

## 2. Chronicles 30



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 And Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> to all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and wrote<sup>H3789</sup> letters<sup>H107</sup> also to Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> and Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup>, that they should come<sup>H935</sup> to the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, to keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 2 For the king<sup>H4428</sup> had taken counsel<sup>H3289</sup>, and his princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and all the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, to keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> in the second<sup>H8145</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>. 3 For they could<sup>H3201</sup> not keep<sup>H6213</sup> it at that time<sup>H6256</sup>, because the priests<sup>H3548</sup> had not sanctified<sup>H6942</sup> themselves sufficiently<sup>H4078 H1767</sup>, neither had the people<sup>H5971</sup> gathered themselves together<sup>H622</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 4 And the thing<sup>H1697</sup> pleased<sup>H3474 H5869</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> and all the congregation<sup>H6951</sup>. 5 So they established<sup>H5975</sup> a decree<sup>H1697</sup> to make proclamation<sup>H5674 H6963</sup> throughout all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, from Beersheba<sup>H884</sup> even to Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, that they should come<sup>H935</sup> to keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>: for they had not done<sup>H6213</sup> it of a long<sup>H7230</sup> time in such sort as it was written<sup>H3789</sup>. 6 So the posts<sup>H7323</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> with the letters<sup>H107</sup> from<sup>H3027</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> and his princes<sup>H8269</sup> throughout all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and according to the commandment<sup>H4687</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Ye children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, turn again<sup>H7725</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, Isaac<sup>H3327</sup>, and Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and he will return<sup>H7725</sup> to the remnant<sup>H7604</sup> of you, that are escaped<sup>H6413</sup> out of the hand<sup>H3709</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>. 7 And be not ye like your fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and like your brethren<sup>H251</sup>, which trespassed<sup>H4603</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of their fathers<sup>H1</sup>, who therefore gave them up<sup>H5414</sup> to desolation<sup>H8047</sup>, as ye see<sup>H7200</sup>. 8 Now be ye not stiffnecked<sup>H7185 H6203</sup>, as your fathers<sup>H1</sup> were, but yield<sup>H5414</sup> yourselves<sup>H3027</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and enter<sup>H935</sup> into his sanctuary<sup>H4720</sup>, which he hath sanctified<sup>H6942</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>: and serve<sup>H5647</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup>, that the fierceness<sup>H2740</sup> of his wrath<sup>H639</sup> may turn away<sup>H7725</sup> from you. 9 For if ye turn again<sup>H7725</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, your brethren<sup>H251</sup> and your children<sup>H1121</sup> shall find compassion<sup>H7356</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> them that lead them captive<sup>H7617</sup>, so that they shall come again<sup>H7725</sup> into this land<sup>H776</sup>: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup> is gracious<sup>H2587</sup> and merciful<sup>H7349</sup>, and will not turn away<sup>H5493</sup> his face<sup>H6440</sup> from you, if ye return<sup>H7725</sup> unto him. 10 So the posts<sup>H7323</sup> passed<sup>H5674</sup> from city<sup>H5892</sup> to city<sup>H5892</sup> through the country<sup>H776</sup> of Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> and Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> even unto Zebulun<sup>H2074</sup>: but they laughed them to scorn<sup>H7832</sup>, and mocked<sup>H3932</sup> them. 11 Nevertheless divers<sup>H582</sup> of Asher<sup>H836</sup> and Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> and of Zebulun<sup>H2074</sup> humbled<sup>H3665</sup> themselves, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 12 Also in Judah<sup>H3063</sup> the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> was to give<sup>H5414</sup> them one<sup>H259</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> the commandment<sup>H4687</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> and of the princes<sup>H8269</sup>, by the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

