

## 2. Kings 13



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

**1** In the three<sup>H7969 H8141</sup> and twentieth<sup>H6242</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehu<sup>H3058</sup> began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and reigned seventeen<sup>H7651</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. **2** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and followed<sup>H3212 H310</sup> the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, which made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>; he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not therefrom.<sup>2</sup> **3** And the anger<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and he delivered<sup>H5414</sup> them into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Hazael<sup>H2371</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, and into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Benhadad<sup>H1130</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Hazael<sup>H2371</sup>, all their days<sup>H3117</sup>. **4** And Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> besought<sup>H2470</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> unto<sup>H6440</sup> him: for he saw<sup>H7200</sup> the oppression<sup>H3906</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, because the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> oppressed<sup>H3905</sup> them. **5** (And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> a saviour<sup>H3467</sup>, so that they went out<sup>H3318</sup> from under the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the Syrians<sup>H758</sup>: and the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in their tents<sup>H168</sup>, as beforetime<sup>H8032 H8543</sup>. **6** Nevertheless they departed<sup>H5493</sup> not from the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> sin<sup>H2398</sup>, but walked<sup>H1980</sup> therein: and there remained<sup>H5975</sup> the grove<sup>H842</sup> also in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>.)<sup>45</sup> **7** Neither did he leave<sup>H7604</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> to Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> but fifty<sup>H2572</sup> horsemen<sup>H6571</sup>, and ten<sup>H6235</sup> chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and ten<sup>H6235</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> footmen<sup>H7273</sup>; for the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> had destroyed<sup>H6</sup> them, and had made<sup>H7760</sup> them like the dust<sup>H6083</sup> by threshing<sup>H1758</sup>. **8** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, and his might<sup>H1369</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? **9** And Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>; and they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>: and Joash<sup>H3101</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.

**10** In the thirty<sup>H7970 H8141</sup> and seventh<sup>H7651</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> began Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> to reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and reigned sixteen<sup>H8337 H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. **11** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not from all the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> sin<sup>H2398</sup>: but he walked<sup>H1980</sup> therein. **12** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, and his might<sup>H1369</sup> wherewith he fought<sup>H3898</sup> against Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? **13** And Joash<sup>H3101</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>; and Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> sat<sup>H3427</sup> upon his throne<sup>H3678</sup>: and Joash<sup>H3101</sup> was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup> with the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **14** Now Elisha<sup>H477</sup> was fallen sick<sup>H2470</sup> of his sickness<sup>H2483</sup> whereof he died<sup>H4191</sup>. And Joash<sup>H3101</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> came down<sup>H3381</sup> unto him, and wept<sup>H1058</sup> over his face<sup>H6440</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, O my father<sup>H1</sup>, my father<sup>H1</sup>, the chariot<sup>H7393</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and the horsemen<sup>H6571</sup> thereof. **15** And Elisha<sup>H477</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Take<sup>H3947</sup> bow<sup>H7198</sup> and arrows<sup>H2671</sup>. And he took<sup>H3947</sup> unto him bow<sup>H7198</sup> and arrows<sup>H2671</sup>. **16** And he said<sup>H559</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Put<sup>H7392</sup> thine hand<sup>H3027</sup> upon the bow<sup>H7198</sup>. And he put<sup>H7392</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> upon it: and Elisha<sup>H477</sup> put<sup>H7760</sup> his hands<sup>H3027</sup> upon the king's<sup>H4428</sup> hands<sup>H3027</sup>. **17** And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Open<sup>H6605</sup> the window<sup>H2474</sup> eastward<sup>H6924</sup>. And he opened<sup>H6605</sup> it. Then Elisha<sup>H477</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Shoot<sup>H3384</sup>. And he shot<sup>H3384</sup>. And he said<sup>H559</sup>, The arrow<sup>H2671</sup> of the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> deliverance<sup>H8668</sup>, and the arrow<sup>H2671</sup> of deliverance<sup>H8668</sup> from Syria<sup>H758</sup>: for thou shalt smite<sup>H5221</sup> the Syrians<sup>H758</sup> in Aphek<sup>H663</sup>, till thou have consumed<sup>H3615</sup> them. **18** And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Take<sup>H3947</sup> the arrows<sup>H2671</sup>. And he took<sup>H3947</sup> them. And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Smite<sup>H5221</sup> upon the ground<sup>H776</sup>. And he smote<sup>H5221</sup> thrice<sup>H7969 H6471</sup>, and stayed<sup>H5975</sup>. **19** And the man<sup>H376</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> was wroth<sup>H7107</sup> with him, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Thou shouldest have smitten<sup>H5221</sup> five<sup>H2568</sup> or six<sup>H8337</sup> times<sup>H6471</sup>; then hadst thou smitten<sup>H5221</sup> Syria<sup>H758</sup> till thou hadst consumed<sup>H3615</sup> it: whereas now thou shalt smite<sup>H5221</sup> Syria<sup>H758</sup> but thrice<sup>H7969 H6471</sup>.

**20** And Elisha<sup>H477</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup>, and they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him. And the bands<sup>H1416</sup> of the Moabites<sup>H4124</sup> invaded<sup>H935</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>

at the coming in<sup>H935</sup> of the year<sup>H8141</sup>. **21** And it came to pass, as they were burying<sup>H6912</sup> a man<sup>H376</sup>, that, behold, they spied<sup>H7200</sup> a band<sup>H1416</sup> of men; and they cast<sup>H7993</sup> the man<sup>H376</sup> into the sepulchre<sup>H6913</sup> of Elisha<sup>H477</sup>: and when the man<sup>H376</sup> was let down<sup>H3212</sup>, and touched<sup>H5060</sup> the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of Elisha<sup>H477</sup>, he revived<sup>H2421</sup>, and stood up<sup>H6965</sup> on his feet<sup>H7272</sup>. **7** **22** But Hazael<sup>H2371</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> oppressed<sup>H3905</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup>. **23** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was gracious<sup>H2603</sup> unto them, and had compassion<sup>H7355</sup> on them, and had respect<sup>H6437</sup> unto them, because of<sup>H4616</sup> his covenant<sup>H1285</sup> with Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, Isaac<sup>H3327</sup>, and Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, and would<sup>H14</sup> not destroy<sup>H7843</sup> them, neither cast<sup>H7993</sup> he them from his presence<sup>H6440</sup> as yet<sup>H5704</sup>. **8** **24** So Hazael<sup>H2371</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup>; and Benhadad<sup>H1130</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. **25** And Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup> out of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Benhadad<sup>H1130</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Hazael<sup>H2371</sup> the cities<sup>H5892</sup>, which he had taken<sup>H3947</sup> out of the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup> by war<sup>H4421</sup>. Three<sup>H7969</sup> times<sup>H6471</sup> did Joash<sup>H3101</sup> beat<sup>H5221</sup> him, and recovered<sup>H7725</sup> the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **9**
