

## 2. Kings 14

1 In the second<sup>H8147</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3099</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 2 He was twenty<sup>H6242</sup> and five<sup>H2568</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> twenty<sup>H6242</sup> and nine<sup>H8672</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. And his mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> was Jehoaddan<sup>H3086</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 3 And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, yet<sup>H7535</sup> not like David<sup>H1732</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup>: he did<sup>H6213</sup> according to all things as Joash<sup>H3101</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup>. 4 Howbeit the high places<sup>H1116</sup> were not taken away<sup>H5493</sup>: as yet<sup>H5750</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> did sacrifice<sup>H2076</sup> and burnt incense<sup>H6999</sup> on the high places<sup>H1116</sup>. 5 And it came to pass, as soon as the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> was confirmed<sup>H2388</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, that he slew<sup>H5221</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup> which had slain<sup>H5221</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup>. 6 But the children<sup>H1121</sup> of the murderers<sup>H5221</sup> he slew<sup>H4191</sup> not: according unto that which is written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the law<sup>H8451</sup> of Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, wherein the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The fathers<sup>H1</sup> shall not be put to death<sup>H4191</sup> for the children<sup>H1121</sup>, nor the children<sup>H1121</sup> be put to death<sup>H4191</sup> for the fathers<sup>H1</sup>; but every man<sup>H376</sup> shall be put to death<sup>H4191</sup> for his own sin<sup>H2399</sup>. 7 He slew<sup>H5221</sup> of Edom<sup>H123</sup> in the valley<sup>H1516</sup> of salt<sup>H4417</sup> ten<sup>H6235</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup>, and took<sup>H8610</sup> Selah<sup>H5554</sup> by war<sup>H4421</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of it Joktheel<sup>H3371</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>.

8 Then Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> messengers<sup>H4397</sup> to Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehu<sup>H3058</sup>, king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Come<sup>H3212</sup>, let us look<sup>H7200</sup> one another in the face<sup>H6440</sup>. 9 And Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> to Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The thistle<sup>H2336</sup> that was in Lebanon<sup>H3844</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> to the cedar<sup>H730</sup> that was in Lebanon<sup>H3844</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Give<sup>H5414</sup> thy daughter<sup>H1323</sup> to my son<sup>H1121</sup> to wife<sup>H802</sup>: and there passed<sup>H5674</sup> by a wild<sup>H7704</sup> beast<sup>H2416</sup> that was in Lebanon<sup>H3844</sup>, and trode down<sup>H7429</sup> the thistle<sup>H2336</sup>. 10 Thou hast indeed<sup>H5221</sup> smitten<sup>H5221</sup> Edom<sup>H123</sup>, and thine heart<sup>H3820</sup> hath lifted thee up<sup>H5375</sup>: glory<sup>H3513</sup> of this, and tarry<sup>H3427</sup> at home<sup>H1004</sup>: for why shouldst thou meddle<sup>H1624</sup> to thy hurt<sup>H7451</sup>, that thou shouldst fall<sup>H5307</sup>, even thou, and Judah<sup>H3063</sup> with thee? 11 But Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> would not hear<sup>H8085</sup>. Therefore Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup>; and he and Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> looked<sup>H7200</sup> one another in the face<sup>H6440</sup> at Bethshemesh<sup>H1053</sup>, which belongeth to Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. 12 And Judah<sup>H3063</sup> was put to the worse<sup>H5062</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and they fled<sup>H5127</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> to their tents<sup>H168</sup>. 13 And Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> took<sup>H8610</sup> Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Ahaziah<sup>H274</sup>, at Bethshemesh<sup>H1053</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and brake down<sup>H6555</sup> the wall<sup>H2346</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> from the gate<sup>H8179</sup> of Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> unto the corner<sup>H6438</sup> gate<sup>H8179</sup>, four<sup>H702</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 14 And he took<sup>H3947</sup> all the gold<sup>H2091</sup> and silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and all the vessels<sup>H3627</sup> that were found<sup>H4672</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and in the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and hostages<sup>H1121</sup> H8594, and returned<sup>H7725</sup> to Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>.

15 Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> which he did<sup>H6213</sup>, and his might<sup>H1369</sup>, and how he fought<sup>H3898</sup> with Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697</sup> H3117 of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? 16 And Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup> with the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. 17 And Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> lived<sup>H2421</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> the death<sup>H4194</sup> of Jehoash<sup>H3060</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoahaz<sup>H3059</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> fifteen<sup>H2568</sup> H6240 years<sup>H8141</sup>. 18 And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Amaziah<sup>H558</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697</sup> H3117 of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? 19 Now they made<sup>H7194</sup> a conspiracy<sup>H7195</sup> against him in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>: and he fled<sup>H5127</sup> to Lachish<sup>H3923</sup>; but they sent<sup>H7971</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> him to Lachish<sup>H3923</sup>, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> him there. 20 And they brought<sup>H5375</sup> him on horses<sup>H5483</sup>: and he was buried<sup>H6912</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. 21 And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> Azariah<sup>H5838</sup>, which was sixteen<sup>H8337</sup> H6240 years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup>, and made him king<sup>H4427</sup> instead of his father<sup>H1</sup>.

Amaziah<sup>H558</sup>. **22** He built<sup>H1129</sup> Elath<sup>H359</sup>, and restored<sup>H7725</sup> it to Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> that the king<sup>H4428</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>.

**23** In the fifteenth<sup>H2568 H6240 H8141</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and reigned forty<sup>H705</sup> and one<sup>H259</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. **24** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not from all the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. **25** He restored<sup>H7725</sup> the coast<sup>H1366</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from the entering<sup>H935</sup> of Hamath<sup>H2574</sup> unto the sea<sup>H3220</sup> of the plain<sup>H6160</sup>, according to the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, which he spake<sup>H1696</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of his servant<sup>H5650</sup> Jonah<sup>H3124</sup>, the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Amittai<sup>H573</sup>, the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, which was of Gathhepher<sup>H1662</sup>. **26** For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> the affliction<sup>H6040</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, that it was very<sup>H3966</sup> bitter<sup>H4784</sup>: for there was not<sup>H657</sup> any shut up<sup>H6113</sup>, nor any left<sup>H5800</sup>, nor any helper<sup>H5826</sup> for Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **27** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H1696</sup> not that he would blot out<sup>H4229</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from under heaven<sup>H8064</sup>: but he saved<sup>H3467</sup> them by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Joash<sup>H3101</sup>. **28** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, and his might<sup>H1369</sup>, how he warred<sup>H3898</sup>, and how he recovered<sup>H7725</sup> Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>, and Hamath<sup>H2574</sup>, which belonged to Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, for Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? **29** And Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, even with the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; and Zachariah<sup>H2148</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.
