it was told<sup>H5046</sup> Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Saul<sup>H7586</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Carmel<sup>H3760</sup>, and, behold, he set him up<sup>H5324</sup> a place<sup>H3027</sup>, and is gone about<sup>H5437</sup>, and passed on<sup>H5674</sup>, and gone down<sup>H3381</sup> to Gilgal<sup>H1537</sup>. 13 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Saul<sup>H7586</sup>: and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be thou of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: I have performed<sup>H6965</sup> the commandment<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 14 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, What meaneth then this bleating<sup>H6963</sup> of the sheep<sup>H6629</sup> in mine ears<sup>H241</sup>, and the lowing<sup>H6963</sup> of the oxen<sup>H1241</sup> which I hear<sup>H8085</sup>? 15 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, They have brought<sup>H935</sup> them from the Amalekites<sup>H6003</sup>: for the people<sup>H5971</sup> spared<sup>H2550</sup> the best<sup>H4315</sup> of the sheep<sup>H6629</sup> and of the oxen<sup>H1241</sup>, to sacrifice<sup>H2076</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>; and the rest<sup>H3498</sup> we have utterly destroyed<sup>H2763</sup>. 16 Then Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, Stay<sup>H7503</sup>, and I will tell<sup>H5046</sup> thee what the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath said<sup>H1696</sup> to me this night<sup>H3915</sup>. And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Say on<sup>H1696</sup>. 17 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, When thou wast little<sup>H6996</sup> in thine own sight<sup>H5869</sup>, wast thou not made the head<sup>H7218</sup> of the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> anointed<sup>H4886</sup> thee king<sup>H4428</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? 18 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> thee on a journey<sup>H1870</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> and utterly destroy<sup>H2763</sup> the sinners<sup>H2400</sup> the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup>, and fight<sup>H3898</sup> against them until they be consumed<sup>H3615</sup>. 19 Wherefore then didst thou not obey<sup>H8085</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, but didst fly<sup>H5860</sup> upon the spoil<sup>H7998</sup>, and didst<sup>H6213</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>? 20 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, Yea, I have obeyed<sup>H8085</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and have gone<sup>H3212</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> me, and have brought<sup>H935</sup> Agag<sup>H90</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>, and have utterly destroyed<sup>H2763</sup> the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup>. 21 But the people<sup>H5971</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> of the spoil<sup>H7998</sup>, sheep<sup>H6629</sup> and oxen<sup>H1241</sup>, the chief<sup>H7225</sup> of the things which should have been utterly destroyed<sup>H2764</sup>, to sacrifice<sup>H2076</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> in Gilgal<sup>H1537</sup>. 22 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Hath the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> as great delight<sup>H2656</sup> in burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> and sacrifices<sup>H2077</sup>, as in obeying<sup>H8085</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>? Behold, to obey<sup>H8085</sup> is better<sup>H2896</sup> than sacrifice<sup>H2077</sup>, and to hearken<sup>H7181</sup> than the fat<sup>H2459</sup> of rams<sup>H352</sup>. 23 For rebellion<sup>H4805</sup> is as the sin<sup>H2403</sup> of witchcraft<sup>H7081</sup>,

and stubbornness<sup>H6484</sup> is as iniquity<sup>H205</sup> and idolatry<sup>H8655</sup>. Because thou hast rejected<sup>H3988</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, he hath also rejected<sup>H3988</sup> thee from being king<sup>H4428</sup> 4.

**24** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, I have sinned<sup>H2398</sup>: for I have transgressed<sup>H5674</sup> the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and thy words<sup>H1697</sup>: because I feared<sup>H3372</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and obeyed<sup>H8085</sup> their voice<sup>H6963</sup>. **25** Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon<sup>H5375</sup> my sin<sup>H2403</sup>, and turn again<sup>H7725</sup> with me, that I may worship<sup>H7812</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **26** And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, I will not return<sup>H7725</sup> with thee: for thou hast rejected<sup>H3988</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath rejected<sup>H3988</sup> thee from being king<sup>H4428</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **27** And as Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> turned about<sup>H5437</sup> to go away<sup>H3212</sup>, he laid hold<sup>H2388</sup> upon the skirt<sup>H3671</sup> of his mantle<sup>H4598</sup>, and it rent<sup>H7167</sup>. **28** And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath rent<sup>H7167</sup> the kingdom<sup>H4468</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from thee this day<sup>H3117</sup>, and hath given<sup>H5414</sup> it to a neighbour<sup>H7453</sup> of thine, that is better<sup>H2896</sup> than thou. **29** And also the Strength<sup>H5331</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> will not lie<sup>H8266</sup> nor repent<sup>H5162</sup>: for he is not a man<sup>H120</sup>, that he should repent<sup>H5162</sup> 5. **30** Then he said<sup>H559</sup>, I have sinned<sup>H2398</sup>: yet honour<sup>H3513</sup> me now, I pray thee, before the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup>, and before Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and turn again<sup>H7725</sup> with me, that I may worship<sup>H7812</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>. **31** So Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> turned again<sup>H7725</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>; and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> worshipped<sup>H7812</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

**32** Then said<sup>H559</sup> Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, Bring ye hither<sup>H5066</sup> to me Agag<sup>H90</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of the Amalekites<sup>H6002</sup>. And Agag<sup>H90</sup> came<sup>H3212</sup> unto him delicately<sup>H4574</sup>. And Agag<sup>H90</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Surely<sup>H403</sup> the bitterness<sup>H4751</sup> of death<sup>H4194</sup> is past<sup>H5493</sup>. **33** And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, As thy sword<sup>H2719</sup> hath made women<sup>H802</sup> childless<sup>H7921</sup>, so shall thy mother<sup>H517</sup> be childless<sup>H7921</sup> among women<sup>H802</sup>. And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> hewed<sup>H8158</sup> Agag<sup>H90</sup> in pieces<sup>H8158</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in Gilgal<sup>H1537</sup>. **34** Then Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> to Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>; and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> to his house<sup>H1004</sup> to Gibeah<sup>H1390</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>. **35** And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> came no more<sup>H3254</sup> to see<sup>H7200</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> until the day<sup>H3117</sup> of his death<sup>H4194</sup>: nevertheless<sup>H3588</sup> Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> mourned<sup>H56</sup> for Saul<sup>H7586</sup>: and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> that he had made Saul<sup>H7586</sup> king<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.
