

## 2. Chronicles 21

1 Now Jehoshaphat<sup>H3092</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. And Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. 2 And he had brethren<sup>H251</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoshaphat<sup>H3092</sup>, Azariah<sup>H5838</sup>, and Jehiel<sup>H3171</sup>, and Zechariah<sup>H2148</sup>, and Azariah<sup>H5838</sup>, and Michael<sup>H4317</sup>, and Shephatiah<sup>H8203</sup>: all these were the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoshaphat<sup>H3092</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 3 And their father<sup>H1</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> them great<sup>H7227</sup> gifts<sup>H4979</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and of gold<sup>H2091</sup>, and of precious things<sup>H4030</sup>, with fenced<sup>H4694</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup> in Judah<sup>H3063</sup>: but the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> he to Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup>, because he was the firstborn<sup>H1060</sup>. 4 Now when Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> was risen up<sup>H6965</sup> to the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> of his father<sup>H1</sup>, he strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> himself, and slew<sup>H2026</sup> all his brethren<sup>H251</sup> with the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and divers also of the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 5 Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> was thirty<sup>H7970</sup> and two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> eight<sup>H8083</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 6 And he walked<sup>H3212</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, like as did<sup>H6213</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>: for he had the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>: and he wrought<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 7 Howbeit the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> would<sup>H114</sup> not destroy<sup>H7843</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, because of the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> that he had made<sup>H3772</sup> with David<sup>H1732</sup>, and as he promised<sup>H559</sup> to give<sup>H5414</sup> a light<sup>H5216</sup> to him and to his sons<sup>H1121</sup> for ever<sup>H3117</sup>. 8 In his days<sup>H3117</sup> the Edomites<sup>H123</sup> revolted<sup>H6586</sup> from under the dominion<sup>H3027</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and made<sup>H4427</sup> themselves a king<sup>H4428</sup>. 9 Then Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> went forth<sup>H5674</sup> with his princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and all his chariots<sup>H7393</sup> with him: and he rose up<sup>H6965</sup> by night<sup>H3915</sup>, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> the Edomites<sup>H123</sup> which compassed him in<sup>H5437</sup>, and the captains<sup>H8269</sup> of the chariots<sup>H7393</sup>. 10 So the Edomites<sup>H123</sup> revolted<sup>H6586</sup> from under the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>. The same time<sup>H6256</sup> also did Libnah<sup>H3841</sup> revolt<sup>H6586</sup> from under his hand<sup>H3027</sup>; because he had forsaken<sup>H5800</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of his fathers<sup>H1</sup>. 11 Moreover he made<sup>H6213</sup> high places<sup>H1116</sup> in the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and caused the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> to commit fornication<sup>H2181</sup>, and compelled<sup>H5080</sup> Judah<sup>H3063</sup> thereto.

12 And there came<sup>H935</sup> a writing<sup>H4385</sup> to him from Elijah<sup>H452</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> thy father<sup>H1</sup>, Because thou hast not walked<sup>H1980</sup> in the ways<sup>H1870</sup> of Jehoshaphat<sup>H3092</sup> thy father<sup>H1</sup>, nor in the ways<sup>H1870</sup> of Asa<sup>H609</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, 13 But hast walked<sup>H3212</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and hast made Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> to go a whoring<sup>H2181</sup>, like to the whoredoms<sup>H2181</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>, and also hast slain<sup>H2026</sup> thy brethren<sup>H251</sup> of thy father's<sup>H1</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, which were better<sup>H2896</sup> than thyself: 14 Behold, with a great<sup>H1419</sup> plague<sup>H4046</sup> will the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> smite<sup>H5062</sup> thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, and thy children<sup>H1121</sup>, and thy wives<sup>H802</sup>, and all thy goods<sup>H7399</sup>. 15 And thou shalt have great<sup>H7227</sup> sickness<sup>H2483</sup> by disease<sup>H4245</sup> of thy bowels<sup>H4578</sup>, until thy bowels<sup>H4578</sup> fall out<sup>H3318</sup> by reason of the sickness<sup>H2483</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> by day<sup>H3117</sup>. 16 Moreover the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> stirred up<sup>H5782</sup> against Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and of the Arabians<sup>H6163</sup>, that were near<sup>H5921</sup> the Ethiopians<sup>H3569</sup>: 17 And they came up<sup>H5927</sup> into Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and brake<sup>H1234</sup> into it, and carried away<sup>H7617</sup> all the substance<sup>H7399</sup> that was found<sup>H4672</sup> in the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and his sons<sup>H1121</sup> also, and his wives<sup>H802</sup>; so that there was never a son<sup>H1121</sup> left<sup>H7604</sup> him, save Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup>, the youngest<sup>H6996</sup> of his sons<sup>H1121</sup>. 18 And after<sup>H310</sup> all this the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> smote<sup>H5062</sup> him in his bowels<sup>H4578</sup> with an incurable<sup>H369</sup> disease<sup>H4832</sup>. 19 And it came to pass, that in process of time<sup>H3117</sup>, after<sup>H3318</sup> the end<sup>H7093</sup> of two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H3117</sup>, his bowels<sup>H4578</sup> fell out<sup>H3318</sup> by reason<sup>H5973</sup> of his sickness<sup>H2483</sup>: so he died<sup>H4191</sup> of sore<sup>H7451</sup> diseases<sup>H8463</sup>. And his people<sup>H5971</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> no burning<sup>H8316</sup> for him, like the burning<sup>H8316</sup> of his fathers<sup>H1</sup>. 20 Thirty<sup>H7970</sup> and two<sup>H8147</sup> years old<sup>H1121</sup> was he when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> eight<sup>H8083</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>, and departed<sup>H3212</sup> without being desired<sup>H2532</sup>. Howbeit they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, but not in the sepulchres<sup>H6913</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup>.
