

# 1. Samuel 7

1 And the men<sup>H582</sup> of Kirjathjearim<sup>H7157</sup> came<sup>H935</sup>, and fetched up<sup>H5927</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and brought<sup>H935</sup> it into the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Abinadab<sup>H41</sup> in the hill<sup>H1389</sup>, and sanctified<sup>H6942</sup> Eleazar<sup>H499</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> to keep<sup>H8104</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 2 And it came to pass, while<sup>H3117</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> abode<sup>H3427</sup> in Kirjathjearim<sup>H7157</sup>, that the time<sup>H3117</sup> was long<sup>H7235</sup>; for it was twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>: and all the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> lamented<sup>H5091</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

3 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> spake<sup>H559</sup> unto all the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, If ye do return<sup>H7725</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> with all your hearts<sup>H3824</sup>, then put away<sup>H5493</sup> the strange<sup>H5236</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup> and Ashtaroth<sup>H6252</sup> from among<sup>H8432</sup> you, and prepare<sup>H3559</sup> your hearts<sup>H3824</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and serve<sup>H5647</sup> him only: and he will deliver<sup>H5337</sup> you out of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. 4 Then the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> did put away<sup>H5493</sup> Baalim<sup>H1168</sup> and Ashtaroth<sup>H6252</sup>, and served<sup>H5647</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> only. 5 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Gather<sup>H6908</sup> all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to Mizpeh<sup>H4708</sup>, and I will pray<sup>H6419</sup> for you unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 6 And they gathered together<sup>H6908</sup> to Mizpeh<sup>H4709</sup>, and drew<sup>H7579</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup>, and poured it out<sup>H8210</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and fasted<sup>H6684</sup> on that day<sup>H3117</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> there, We have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> judged<sup>H8199</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Mizpeh<sup>H4708</sup>.

7 And when the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> that the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> were gathered together<sup>H6908</sup> to Mizpeh<sup>H4708</sup>, the lords<sup>H5633</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> against Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. And when the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> it, they were afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of<sup>H6440</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. 8 And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, Cease<sup>H2790</sup> not to cry<sup>H2199</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> for us, that he will save<sup>H3467</sup> us out of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. 9 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> a<sup>H259</sup> sucking<sup>H2461</sup> lamb<sup>H2924</sup>, and offered<sup>H5927</sup> it for a burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup> wholly<sup>H3632</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> cried<sup>H2199</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> heard<sup>H6030</sup> him.<sup>2</sup> 10 And as Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> was offering up<sup>H5927</sup> the burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>, the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> drew near<sup>H5066</sup> to battle<sup>H4421</sup> against Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: but the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thundered<sup>H7481</sup> with a great<sup>H1419</sup> thunder<sup>H6963</sup> on that day<sup>H3117</sup> upon the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and discomfited<sup>H2000</sup> them; and they were smitten<sup>H5062</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 11 And the men<sup>H582</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> went out<sup>H3318</sup> of Mizpeh<sup>H4709</sup>, and pursued<sup>H7291</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> them, until they came under Bethcar<sup>H1033</sup>. 12 Then Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> a<sup>H259</sup> stone<sup>H68</sup>, and set<sup>H7760</sup> it between Mizpeh<sup>H4709</sup> and Shen<sup>H8129</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of it Ebenezer<sup>H72</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Hitherto hath the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> helped<sup>H5826</sup> us.<sup>3</sup>

13 So the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> were subdued<sup>H3665</sup>, and they came<sup>H935</sup> no more<sup>H3254</sup> into the coast<sup>H1366</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: and the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was against the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>. 14 And the cities<sup>H5892</sup> which the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> had taken<sup>H3947</sup> from Israel<sup>H3478</sup> were restored<sup>H7725</sup> to Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, from Ekron<sup>H6138</sup> even unto Gath<sup>H1661</sup>; and the coasts<sup>H1366</sup> thereof did Israel<sup>H3478</sup> deliver<sup>H5337</sup> out of the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. And there was peace<sup>H7965</sup> between Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and the Amorites<sup>H567</sup>. 15 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> judged<sup>H8199</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of his life<sup>H2416</sup>. 16 And he went<sup>H1980</sup> from<sup>H1767</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> to year<sup>H8141</sup> in circuit<sup>H5437</sup> to Bethel<sup>H1008</sup>, and Gilgal<sup>H1537</sup>, and Mizpeh<sup>H4709</sup>, and judged<sup>H8199</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in all those places<sup>H4725</sup>. 17 And his return<sup>H8666</sup> was to Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>, for there was his house<sup>H1004</sup>, and there he judged<sup>H8199</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; and there he built<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
