

## 2. Chronicles 26

1 Then all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup>, who was sixteen<sup>H8337</sup> years<sup>H6240</sup> old<sup>H8141</sup>, and made him king<sup>H4427</sup> in the room of his father<sup>H1</sup> Amaziah<sup>H558</sup>. 2 He built<sup>H1129</sup> Eloth<sup>H359</sup>, and restored<sup>H7725</sup> it to Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> that the king<sup>H4428</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>. 3 Sixteen<sup>H8337</sup> years<sup>H6240</sup> old<sup>H8141</sup> was Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> fifty<sup>H2572</sup> and two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. His mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> also was Jecoliah<sup>H3203</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 4 And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, according to all that his father<sup>H1</sup> Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup>. 5 And he sought<sup>H1875</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> in the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Zechariah<sup>H2148</sup>, who had understanding<sup>H995</sup> in the visions<sup>H7200</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>: and as long as<sup>H3117</sup> he sought<sup>H1875</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> made him to prosper<sup>H6743</sup>. 6 And he went forth<sup>H3318</sup> and warred<sup>H3898</sup> against the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and brake down<sup>H6555</sup> the wall<sup>H2346</sup> of Gath<sup>H1661</sup>, and the wall<sup>H2346</sup> of Jabneh<sup>H2996</sup>, and the wall<sup>H2346</sup> of Ashdod<sup>H795</sup>, and built<sup>H1129</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup> about Ashdod<sup>H795</sup>, and among the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. 7 And God<sup>H430</sup> helped<sup>H5826</sup> him against the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and against the Arabians<sup>H6163</sup> that dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in Gurbaal<sup>H1485</sup>, and the Mehunims<sup>H4586</sup>. 8 And the Ammonites<sup>H5984</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> gifts<sup>H4503</sup> to Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup>: and his name<sup>H8034</sup> spread abroad<sup>H3212</sup> even to the entering<sup>H935</sup> in of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>; for he strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> himself exceedingly<sup>H4605</sup>. 9 Moreover Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> towers<sup>H4026</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> at the corner<sup>H6438</sup> gate<sup>H8179</sup>, and at the valley<sup>H1516</sup> gate<sup>H8179</sup>, and at the turning<sup>H4740</sup> of the wall, and fortified<sup>H2388</sup> them. 10 Also he built<sup>H1129</sup> towers<sup>H4026</sup> in the desert<sup>H4057</sup>, and digged<sup>H2672</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> wells<sup>H953</sup>: for he had much<sup>H7227</sup> cattle<sup>H4735</sup>, both in the low country<sup>H8219</sup>, and in the plains<sup>H4334</sup>: husbandmen<sup>H406</sup> also, and vine dressers<sup>H3755</sup> in the mountains<sup>H2022</sup>, and in Carmel<sup>H3760</sup>: for he loved<sup>H157</sup> husbandry<sup>H127</sup>. 11 Moreover Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> had an host<sup>H2428</sup> of fighting<sup>H4421</sup> men<sup>H6213</sup>, that went out<sup>H3318</sup> to war<sup>H6635</sup> by bands<sup>H1416</sup>, according to the number<sup>H4557</sup> of their account<sup>H6486</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Jeiel<sup>H3273</sup> the scribe<sup>H5608</sup> and Maaseiah<sup>H4641</sup> the ruler<sup>H7860</sup>, under the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Hananiah<sup>H2608</sup>, one of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> captains<sup>H8269</sup>. 12 The whole number<sup>H4557</sup> of the chief<sup>H7218</sup> of the fathers<sup>H1</sup> of the mighty men<sup>H1368</sup> of valour<sup>H2428</sup> were two thousand<sup>H505</sup> and six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup>. 13 And under their hand<sup>H3027</sup> was an army<sup>H2428</sup>, three<sup>H6635</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> and seven<sup>H7651</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> and five<sup>H2568</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup>, that made<sup>H6213</sup> war<sup>H4421</sup> with mighty<sup>H2428</sup> power<sup>H3581</sup>, to help<sup>H5826</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> against the enemy<sup>H341</sup>. 14 And Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> prepared<sup>H3559</sup> for them throughout all the host<sup>H6635</sup> shields<sup>H4043</sup>, and spears<sup>H7420</sup>, and helmets<sup>H3553</sup>, and habergeons<sup>H8302</sup>, and bows<sup>H7198</sup>, and slings<sup>H7050</sup> to cast stones<sup>H68</sup>. 15 And he made<sup>H6213</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> engines<sup>H2810</sup>, invented<sup>H4284</sup> by cunning men<sup>H2803</sup>, to be on the towers<sup>H4026</sup> and upon the bulwarks<sup>H6438</sup>, to shoot<sup>H3384</sup> arrows<sup>H2671</sup> and great<sup>H1419</sup> stones<sup>H68</sup> withal. And his name<sup>H8034</sup> spread<sup>H3318</sup> far abroad<sup>H7350</sup>, for he was marvellously<sup>H6381</sup> helped<sup>H5826</sup>, till<sup>H3588</sup> he was strong<sup>H2388</sup>.

