## 1. Samuel 23

**1** Then they told<sup>H5046</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> fight<sup>H3898</sup> against Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, and they rob<sup>H8154</sup> the threshingfloors<sup>H1637</sup>. **2** Therefore David<sup>H1732</sup> enquired<sup>H7592</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Shall I go<sup>H3212</sup> and smite<sup>H5221</sup> these Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>? And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, and smite<sup>H5221</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and save<sup>H3467</sup> Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>. **3** And David's<sup>H1732</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Behold, we be afraid<sup>H3373</sup> here in Judah<sup>H3063</sup>: how much more then if we come<sup>H3212</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup> against the armies<sup>H4634</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>? **4** Then David<sup>H1732</sup> enquired<sup>H7592</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> yet again<sup>H3254</sup>. And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> him and said<sup>H559</sup>, Arise<sup>H6965</sup>, go down<sup>H3381</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, for I will deliver<sup>H5414</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **5** So David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, and fought<sup>H3898</sup> with the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and brought away<sup>H5090</sup> their cattle<sup>H4735</sup>, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> them with a great<sup>H1419</sup> slaughter<sup>H4347</sup>. So David<sup>H1732</sup> saved<sup>H3467</sup> the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>. **6** And it came to pass, when Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahimelech<sup>H288</sup> fled<sup>H1272</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, that he came down<sup>H3381</sup> with an ephod<sup>H646</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>.

**7** And it was told<sup>H5046</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> that David<sup>H1732</sup> was come<sup>H935</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>. And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> hath delivered<sup>H5234</sup> him into mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>; for he is shut in<sup>H5462</sup>, by entering<sup>H935</sup> into a town<sup>H5892</sup> that hath gates<sup>H1817</sup> and bars<sup>H1280</sup>. **8** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> called<sup>H8085</sup> all the people<sup>H5971</sup> together<sup>H8085</sup> to war<sup>H4421</sup>, to go down<sup>H3381</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, to besiege<sup>H6696</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup>. **9** And David<sup>H1732</sup> knew<sup>H3045</sup> that Saul<sup>H7586</sup> secretly practised<sup>H2790</sup> mischief<sup>H7451</sup> against him; and he said<sup>H559</sup> to Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, Bring hither<sup>H5066</sup> the ephod<sup>H646</sup>. **10** Then said<sup>H559</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> hath certainly<sup>H8085</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> that Saul<sup>H7586</sup> secketh<sup>H1245</sup> to come<sup>H935</sup> to Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, to destroy<sup>H7843</sup> the city<sup>H5892</sup> for my sake. **11** Will the men<sup>H1167</sup> of Keilah<sup>H7084</sup> deliver me up<sup>H5462</sup> into his hand<sup>H3027</sup>? will Saul<sup>H7586</sup> come down<sup>H3381</sup>, as thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> hath heard<sup>H8085</sup>? O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3786</sup> thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>. And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, They will deliver thee up<sup>H5462</sup>. **13** Then David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup>, which were about six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967 H376</sup>, arose<sup>H6965</sup> and departed<sup>H3318</sup> out of Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>, and went<sup>H1980</sup> whithersoever<sup>H834</sup> they could go<sup>H1980</sup>. And it was told<sup>H5046</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> that David<sup>H1732</sup> was escaped<sup>H4422</sup> from Keilah<sup>H7084</sup>; and he forbare<sup>H2308</sup> to go forth<sup>H3318</sup>.

**14** And David<sup>H1732</sup> abode<sup>H3427</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> in strong holds<sup>H4679</sup>, and remained<sup>H3427</sup> in a mountain<sup>H2022</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Ziph<sup>H2128</sup>. And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> sought<sup>H1245</sup> him every day<sup>H3117</sup>, but God<sup>H430</sup> delivered<sup>H5414</sup> him not into his hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **15** And David<sup>H1732</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that Saul<sup>H7586</sup> was come out<sup>H3318</sup> to seek<sup>H1245</sup> his life<sup>H5315</sup>: and David<sup>H1732</sup> was in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Ziph<sup>H2128</sup> in a wood<sup>H2793</sup>. **16** And Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> Saul's<sup>H7586</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup> into the wood<sup>H2793</sup>, and strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> in God<sup>H430</sup>. **17** And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Fear<sup>H3372</sup> not: for the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup> my father<sup>H1</sup> shall not find<sup>H4672</sup> thee; and thou shalt be king<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and I shall be next<sup>H4932</sup> unto thee; and that also Saul<sup>H7586</sup> my father<sup>H1</sup> knoweth<sup>H3045</sup>. **18** And they two<sup>H8147</sup> made<sup>H3772</sup> a covenant<sup>H1285</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and David<sup>H1732</sup> abode<sup>H3427</sup> in the wood<sup>H2793</sup>, and Jonathan<sup>H3088</sup> went<sup>H1980</sup> to his house<sup>H1004</sup>.

