

# 1. Samuel 27

1 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> in his heart<sup>H3820</sup>, I shall now perish<sup>H5595</sup> one<sup>H259</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Saul<sup>H7586</sup>: there is nothing better<sup>H2896</sup> for me than that<sup>H3588</sup> I should speedily<sup>H4422</sup> escape<sup>H4422</sup> into the land<sup>H776</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>; and Saul<sup>H7586</sup> shall despair<sup>H2976</sup> of me, to seek<sup>H1245</sup> me any more in any coast<sup>H1366</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: so shall I escape<sup>H4422</sup> out of his hand<sup>H3027</sup>.<sup>1</sup> 2 And David<sup>H1732</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and he passed over<sup>H5674</sup> with the six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> that were with him unto Achish<sup>H397</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Maoch<sup>H4582</sup>, king<sup>H4428</sup> of Gath<sup>H1661</sup>. 3 And David<sup>H1732</sup> dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> with Achish<sup>H397</sup> at Gath<sup>H1661</sup>, he and his men<sup>H582</sup>, every man<sup>H376</sup> with his household<sup>H1004</sup>, even David<sup>H1732</sup> with his two<sup>H8147</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup>, Ahinoam<sup>H293</sup> the Jezreelitess<sup>H3159</sup>, and Abigail<sup>H26</sup> the Carmelitess<sup>H3762</sup>, Nabal's<sup>H5037</sup> wife<sup>H802</sup>. 4 And it was told<sup>H5046</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> that David<sup>H1732</sup> was fled<sup>H1272</sup> to Gath<sup>H1661</sup>: and he sought<sup>H1245</sup> no more again<sup>H3254 H3254</sup> for him. 5 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Achish<sup>H397</sup>, If I have now found<sup>H4672</sup> grace<sup>H2580</sup> in thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, let them give<sup>H5414</sup> me a place<sup>H4725</sup> in some<sup>H259</sup> town<sup>H5892</sup> in the country<sup>H7704</sup>, that I may dwell<sup>H3427</sup> there: for why should thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in the royal<sup>H4467</sup> city<sup>H5892</sup> with thee? 6 Then Achish<sup>H397</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> him Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup>: wherefore Ziklag<sup>H6860</sup> pertaineth unto the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>. 7 And the time<sup>H4557 H3117</sup> that David<sup>H1732</sup> dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in the country<sup>H7704</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> was a full year<sup>H3117</sup> and four<sup>H702</sup> months<sup>H2320 23</sup>.

8 And David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup>, and invaded<sup>H6584</sup> the Geshurites<sup>H1651</sup>, and the Gezrites<sup>H1511</sup>, and the Amalekites<sup>H6003</sup>: for those<sup>H2007</sup> nations were of old<sup>H5769</sup> the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, as thou goest<sup>H935</sup> to Shur<sup>H793</sup>, even unto the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 9 And David<sup>H1732</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>, and left neither man<sup>H376</sup> nor woman<sup>H802</sup> alive<sup>H2421</sup>, and took away<sup>H3947</sup> the sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, and the oxen<sup>H1241</sup>, and the asses<sup>H2543</sup>, and the camels<sup>H1581</sup>, and the apparel<sup>H899</sup>, and returned<sup>H7725</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Achish<sup>H397</sup>. 10 And Achish<sup>H397</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Whither<sup>H408</sup> have ye made a road<sup>H6584</sup> to day<sup>H3117</sup>? And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Against the south<sup>H5045</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and against the south<sup>H5045</sup> of the Jerahmeelites<sup>H3397</sup>, and against the south<sup>H5045</sup> of the Kenites<sup>H7017</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 11 And David<sup>H1732</sup> saved<sup>H2421</sup> neither man<sup>H376</sup> nor woman<sup>H802</sup> alive<sup>H2421</sup>, to bring<sup>H935</sup> tidings to Gath<sup>H1661</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Lest they should tell<sup>H5046</sup> on us, saying<sup>H559</sup>, So did<sup>H6213</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, and so will be his manner<sup>H4941</sup> all the while<sup>H3117</sup> he dwelleth<sup>H3427</sup> in the country<sup>H7704</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. 12 And Achish<sup>H397</sup> believed<sup>H539</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, He hath made his people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> utterly<sup>H887</sup> to abhor<sup>H887</sup> him; therefore he shall be my servant<sup>H5650</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>.<sup>6</sup>
