

# 1. Samuel 8



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 And it came to pass, when Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> was old<sup>H2204</sup>, that he made<sup>H7760</sup> his sons<sup>H1121</sup> judges<sup>H8199</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 2 Now the name<sup>H8034</sup> of his firstborn<sup>H1121 H1060</sup> was Joel<sup>H3100</sup>; and the name<sup>H8034</sup> of his second<sup>H4932</sup>, Abiah<sup>H29</sup>: they were judges<sup>H8199</sup> in Beersheba<sup>H884</sup>. 3 And his sons<sup>H1121</sup> walked<sup>H1980</sup> not in his ways<sup>H1870</sup>, but turned aside<sup>H5186</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> lucre<sup>H1215</sup>, and took<sup>H3947</sup> bribes<sup>H7810</sup>, and perverted<sup>H5186</sup> judgment<sup>H4941</sup>.

4 Then all the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> gathered themselves together<sup>H6908</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> unto Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>, 5 And said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Behold, thou art old<sup>H2204</sup>, and thy sons<sup>H1121</sup> walk<sup>H1980</sup> not in thy ways<sup>H1870</sup>: now make<sup>H7760</sup> us a king<sup>H4428</sup> to judge<sup>H8199</sup> us like all the nations<sup>H1471</sup>. 6 But the thing<sup>H1697</sup> displeased<sup>H3415 H5869</sup> Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, when they said<sup>H559</sup>, Give<sup>H5414</sup> us a king<sup>H4428</sup> to judge<sup>H8199</sup> us. And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> prayed<sup>H6419</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 7 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, Harken<sup>H8085</sup> unto the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> in all that they say<sup>H559</sup> unto thee: for they have not rejected<sup>H3988</sup> thee, but they have rejected<sup>H3988</sup> me, that I should not reign<sup>H4427</sup> over them. 8 According to all the works<sup>H4639</sup> which they have done<sup>H6213</sup> since the day<sup>H3117</sup> that I brought them up<sup>H5927</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> even unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>, wherewith they have forsaken<sup>H5800</sup> me, and served<sup>H5647</sup> other<sup>H312</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup>, so do<sup>H6213</sup> they also unto thee. 9 Now therefore hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto their voice<sup>H6963</sup>: howbeit<sup>H389</sup> yet protest<sup>H5749</sup> solemnly<sup>H5749</sup> unto them, and shew<sup>H5046</sup> them the manner<sup>H4941</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> that shall reign<sup>H4427</sup> over them. 10 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> told<sup>H559</sup> all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup> that asked<sup>H7592</sup> of him a king<sup>H4428</sup>. 11 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, This will be the manner<sup>H4941</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> that shall reign<sup>H4427</sup> over you: He will take<sup>H3947</sup> your sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and appoint<sup>H7760</sup> them for himself, for his chariots<sup>H4818</sup>, and to be his horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>; and some shall run<sup>H7323</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> his chariots<sup>H4818</sup>. 12 And he will appoint<sup>H7760</sup> him captains<sup>H8269</sup> over thousands<sup>H505</sup>, and captains<sup>H8269</sup> over fifties<sup>H2572</sup>, and will set them to ear<sup>H2790</sup> his ground<sup>H2758</sup>, and to reap<sup>H7114</sup> his harvest<sup>H7105</sup>, and to make<sup>H6213</sup> his instruments<sup>H3627</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup>, and instruments<sup>H3627</sup> of his chariots<sup>H7393</sup>. 13 And he will take<sup>H3947</sup> your daughters<sup>H1323</sup> to be confectionaries<sup>H7548</sup>, and to be cooks<sup>H2879</sup>, and to be bakers<sup>H644</sup>. 14 And he will take<sup>H3947</sup> your fields<sup>H7704</sup>, and your vineyards<sup>H3754</sup>, and your oliveyards<sup>H2132</sup>, even the best<sup>H2896</sup> of them, and give<sup>H5414</sup> them to his servants<sup>H5650</sup>. 15 And he will take the tenth<sup>H6237</sup> of your seed<sup>H2233</sup>, and of your vineyards<sup>H3754</sup>, and give<sup>H5414</sup> to his officers<sup>H5631</sup>, and to his servants<sup>H5650</sup>. 16 And he will take<sup>H3947</sup> your menservants<sup>H5650</sup>, and your maidservants<sup>H8198</sup>, and your goodliest<sup>H2896</sup> young men<sup>H970</sup>, and your asses<sup>H2543</sup>, and put<sup>H6213</sup> them to his work<sup>H4399</sup>. 17 He will take the tenth<sup>H6237</sup> of your sheep<sup>H6629</sup>: and ye shall be his servants<sup>H5650</sup>. 18 And ye shall cry out<sup>H2199</sup> in that day<sup>H3117</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of your king<sup>H4428</sup> which ye shall have chosen<sup>H977</sup> you; and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will not hear<sup>H6030</sup> you in that day<sup>H3117</sup>. 19 Nevertheless the people<sup>H5971</sup> refused<sup>H3985</sup> to obey<sup>H8085</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, and they said<sup>H559</sup>, Nay; but we will have a king<sup>H4428</sup> over us; 20 That we also may be like all the nations<sup>H1471</sup>; and that our king<sup>H4428</sup> may judge<sup>H8199</sup> us, and go out<sup>H3318</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> us, and fight<sup>H3898</sup> our battles<sup>H4421</sup>. 21 And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and he rehearsed<sup>H1696</sup> them in the ears<sup>H241</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 22 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Samuel<sup>H8050</sup>, Harken<sup>H8085</sup> unto their voice<sup>H6963</sup>, and make<sup>H4427</sup> them a king<sup>H4428</sup>. And Samuel<sup>H8050</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the men<sup>H582</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> ye every man<sup>H376</sup> unto his city<sup>H5892</sup>.
