

## 2. Chronicles 32

1 After<sup>H310</sup> these things<sup>H1697</sup>, and the establishment<sup>H571</sup> thereof, Sennacherib<sup>H5576</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> came<sup>H935</sup>, and entered<sup>H935</sup> into Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and encamped<sup>H2583</sup> against the fenced<sup>H1219</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup>, and thought<sup>H559</sup> to win<sup>H1234</sup> them for himself.<sup>1</sup> 2 And when Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that Sennacherib<sup>H5576</sup> was come<sup>H935</sup>, and that he was purposed<sup>H6440</sup> to fight<sup>H4421</sup> against Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>,<sup>2</sup> 3 He took counsel<sup>H3289</sup> with his princes<sup>H8269</sup> and his mighty men<sup>H1368</sup> to stop<sup>H5640</sup> the waters<sup>H4325</sup> of the fountains<sup>H5869</sup> which were without<sup>H2351</sup> the city<sup>H5892</sup>: and they did help<sup>H5826</sup> him. 4 So there was gathered<sup>H6908</sup> much<sup>H7227</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup> together<sup>H6908</sup>, who stopped<sup>H5640</sup> all the fountains<sup>H4599</sup>, and the brook<sup>H5158</sup> that ran<sup>H7857</sup> through the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Why should the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> come<sup>H935</sup>, and find<sup>H4672</sup> much<sup>H7227</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup>?<sup>3</sup> 5 Also he strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> himself, and built up<sup>H1129</sup> all the wall<sup>H2346</sup> that was broken<sup>H6555</sup>, and raised it up<sup>H5927</sup> to the towers<sup>H4026</sup>, and another<sup>H312</sup> wall<sup>H2346</sup> without<sup>H2351</sup>, and repaired<sup>H2388</sup> Millo<sup>H4407</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, and made<sup>H6213</sup> darts<sup>H7973</sup> and shields<sup>H4043</sup> in abundance<sup>H7230</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 6 And he set<sup>H5414</sup> captains<sup>H8269</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> over the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and gathered them together<sup>H6908</sup> to him in the street<sup>H7339</sup> of the gate<sup>H8179</sup> of the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and spake<sup>H1696</sup> comfortably<sup>H3824</sup> to them, saying<sup>H559</sup>,<sup>5</sup> 7 Be strong<sup>H2388</sup> and courageous<sup>H553</sup>, be not afraid<sup>H3372</sup> nor dismayed<sup>H2865</sup> for<sup>H6440</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, nor for all the multitude<sup>H1995</sup> that is with him: for there be more<sup>H7227</sup> with us than with him: 8 With him is an arm<sup>H2220</sup> of flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, but with us is the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> to help<sup>H5826</sup> us, and to fight<sup>H3898</sup> our battles<sup>H4421</sup>. And the people<sup>H5971</sup> rested<sup>H5564</sup> themselves upon the words<sup>H1697</sup> of Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>.<sup>6</sup>

9 After<sup>H310</sup> this did Sennacherib<sup>H5576</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> send<sup>H7971</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, (but he himself laid siege against Lachish<sup>H3923</sup>, and all his power<sup>H4475</sup> with him,) unto Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and unto all Judah<sup>H3063</sup> that were at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>,<sup>7</sup> 10 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> Sennacherib<sup>H5576</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, Whereon do ye trust<sup>H982</sup>, that ye abide<sup>H3427</sup> in the siege<sup>H4692</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>?<sup>8</sup> 11 Doth not Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> persuade<sup>H5496</sup> you to give<sup>H5414</sup> over yourselves to die<sup>H4191</sup> by famine<sup>H7458</sup> and by thirst<sup>H6772</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> shall deliver<sup>H5337</sup> us out of the hand<sup>H3709</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>?<sup>9</sup> 12 Hath not the same Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> taken away<sup>H5493</sup> his high places<sup>H1116</sup> and his altars<sup>H4196</sup>, and commanded<sup>H559</sup> Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Ye shall worship<sup>H7812</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> one<sup>H259</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup>, and burn incense<sup>H6999</sup> upon it? 13 Know<sup>H3045</sup> ye not what I and my fathers<sup>H1</sup> have done<sup>H6213</sup> unto all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of other lands<sup>H776</sup>? were the gods<sup>H430</sup> of the nations<sup>H1471</sup> of those lands<sup>H776</sup> any ways<sup>H3201</sup> able<sup>H3201</sup> to deliver<sup>H5337</sup> their lands<sup>H776</sup> out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>?<sup>10</sup> 14 Who was there among all the gods<sup>H430</sup> of those nations<sup>H1471</sup> that my fathers<sup>H1</sup> utterly destroyed<sup>H2763</sup>, that could<sup>H3201</sup> deliver<sup>H5337</sup> his people<sup>H5971</sup> out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, that your God<sup>H430</sup> should be able<sup>H3201</sup> to deliver<sup>H5337</sup> you out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>?<sup>11</sup> 15 Now therefore let not<sup>H3808</sup> Hezekiah<sup>H2396</sup> deceive<sup>H5377</sup> you, nor persuade<sup>H5496</sup> you on this manner, neither yet believe<sup>H539</sup> him: for no god<sup>H433</sup> of any nation<sup>H1471</sup> or kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> was able<sup>H3201</sup> to deliver<sup>H5337</sup> his people<sup>H5971</sup> out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and out of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of my fathers<sup>H1</sup>: how much less shall your God<sup>H430</sup> deliver<sup>H5337</sup> you out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>?<sup>12</sup> 16 And his servants<sup>H5650</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> yet more against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, and against his servant<sup>H5650</sup> Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup>. 17 He wrote<sup>H3789</sup> also letters<sup>H5612</sup> to rail<sup>H2778</sup> on the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and to speak<sup>H559</sup> against him, saying<sup>H559</sup>, As the gods<sup>H430</sup> of the nations<sup>H1471</sup> of other lands<sup>H776</sup> have not delivered<sup>H5337</sup> their people<sup>H5971</sup> out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, so shall not the God<sup>H430</sup> of Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> deliver<sup>H5337</sup> his people<sup>H5971</sup> out of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>.<sup>13</sup> 18 Then they cried<sup>H7121</sup> with a loud<sup>H1419</sup> voice<sup>H6963</sup> in the Jews' speech<sup>H3066</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> that were on the wall<sup>H2346</sup>, to affright<sup>H3372</sup> them, and to trouble<sup>H926</sup> them; that they might take<sup>H3920</sup> the city<sup>H5892</sup>. 19 And they spake<sup>H1696</sup> against<sup>H5921</sup> the God<sup>H430</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, as against the gods<sup>H430</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>, which were the work<sup>H4639</sup> of the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>. 20 And for this cause Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> Isaiah<sup>H3470</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Amoz<sup>H531</sup>, prayed<sup>H6419</sup> and cried<sup>H2199</sup> to heaven<sup>H8064</sup>. 21 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> an angel<sup>H4397</sup>, which cut off<sup>H3582</sup> all the mighty men<sup>H1368</sup> of valour<sup>H2428</sup>,

