

# 1. Timothy 4

1 Now<sup>G1161</sup> the Spirit<sup>G4151</sup> speaketh<sup>G3004</sup> expressly<sup>G4490</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the latter<sup>G5306</sup> times<sup>G2540</sup> some<sup>G5100</sup> shall depart from<sup>G868</sup> the faith<sup>G4102</sup>, giving heed<sup>G4337</sup> to seducing<sup>G4108</sup> spirits<sup>G4151</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> doctrines<sup>G1319</sup> of devils<sup>G1140</sup>; 2 Speaking lies<sup>G5573</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> hypocrisy<sup>G5272</sup>; having<sup>G2743</sup> their<sup>G2398</sup> conscience<sup>G4893</sup> seared with a hot iron<sup>G2743</sup>; 3 Forbidding<sup>G2967</sup> to marry<sup>G1060</sup>, and commanding to abstain from<sup>G567</sup> meats<sup>G1033</sup>, which<sup>G3739</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup> hath created<sup>G2936</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> be received<sup>G3336</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> thanksgiving<sup>G2169</sup> of them which believe<sup>G4103</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> know<sup>G1921</sup> the truth<sup>G225</sup>. 4 For<sup>G3754</sup> every<sup>G3956</sup> creature<sup>G2938</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup> is good<sup>G2570</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> nothing<sup>G3762</sup> to be refused<sup>G579</sup>, if it be received<sup>G2983</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> thanksgiving<sup>G2169</sup>: 5 For<sup>G1063</sup> it is sanctified<sup>G37</sup> by<sup>G1223</sup> the word<sup>G3056</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> prayer<sup>G1783</sup>.

6 If thou put<sup>G5294</sup> the brethren<sup>G80</sup> in remembrance<sup>G5294</sup> of these things<sup>G5023</sup>, thou shalt be<sup>G2071</sup> a good<sup>G2570</sup> minister<sup>G1249</sup> of Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>, nourished up<sup>G1789</sup> in the words<sup>G3056</sup> of faith<sup>G4102</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> of good<sup>G2570</sup> doctrine<sup>G1319</sup>, whereunto<sup>G3739</sup> thou hast attained<sup>G3877</sup>. 7 But<sup>G1161</sup> refuse<sup>G3868</sup> profane<sup>G952</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> old wives'<sup>G1126</sup> fables<sup>G3454</sup>, and<sup>G1161</sup> exercise<sup>G1128</sup> thyself<sup>G4572</sup> rather unto<sup>G4314</sup> godliness<sup>G2150</sup>. 8 For<sup>G1063</sup> bodily<sup>G4984</sup> exercise<sup>G1129</sup> profiteth<sup>G2076</sup> little<sup>G4314</sup>: but<sup>G1161</sup> godliness<sup>G2150</sup> is profitable<sup>G2076</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> all things<sup>G3956</sup>, having<sup>G2192</sup> promise<sup>G1860</sup> of the life<sup>G2222</sup> that now is<sup>G3568</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> of that which is to come<sup>G3195</sup>. 9 This is a faithful<sup>G4103</sup> saying<sup>G3056</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> worthy<sup>G514</sup> of all<sup>G3956</sup> acceptation<sup>G594</sup>. 10 For<sup>G1063</sup> therefore<sup>G1519</sup> we<sup>G2872</sup> both<sup>G2532</sup> labour<sup>G2872</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> suffer reproach<sup>G3679</sup>, because<sup>G3754</sup> we trust<sup>G1679</sup> in<sup>G1909</sup> the living<sup>G2198</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, who<sup>G3739</sup> is<sup>G2076</sup> the Saviour<sup>G4990</sup> of all<sup>G3956</sup> men<sup>G444</sup>, specially<sup>G3122</sup> of those that believe<sup>G4103</sup>. 11 These things<sup>G5023</sup> command<sup>G3853</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> teach<sup>G1321</sup>. 12 Let<sup>G2706</sup> no man<sup>G3367</sup> despise<sup>G2706</sup> thy<sup>G4675</sup> youth<sup>G3503</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> be thou<sup>G1096</sup> an example<sup>G5179</sup> of the believers<sup>G4103</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> word<sup>G3056</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> conversation<sup>G391</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> charity<sup>G26</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> spirit<sup>G4151</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> faith<sup>G4102</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> purity<sup>G47</sup>. 13 Till<sup>G2193</sup> I come<sup>G2064</sup>, give attendance<sup>G4337</sup> to reading<sup>G320</sup>, to exhortation<sup>G3874</sup>, to doctrine<sup>G1319</sup>. 14 Neglect<sup>G272</sup> not<sup>G3361</sup> the gift<sup>G5486</sup> that is in<sup>G1722</sup> thee<sup>G4671</sup>, which<sup>G3739</sup> was given<sup>G1325</sup> thee<sup>G4671</sup> by<sup>G1223</sup> prophecy<sup>G4394</sup>, with<sup>G3326</sup> the laying on<sup>G1936</sup> of the hands<sup>G5495</sup> of the presbytery<sup>G4244</sup>. 15 Meditate upon<sup>G3191</sup> these things<sup>G5023</sup>; give thyself<sup>G2468</sup> wholly to<sup>G1722</sup> them<sup>G5125</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> thy<sup>G4675</sup> profiting<sup>G4297</sup> may<sup>G5600</sup> appear<sup>G5318</sup> to<sup>G1722</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup>. 16 Take heed<sup>G1907</sup> unto thyself<sup>G4572</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> unto the doctrine<sup>G1319</sup>; continue<sup>G1961</sup> in them<sup>G846</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> in doing<sup>G4160</sup> this<sup>G5124</sup> thou shalt<sup>G4982</sup> both<sup>G2532</sup> save<sup>G4982</sup> thyself<sup>G4572</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> them that hear<sup>G191</sup> thee<sup>G4675</sup>.