**19** Then came up<sup>H5927</sup> the Ziphites<sup>H2130</sup> to Saul<sup>H7586</sup> to Gibeah<sup>H1390</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Doth not David<sup>H1732</sup> hide<sup>H5641</sup> himself with us in strong holds<sup>H4679</sup> in the wood<sup>H2793</sup>, in the hill<sup>H1389</sup> of Hachilah<sup>H2444</sup>, which is on the south<sup>H3225</sup> of Jeshimon<sup>H3452</sup>?<sup>23</sup> **20** Now therefore, O king<sup>H4428</sup>, come down<sup>H3381</sup> according to all the desire<sup>H185</sup> of thy soul<sup>H5315</sup> to come down<sup>H3381</sup>; and our part shall be to deliver<sup>H5462</sup> him into the king's<sup>H4428</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **21** And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be ye of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; for ye have compassion<sup>H2550</sup> on me. **22** Go<sup>H3212</sup>, I pray you, prepare<sup>H3559</sup> yet, and

know<sup>H3045</sup> and see<sup>H7200</sup> his place<sup>H4725</sup> where his haunt<sup>H7272</sup> is, and who hath seen<sup>H7200</sup> him there: for it is told<sup>H559</sup> me that he dealeth very<sup>H6191</sup> subtilly<sup>H6191</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 23 See<sup>H7200</sup> therefore, and take knowledge<sup>H3045</sup> of all the lurking places<sup>H4224</sup> where he hideth<sup>H2244</sup> himself, and come ye again<sup>H7725</sup> to me with the certainty<sup>H3559</sup>, and I will go<sup>H1980</sup> with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be<sup>H3426</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup>, that I will search<sup>H2664</sup> him out throughout all the thousands<sup>H505</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 24 And they arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> to Ziph<sup>H2128</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>: but David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> were in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Maon<sup>H4584</sup>, in the plain<sup>H6160</sup> on the south<sup>H3225</sup> of Jeshimon<sup>H3452</sup>. **25** Saul<sup>H7586</sup> also and his men<sup>H582</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> to seek<sup>H1245</sup> him. And they told<sup>H5046</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>: wherefore he came down<sup>H3381</sup> into a rock<sup>H5553</sup>, and abode<sup>H3427</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Maon<sup>H4584</sup>. And when Saul<sup>H7586</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> that, he pursued<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Maon<sup>H4584,5</sup> 26 And Saul<sup>H7586</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> on this side<sup>H6654</sup> of the mountain<sup>H2022</sup>, and David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> on that side<sup>H6654</sup> of the mountain<sup>H2022</sup>: and David<sup>H1732</sup> made haste<sup>H2648</sup> to get away<sup>H3212</sup> for fear<sup>H6440</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>; for Saul<sup>H7586</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> compassed<sup>H5849</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> round about<sup>H5849</sup> to take<sup>H8610</sup> them. **27** But there came<sup>H935</sup> a messenger<sup>H4397</sup> unto Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Haste<sup>H4116</sup> thee, and come<sup>H3212</sup>; for the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> have invaded<sup>H6584</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>.<sup>6</sup> 28 Wherefore Saul<sup>H7586</sup> returned<sup>H7725</sup> from pursuing<sup>H7291</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> against<sup>H7125</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>: therefore they called<sup>H7121</sup> that place<sup>H4725</sup> Selahammahlekoth<sup>H5555,7</sup> 29 And David<sup>H1732</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> from thence, and dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in strong holds<sup>H4679</sup> at Engedi<sup>H5872</sup>.