and the leaders<sup>H5057</sup> and captains<sup>H8269</sup> in the camp<sup>H4264</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>. So he returned<sup>H7725</sup> with shame<sup>H1322</sup> of face<sup>H6440</sup> to his own land<sup>H776</sup>. And when he was come<sup>H935</sup> into the house<sup>H1004</sup> of his god<sup>H430</sup>, they that came forth<sup>H3329</sup> of his own bowels<sup>H4578</sup> slew<sup>H5307</sup> him there with the sword<sup>H2719 9</sup>. **22** Thus the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saved<sup>H3467</sup> Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> and the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> from the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Sennacherib<sup>H5576</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, and from the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of all other, and guided<sup>H5095</sup> them on every side<sup>H5439</sup>. **23** And many<sup>H7227</sup> brought<sup>H935</sup> gifts<sup>H4503</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and presents<sup>H4030</sup> to Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>: so that he was magnified<sup>H5375</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of all nations<sup>H1471</sup> from thenceforth<sup>H310 10</sup>.

**24** In those days<sup>H3117</sup> Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> was sick<sup>H2470</sup> to the death<sup>H4191</sup>, and prayed<sup>H6419</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and he spake<sup>H559</sup> unto him, and he gave<sup>H5414</sup> him a sign<sup>H4159 11</sup>. **25** But Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> rendered not again<sup>H7725</sup> according to the benefit<sup>H1576</sup> done unto him; for his heart<sup>H3820</sup> was lifted up<sup>H1361</sup>: therefore there was wrath<sup>H7110</sup> upon him, and upon Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. **26** Notwithstanding Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> humbled<sup>H3665</sup> himself for the pride<sup>H1363</sup> of his heart<sup>H3820</sup>, both he and the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, so that the wrath<sup>H7110</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> not upon them in the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup>. **27** And Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> had exceeding<sup>H3966</sup> much<sup>H7235</sup> riches<sup>H6239</sup> and honour<sup>H3519</sup>: and he made<sup>H6213</sup> himself treasuries<sup>H214</sup> for silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and for gold<sup>H2091</sup>, and for precious<sup>H3368</sup> stones<sup>H68</sup>, and for spices<sup>H1314</sup>, and for shields<sup>H4043</sup>, and for all manner of pleasant<sup>H2532</sup> jewels<sup>H3627,13</sup>. **28** Storehouses<sup>H4543</sup> also for the increase<sup>H8393</sup> of corn<sup>H1715</sup>, and wine<sup>H8492</sup>, and oil<sup>H3323</sup>; and stalls<sup>H723</sup> for all manner of beasts<sup>H929</sup>, and cotes<sup>H220</sup> for flocks<sup>H5739</sup>. **29** Moreover he provided<sup>H6213</sup> him cities<sup>H5892</sup>, and possessions<sup>H4735</sup> of flocks<sup>H6629</sup> and herds<sup>H1241</sup> in abundance<sup>H7230</sup>: for God<sup>H430</sup> had given<sup>H5414</sup> him substance<sup>H7399</sup> very<sup>H3966</sup> much<sup>H7227</sup>. **30** This same Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> also stopped<sup>H5640</sup> the upper<sup>H5945</sup> watercourse<sup>H4161 H4325</sup> of Gihon<sup>H1521</sup>, and brought it straight<sup>H3474</sup> down<sup>H4295</sup> to the west side<sup>H4628</sup> of the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. And Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> prospered<sup>H6743</sup> in all his works<sup>H4639</sup>. **31** Howbeit<sup>H3651</sup> in the business of the ambassadors<sup>H3887</sup> of the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, who sent<sup>H7971</sup> unto him to enquire<sup>H1875</sup> of the wonder<sup>H4159</sup> that was done in the land<sup>H776</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> left<sup>H5800</sup> him, to try<sup>H5254</sup> him, that he might know<sup>H3045</sup> all that was in his heart<sup>H3824 14</sup>. **32** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup>, and his goodness<sup>H2617</sup>, behold, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the vision<sup>H2377</sup> of Isaiah<sup>H3470</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Amoz<sup>H531</sup>, and in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and Israel<sup>H3478 15</sup>. **33** And Hezekiah<sup>H3169</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in the chiefest<sup>H4608</sup> of the sepulchres<sup>H6913</sup> of the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>: and all Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> did him<sup>H6213</sup> honour<sup>H3519</sup> at his death<sup>H4194</sup>. And Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.<sup>16</sup>
