## 1. Samuel 18

**1** And it came to pass, when he had made an end<sup>H3615</sup> of speaking<sup>H1696</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, that the soul<sup>H5315</sup> of Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> was knit<sup>H7194</sup> with the soul<sup>H5315</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, and Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> loved<sup>H157</sup> him as his own soul<sup>H5315</sup>. **2** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> him that day<sup>H3117</sup>, and would let<sup>H5414</sup> him go no more home<sup>H7725</sup> to his father's<sup>H1</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>. **3** Then Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> and David<sup>H1732</sup> made<sup>H3772</sup> a covenant<sup>H1285</sup>, because he loved<sup>H160</sup> him as his own soul<sup>H5315</sup>. **4** And Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> stripped<sup>H6584</sup> himself of the robe<sup>H4598</sup> that was upon him, and gave<sup>H5414</sup> it to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and his garments<sup>H4055</sup>, even to his sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and to his bow<sup>H7198</sup>, and to his girdle<sup>H2289</sup>. **5** And David<sup>H1732</sup> went out<sup>H3318</sup> whithersoever Saul<sup>H7586</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> him, and behaved himself wisely<sup>H7919</sup>: and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> set<sup>H7760</sup> him over the men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup>, and he was accepted<sup>H3190</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of all the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and also in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup>.

**6** And it came to pass as they came<sup>H935</sup>, when David<sup>H1732</sup> was returned<sup>H7725</sup> from the slaughter<sup>H5221</sup> of the Philistine<sup>H6430</sup>, that the women<sup>H802</sup> came out<sup>H3318</sup> of all cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, singing<sup>H7891</sup> and dancing<sup>H4246</sup>, to meet<sup>H7125</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, with tabrets<sup>H8596</sup>, with joy<sup>H8057</sup>, and with instruments<sup>H7991</sup> of musick.<sup>23</sup> **7** And the women<sup>H802</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> one another as they played<sup>H7832</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Saul<sup>H7586</sup> hath slain<sup>H521</sup> his thousands<sup>H505</sup>, and David<sup>H1732</sup> his ten thousands<sup>H7233</sup>. **8** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> was very<sup>H3966</sup> wroth<sup>H2734</sup>, and the saying<sup>H1697</sup> displeased<sup>H3415</sup> <sup>H5869</sup> him; and he said<sup>H559</sup>, They have ascribed<sup>H5414</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup> ten thousands<sup>H7233</sup>, and to me they have ascribed<sup>H5414</sup> but thousands<sup>H505</sup>: and what can he have more but the kingdom<sup>H4410</sup>?<sup>4</sup> **9** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> eyed<sup>H5770</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> from that day<sup>H3117</sup> and forward<sup>H1973</sup>. **10** And it came to pass on the morrow<sup>H4283</sup>, that the evil<sup>H7451</sup> spirit<sup>H7307</sup> from God<sup>H430</sup> came<sup>H6743</sup> upon Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, and he prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup>: and David<sup>H1732</sup> played<sup>H5059</sup> with his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, as at other times<sup>H3117</sup>: and there was a javelin<sup>H2595</sup> in Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **11** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> cast<sup>H2904</sup> the javelin<sup>H2595</sup>; for he said<sup>H559</sup>, I will smite<sup>H521</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> even to the wall<sup>H7023</sup> with it. And David<sup>H1732</sup> avoided out<sup>H5437</sup> of his presence<sup>H6440</sup> twice<sup>H6471</sup>.