13 And there assembled<sup>H622</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> much<sup>H7227</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup> to keep<sup>H6213</sup> the feast<sup>H2282</sup> of unleavened bread<sup>H4682</sup> in the second<sup>H8145</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>, a very<sup>H3966</sup> great<sup>H7230</sup> congregation<sup>H6951</sup>. 14 And they arose<sup>H6965</sup> and took away<sup>H5493</sup> the altars<sup>H4196</sup> that were in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and all the altars for incense<sup>H6999</sup> took they away<sup>H5493</sup>, and cast<sup>H7993</sup> them into the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Kidron<sup>H6939</sup>. 15 Then they killed<sup>H7819</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> on the fourteenth<sup>H702 H6240</sup> day of the second<sup>H8145</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>: and the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> were ashamed<sup>H3637</sup>, and sanctified<sup>H6942</sup> themselves, and brought in<sup>H935</sup> the burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> into the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 16 And they stood<sup>H5975</sup> in their place<sup>H5977</sup> after their manner<sup>H4941</sup>, according to the law<sup>H8451</sup> of Moses<sup>H4872</sup> the man<sup>H376</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>: the priests<sup>H3548</sup> sprinkled<sup>H2236</sup> the blood<sup>H1818</sup>, which they received of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Levites<sup>H3881</sup>. 17 For there were many<sup>H7227</sup> in the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> that were not sanctified<sup>H6942</sup>: therefore the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> had the charge of the killing<sup>H7821</sup> of the passovers<sup>H6453</sup> for every one that was not clean<sup>H2889</sup>, to sanctify<sup>H6942</sup> them unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 18 For a multitude<sup>H4768</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>, even many<sup>H7227</sup> of Ephraim<sup>H669</sup>, and Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup>, Issachar<sup>H3485</sup>, and Zebulun<sup>H2074</sup>, had not cleansed<sup>H2891</sup> themselves, yet did they eat<sup>H398</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> otherwise than it was written<sup>H3789</sup>. But Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> prayed<sup>H6419</sup> for them, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The good<sup>H2896</sup> LORD<sup>H3068</sup> pardon<sup>H3722</sup> every one 19 That prepareth<sup>H3559</sup> his heart<sup>H3824</sup> to seek<sup>H1875</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, though he be not cleansed according to the purification<sup>H2893</sup> of the sanctuary<sup>H6944</sup>. 20 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> to Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup>, and healed<sup>H7495</sup> the

people<sup>H5971</sup>.

21 And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> that were present<sup>H4672</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> kept<sup>H6213</sup> the feast<sup>H2282</sup> of unleavened bread<sup>H4682</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> with great<sup>H1419</sup> gladness<sup>H8057</sup>; and the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> and the priests<sup>H3548</sup> praised<sup>H1984</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> by day<sup>H3117</sup>, singing with loud<sup>H5797</sup> instruments<sup>H3627</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 22 And Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> comfortably<sup>H3820</sup> unto all the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> that taught<sup>H7919</sup> the good<sup>H2896</sup> knowledge<sup>H7922</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; and they did eat<sup>H398</sup> throughout the feast<sup>H4150</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>, offering<sup>H2076</sup> peace<sup>H8002</sup> offerings<sup>H2077</sup>, and making confession<sup>H3034</sup> to the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of their fathers<sup>H1</sup>. 23 And the whole assembly<sup>H6951</sup> took counsel<sup>H3289</sup> to keep<sup>H6213</sup> other<sup>H312</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>; and they kept<sup>H6213</sup> other seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> with gladness<sup>H8057</sup>. 24 For Hezekiah<sup>H2396</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> did give<sup>H7311</sup> to the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> a thousand<sup>H505</sup> bullocks<sup>H6499</sup> and seven<sup>H7651</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> sheep<sup>H6629</sup>; and the princes<sup>H8269</sup> gave<sup>H7311</sup> to the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> a thousand<sup>H505</sup> bullocks<sup>H6499</sup> and ten<sup>H6235</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> sheep<sup>H6629</sup>; and a great number<sup>H7230</sup> of priests<sup>H3548</sup> sanctified<sup>H6942</sup> themselves.<sup>910</sup> 25 And all the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, with the priests<sup>H3548</sup> and the Levites<sup>H3881</sup>, and all the congregation<sup>H6951</sup> that came out<sup>H935</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and the strangers<sup>H1616</sup> that came out<sup>H935</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and that dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, rejoiced<sup>H8055</sup>. 26 So there was great<sup>H1419</sup> joy<sup>H8057</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>; for since the time<sup>H3117</sup> of Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> there was not the like in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 27 Then the priests<sup>H3548</sup> the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup> and blessed<sup>H1288</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>; and their voice<sup>H6963</sup> was heard<sup>H8085</sup>, and their prayer<sup>H8605</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> up to his holy<sup>H6944</sup> dwelling place<sup>H4583</sup>, even unto heaven<sup>H8064</sup>.<sup>11</sup>
