

## 2. Chronicles 22

1 And the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> made<sup>H4427</sup> Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> his youngest<sup>H6996</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> king<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead: for the band of men<sup>H1416</sup> that came<sup>H935</sup> with the Arabians<sup>H6163</sup> to the camp<sup>H4264</sup> had slain<sup>H2026</sup> all the eldest<sup>H7223</sup>. So Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup>. 2 Forty<sup>H705</sup> and two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> was Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> one<sup>H259</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. His mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> also was Athaliah<sup>H6271</sup> the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Omri<sup>H6018</sup>. 3 He also walked<sup>H1980</sup> in the ways<sup>H1870</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>: for his mother<sup>H517</sup> was his counsellor<sup>H3289</sup> to do wickedly<sup>H7561</sup>. 4 Wherefore he did<sup>H6213</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> like the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>: for they were his counsellors<sup>H3289</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the death<sup>H4194</sup> of his father<sup>H1</sup> to his destruction<sup>H4889</sup>. 5 He walked<sup>H1980</sup> also after their counsel<sup>H6098</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> with Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to war<sup>H4421</sup> against Hazael<sup>H2371</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> at Ramothgilead<sup>H7433 H1568</sup>: and the Syrians<sup>H7421</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> Joram<sup>H3141</sup>. 6 And he returned<sup>H7725</sup> to be healed<sup>H7495</sup> in Jezreel<sup>H3157</sup> because of the wounds<sup>H4347</sup> which were given<sup>H5221</sup> him at Ramah<sup>H7414</sup>, when he fought<sup>H3898</sup> with Hazael<sup>H2371</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>. And Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> went down<sup>H3381</sup> to see<sup>H7200</sup> Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup> at Jezreel<sup>H3157</sup>, because he was sick<sup>H2470</sup>. 7 And the destruction<sup>H8395</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> was of God<sup>H430</sup> by coming<sup>H935</sup> to Joram<sup>H3141</sup>: for when he was come<sup>H935</sup>, he went out<sup>H3318</sup> with Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup> against Jehu<sup>H3058</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nimshi<sup>H5250</sup>, whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had anointed<sup>H4886</sup> to cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>. 8 And it came to pass, that, when Jehu<sup>H3058</sup> was executing judgment<sup>H8199</sup> upon the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>, and found<sup>H4672</sup> the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of the brethren<sup>H251</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup>, that ministered<sup>H8334</sup> to Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup>, he slew<sup>H2026</sup> them. 9 And he sought<sup>H1245</sup> Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup>: and they caught<sup>H3920</sup> him, (for he was hid<sup>H2244</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>), and brought<sup>H935</sup> him to Jehu<sup>H3058</sup>: and when they had slain<sup>H4191</sup> him, they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him: Because, said<sup>H559</sup> they, he is the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoshaphat<sup>H3092</sup>, who sought<sup>H1875</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> with all his heart<sup>H3824</sup>. So the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> had no power<sup>H3581</sup> to keep<sup>H6113</sup> still the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup>.

10 But when Athaliah<sup>H6271</sup> the mother<sup>H517</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that her son<sup>H1121</sup> was dead<sup>H4191</sup>, she arose<sup>H6965</sup> and destroyed<sup>H1696</sup> all the seed<sup>H2233</sup> royal<sup>H4467</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 11 But Jehoshabeath<sup>H3090</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup>, took<sup>H3947</sup> Joash<sup>H3101</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup>, and stole<sup>H1589</sup> him from among<sup>H8432</sup> the king's<sup>H4428</sup> sons<sup>H1121</sup> that were slain<sup>H4191</sup>, and put<sup>H5414</sup> him and his nurse<sup>H3243</sup> in a bedchamber<sup>H2315 H4296</sup>. So Jehoshabeath<sup>H3090</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of king<sup>H4428</sup> Jehoram<sup>H3088</sup>, the wife<sup>H802</sup> of Jehoiada<sup>H3077</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, (for she was the sister<sup>H269</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup>), hid<sup>H5641</sup> him from<sup>H6440</sup> Athaliah<sup>H6271</sup>, so that she slew<sup>H4191</sup> him not. 12 And he was with them hid<sup>H2244</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> six<sup>H8337</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>: and Athaliah<sup>H6271</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> over the land<sup>H776</sup>.