16 But when he was strong<sup>H2393</sup>, his heart<sup>H3820</sup> was lifted up<sup>H1361</sup> to his destruction<sup>H7843</sup>: for he transgressed<sup>H4603</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>, and went<sup>H935</sup> into the temple<sup>H1964</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> to burn incense<sup>H6999</sup> upon the altar<sup>H4196</sup> of incense<sup>H7004</sup>. 17 And Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> went in<sup>H935</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> him, and with him fourscore<sup>H8084</sup> priests<sup>H3548</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that were valiant<sup>H2428</sup> men<sup>H1121</sup>: 18 And they withstood<sup>H5975</sup> Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, It appertaineth not unto thee, Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup>, to burn incense<sup>H6999</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, but to the priests<sup>H3548</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, that are consecrated<sup>H6942</sup> to burn incense<sup>H6999</sup>: go out<sup>H3318</sup> of the sanctuary<sup>H4720</sup>; for thou hast trespassed<sup>H4603</sup>; neither shall it be for thine honour<sup>H3519</sup> from the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>. 19 Then Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> was wroth<sup>H2196</sup>, and had a censer<sup>H4730</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup> to burn incense<sup>H6999</sup>: and while he was wroth<sup>H2196</sup> with the priests<sup>H3548</sup>, the leprosy<sup>H6883</sup> even rose up<sup>H2224</sup> in his forehead<sup>H4696</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the priests<sup>H3548</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, from beside the incense<sup>H7004</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup>. 20 And Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> the chief<sup>H7218</sup> priest<sup>H3548</sup>, and all the priests<sup>H3548</sup>, looked<sup>H6437</sup> upon him, and, behold, he was leprous<sup>H6879</sup> in his forehead<sup>H4696</sup>, and they thrust him out<sup>H926</sup> from thence; yea, himself hasted<sup>H1765</sup> also to go out<sup>H3318</sup>, because the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had smitten<sup>H5060</sup> him. 21 And Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> was a leper<sup>H6879</sup> unto the day<sup>H3117</sup> of his death<sup>H4194</sup>, and dwelt in<sup>H3427</sup> a several<sup>H2669</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, being a leper<sup>H6879</sup>; for he was cut off<sup>H1504</sup> from the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> his

son<sup>H1121</sup> was over the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, judging<sup>H8199</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>.<sup>12</sup> **22** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup>, first<sup>H7223</sup> and last<sup>H314</sup>, did Isaiah<sup>H3470</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Amoz<sup>H531</sup>, write<sup>H3789</sup>. **23** So Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him with his fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the field<sup>H7704</sup> of the burial<sup>H6900</sup> which belonged to the kings<sup>H4428</sup>; for they said<sup>H559</sup>, He is a leper<sup>H6879</sup>: and Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.