12 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> was afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of<sup>H6440</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, because the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was with him, and was departed<sup>H5493</sup> from Saul<sup>H7586</sup>. **13** Therefore Saul<sup>H7586</sup> removed<sup>H5493</sup> him from him, and made<sup>H7760</sup> him his captain<sup>H8269</sup> over a thousand<sup>H505</sup>; and he went out<sup>H3318</sup> and came in<sup>H935</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>. **14** And David<sup>H1732</sup> behaved himself wisely<sup>H7919</sup> in all his ways<sup>H1870</sup>; and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was with him.<sup>5</sup> 15 Wherefore when Saul<sup>H7586</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that he behaved<sup>H7919</sup> himself very<sup>H3966</sup> wisely<sup>H7919</sup>, he was afraid<sup>H1481</sup> of<sup>H6440</sup> him. **16** But all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup> loved<sup>H157</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, because he went out<sup>H3318</sup> and came in<sup>H935</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> them. **17** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>. Behold my elder<sup>H1419</sup> daughter<sup>H1323</sup> Merab<sup>H4764</sup>, her will I give<sup>H5414</sup> thee to wife<sup>H802</sup>: only be thou valiant<sup>H1121 H2428</sup> for me, and fight<sup>H3898</sup> the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> battles<sup>H4421</sup>. For Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Let not mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> be upon him, but let the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> be upon him.<sup>6</sup> 18 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, Who am I? and what is my life<sup>H2416</sup>, or my father's<sup>H1</sup> family<sup>H4940</sup> in Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, that I should be son in law<sup>H2860</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup>? **19** But it came to pass at the time<sup>H6256</sup> when Merab<sup>H4764</sup> Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> daughter<sup>H1323</sup> should have been given<sup>H5414</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, that she was given<sup>H5414</sup> unto Adriel<sup>H5741</sup> the Meholathite<sup>H4259</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>. 20 And Michal<sup>H4324</sup> Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> daughter<sup>H1323</sup> loved<sup>H157</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>: and they told<sup>H5046</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, and the thing<sup>H1697</sup> pleased<sup>H3474 H5869</sup> him.<sup>7</sup> 21 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, I will give<sup>H5414</sup> him her, that she may be a snare<sup>H4170</sup> to him, and that the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> may be against him. Wherefore Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, Thou shalt this day<sup>H3117</sup> be my son in law<sup>H2859</sup> in the one of the twain<sup>H8147</sup>. 22 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup>, saying, Commune<sup>H1696</sup> with David<sup>H1732</sup> secretly<sup>H3909</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, the king<sup>H4428</sup> hath delight<sup>H2654</sup> in thee, and all his servants<sup>H5650</sup> love<sup>H157</sup> thee: now therefore be the king's<sup>H4428</sup> son in law<sup>H2859</sup>. 23 And Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> those words<sup>H1697</sup> in the ears<sup>H241</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Seemeth<sup>H5869</sup> it to you a light<sup>H7043</sup> thing to be a king's<sup>H4428</sup> son in law<sup>H2859</sup>, seeing that I am a poor<sup>H7326</sup> man<sup>H376</sup>, and lightly esteemed<sup>H7034</sup>? **24** And the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup> told<sup>H5046</sup> him, saying<sup>H559</sup>, On this manner<sup>H1697</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>.<sup>8</sup> **25** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Thus shall ye say<sup>H559</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, The king<sup>H4428</sup> desireth<sup>H2656</sup> not any dowry<sup>H4119</sup>, but an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> foreskins<sup>H6190</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, to be avenged<sup>H5358</sup> of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> enemies<sup>H341</sup>. But Saul<sup>H7586</sup> thought<sup>H2803</sup> to make David<sup>H1732</sup> fall<sup>H5307</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. **26** And when his servants<sup>H5650</sup> told<sup>H5046</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> these words<sup>H1697</sup>, it pleased<sup>H3474 H1697 H5869</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> well to be the king's<sup>H4428</sup> son in law<sup>H2859</sup>: and the days<sup>H3117</sup> were not expired<sup>H4390</sup>.<sup>9</sup> **27** Wherefore David<sup>H1732</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup> and went<sup>H3212</sup>, he and his men<sup>H582</sup>, and slew<sup>H521</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> two hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>; and David<sup>H1732</sup> brought<sup>H935</sup> their foreskins<sup>H6190</sup>, and they gave them in full tale<sup>H4390</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup>, that he might be the king's<sup>H4428</sup> son in law<sup>H2859</sup>. And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> him Michal<sup>H4324</sup> his daughter<sup>H1323</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>. **28** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> and knew<sup>H3045</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was with David<sup>H1732</sup>, and that Michal<sup>H4324</sup> Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> daughter<sup>H1323</sup> loved<sup>H157</sup> him. **29** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> was yet the more<sup>H3254</sup> afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of<sup>H6440</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>; and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> became David's<sup>H1732</sup> enemy<sup>H341</sup> continually<sup>H3117</sup>. **30** Then the princes<sup>H6269</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> went forth<sup>H3318</sup>: and it came to pass, after<sup>H1767</sup> they went forth<sup>H3318</sup>, that David<sup>H1732</sup> behaved himself more wisely<sup>H7919</sup> than all the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>; so that his name<sup>H8034</sup> was much<sup>H3966</sup> set by<sup>H3365,10</sup>
