

## 2. Kings 15

**1** In the twenty<sup>H6242 H8141</sup> and seventh<sup>H7651</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> began Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> of Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> to reign<sup>H4427</sup>. **2** Sixteen<sup>H8337 H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> was he when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> two<sup>H8147</sup> and fifty<sup>H2572</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. And his mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> was Jeholiah<sup>H3203</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. **3** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, according to all that his father<sup>H1</sup> Amaziah<sup>H558</sup> had done<sup>H6213</sup>; **4** Save that the high places<sup>H1116</sup> were not removed<sup>H5493</sup>: the people<sup>H5971</sup> sacrificed<sup>H2076</sup> and burnt incense<sup>H6999</sup> still on the high places<sup>H1116</sup>. **5** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> smote<sup>H5060</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, so that he was a leper<sup>H6879</sup> unto the day<sup>H3117</sup> of his death<sup>H4194</sup>, and dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in a several<sup>H2669</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>. And Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> the king's<sup>H4428</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> was over the house<sup>H1004</sup>, judging<sup>H8199</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>. **6** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Azariah<sup>H5838</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? **7** So Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and they buried<sup>H6912</sup> him with his fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>: and Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.

**8** In the thirty<sup>H7970 H8141</sup> and eighth<sup>H8083</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> did Zachariah<sup>H2148</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup> six<sup>H8337</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup>. **9** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, as his fathers<sup>H1</sup> had done<sup>H6213</sup>: he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not from the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. **10** And Shallum<sup>H7967</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jabesh<sup>H3003</sup> conspired<sup>H7194</sup> against him, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> him before<sup>H6905</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> him, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. **11** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Zachariah<sup>H2148</sup>, behold, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **12** This was the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> which he spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Jehu<sup>H3058</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Thy sons<sup>H1121</sup> shall sit<sup>H3427</sup> on the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> unto the fourth<sup>H7243</sup> generation. And so it came to pass. **13** Shallum<sup>H7967</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jabesh<sup>H3003</sup> began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> in the nine<sup>H8672</sup> and thirtieth<sup>H7970</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>; and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> a full<sup>H3117</sup> month<sup>H3391</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>. **14** For Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Gadi<sup>H1424</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> from Tirzah<sup>H8656</sup>, and came<sup>H935</sup> to Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> Shallum<sup>H7967</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jabesh<sup>H3003</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> him, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. **15** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Shallum<sup>H7967</sup>, and his conspiracy<sup>H7195</sup> which he made<sup>H7194</sup>, behold, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **16** Then Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> Tiphshah<sup>H8607</sup>, and all that were therein, and the coasts<sup>H1366</sup> thereof from Tirzah<sup>H8656</sup>: because they opened<sup>H6605</sup> not to him, therefore he smote<sup>H5221</sup> it; and all the women therein that were with child<sup>H2030</sup> he ripped up<sup>H1234</sup>. **17** In the nine<sup>H8672 H8141</sup> and thirtieth<sup>H7970</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> began Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Gadi<sup>H1424</sup> to reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and reigned ten<sup>H6235</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>. **18** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not all his days<sup>H3117</sup> from the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. **19** And Pul<sup>H6322</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> against the land<sup>H776</sup>: and Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> Pul<sup>H6322</sup> a thousand<sup>H505</sup> talents<sup>H3603</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, that his hand<sup>H3027</sup> might be with him to confirm<sup>H2388</sup> the kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **20** And Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> exacted<sup>H3318</sup> the money<sup>H3701</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, even of all the mighty men<sup>H1368</sup> of wealth<sup>H2428</sup>, of each<sup>H259</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> fifty<sup>H2572</sup> shekels<sup>H8255</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup>, to give<sup>H5414</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>. So the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> turned back<sup>H7725</sup>, and stayed<sup>H5975</sup> not there in the land<sup>H776</sup>. **21** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Menahem<sup>H4505</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? **22** And Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>; and Pekahiah<sup>H6494</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. **23** In the fiftieth<sup>H2572 H8141</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> Pekahiah<sup>H6494</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Menahem<sup>H4505</sup> began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and reigned two years<sup>H8141</sup>. **24** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the

sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not from the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. **25** But Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup>, a captain<sup>H7991</sup> of his, conspired<sup>H7194</sup> against him, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> him in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, in the palace<sup>H759</sup> of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, with Argob<sup>H709</sup> and Arie<sup>H745</sup>, and with him fifty<sup>H2572</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> of the Gileadites<sup>H1121</sup><sup>H1569</sup>: and he killed<sup>H4191</sup> him, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his room. **26** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Pekahiah<sup>H6494</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, behold, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697</sup><sup>H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **27** In the two<sup>H8147</sup><sup>H8141</sup> and fiftieth<sup>H2572</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Azariah<sup>H5838</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup> began to reign<sup>H4427</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and reigned twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. **28** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: he departed<sup>H5493</sup> not from the sins<sup>H2403</sup> of Jeroboam<sup>H3379</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nebat<sup>H5028</sup>, who made Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>. **29** In the days<sup>H3117</sup> of Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> Tiglathpileser<sup>H8407</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, and took<sup>H3947</sup> Ijon<sup>H5859</sup>, and Abelbethmaachah<sup>H62</sup>, and Janoah<sup>H3239</sup>, and Kedesh<sup>H6943</sup>, and Hazor<sup>H2674</sup>, and Gilead<sup>H1568</sup>, and Galilee<sup>H1551</sup>, all the land<sup>H776</sup> of Naphtali<sup>H5321</sup>, and carried them captive<sup>H1540</sup> to Assyria<sup>H804</sup>. **30** And Hoshea<sup>H1954</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Elah<sup>H425</sup> made<sup>H7194</sup> a conspiracy<sup>H7195</sup> against Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup>, and smote<sup>H5221</sup> him, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> him, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead, in the twentieth<sup>H6242</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup>. **31** And the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Pekah<sup>H6492</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, behold, they are written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697</sup><sup>H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.

**32** In the second<sup>H8147</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> began Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> to reign<sup>H4427</sup>. **33** Five<sup>H2568</sup> and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> was he when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> sixteen<sup>H8337</sup><sup>H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. And his mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> was Jerusha<sup>H3388</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Zadok<sup>H6659</sup>. **34** And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: he did<sup>H6213</sup> according to all that his father<sup>H1</sup> Uzziah<sup>H5818</sup> had done<sup>H6213</sup>. **35** Howbeit the high places<sup>H1116</sup> were not removed<sup>H5493</sup>: the people<sup>H5971</sup> sacrificed<sup>H2076</sup> and burned incense<sup>H6999</sup> still in the high places<sup>H1116</sup>. He built<sup>H1129</sup> the higher<sup>H5945</sup> gate<sup>H8179</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **36** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Jotham<sup>H3147</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697</sup><sup>H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? **37** In those days<sup>H3117</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> began<sup>H2490</sup> to send<sup>H7971</sup> against Judah<sup>H3063</sup> Rezin<sup>H7526</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, and Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup>. **38** And Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup>: and Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.
