

## 2. Chronicles 16



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 In the six<sup>H8337</sup> and thirtieth<sup>H7970</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of the reign<sup>H4438</sup> of Asa<sup>H609</sup> Baasha<sup>H1201</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> came up<sup>H5927</sup> against Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and built<sup>H1129</sup> Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>, to the intent that<sup>H1115</sup> he might let<sup>H5414</sup> none go out<sup>H3318</sup> or come in<sup>H935</sup> to Asa<sup>H609</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 2 Then Asa<sup>H609</sup> brought out<sup>H3318</sup> silver<sup>H3701</sup> and gold<sup>H2091</sup> out of the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> and of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and sent<sup>H7971</sup> to Benhadad<sup>H1130</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, that dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> at Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 3 There is a league<sup>H1285</sup> between me and thee, as there was between my father<sup>H1</sup> and thy father<sup>H1</sup>: behold, I have sent<sup>H7971</sup> thee silver<sup>H3701</sup> and gold<sup>H2091</sup>; go<sup>H3212</sup>, break<sup>H6565</sup> thy league<sup>H1285</sup> with Baasha<sup>H1201</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, that he may depart<sup>H5927</sup> from me. 4 And Benhadad<sup>H1130</sup> hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> unto king<sup>H4428</sup> Asa<sup>H609</sup>, and sent<sup>H7971</sup> the captains<sup>H8269</sup> of his armies<sup>H2428</sup> against the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; and they smote<sup>H5221</sup> Ijon<sup>H5859</sup>, and Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, and Abelmaim<sup>H66</sup>, and all the store<sup>H4543</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Naphtali<sup>H5321</sup>. 5 And it came to pass, when Baasha<sup>H1201</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> it, that he left off<sup>H2308</sup> building<sup>H1129</sup> of Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>, and let his work<sup>H4399</sup> cease<sup>H7673</sup>. 6 Then Asa<sup>H609</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> all Judah<sup>H3063</sup>; and they carried away<sup>H5375</sup> the stones<sup>H68</sup> of Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>, and the timber<sup>H6086</sup> thereof, wherewith Baasha<sup>H1201</sup> was building<sup>H1129</sup>; and he built<sup>H1129</sup> therewith Geba<sup>H1387</sup> and Mizpah<sup>H4709</sup>.

7 And at that time<sup>H6256</sup> Hanani<sup>H2607</sup> the seer<sup>H7200</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Asa<sup>H609</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Because thou hast relied<sup>H8172</sup> on the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, and not relied<sup>H8172</sup> on the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, therefore is the host<sup>H2428</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> escaped<sup>H4422</sup> out of thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 8 Were not the Ethiopians<sup>H3569</sup> and the Lubims<sup>H3864</sup> a huge<sup>H7230</sup> host<sup>H2428</sup>, with very<sup>H3966</sup> many<sup>H7235</sup> chariots<sup>H7393</sup> and horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>? yet, because thou didst rely<sup>H8172</sup> on the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, he delivered<sup>H5414</sup> them into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 9 For the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> run to and fro<sup>H7751</sup> throughout the whole earth<sup>H776</sup>, to shew himself strong<sup>H2388</sup> in the behalf of them whose heart<sup>H3824</sup> is perfect<sup>H8003</sup> toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly<sup>H5528</sup>: therefore from henceforth<sup>H6258</sup> thou shalt have<sup>H3426</sup> wars<sup>H4421</sup>. 10 Then Asa<sup>H609</sup> was wroth<sup>H3707</sup> with the seer<sup>H7200</sup>, and put<sup>H5414</sup> him in a prison<sup>H4115</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>; for he was in a rage<sup>H2197</sup> with him because of this thing. And Asa<sup>H609</sup> oppressed<sup>H7533</sup> some of the people<sup>H5971</sup> the same time<sup>H6256</sup>. 11 And, behold, the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Asa<sup>H609</sup>, first<sup>H7223</sup> and last<sup>H314</sup>, lo, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 12 And Asa<sup>H609</sup> in the thirty<sup>H7970</sup> and ninth<sup>H8672</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of his reign<sup>H4438</sup> was diseased<sup>H2456</sup> in his feet<sup>H7272</sup>, until his disease<sup>H2483</sup> was exceeding<sup>H4605</sup> great: yet in his disease<sup>H2483</sup> he sought<sup>H1875</sup> not to the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, but to the physicians<sup>H7495</sup>. 13 And Asa<sup>H609</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and died<sup>H4191</sup> in the one<sup>H259</sup> and fortieth<sup>H705</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of his reign<sup>H4427</sup>. 14 And they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in his own sepulchres<sup>H6913</sup>, which he had made<sup>H3738</sup> for himself in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, and laid<sup>H7901</sup> him in the bed<sup>H4904</sup> which was filled<sup>H4390</sup> with sweet odours<sup>H1314</sup> and divers kinds<sup>H2177</sup> of spices prepared<sup>H7543</sup> by the apothecaries<sup>H4842</sup> art<sup>H4639</sup>: and they made<sup>H8313</sup> a very<sup>H3966</sup> great<sup>H1419</sup> burning<sup>H8316</sup> for him.<sup>6</sup>
