## 2. Kings 16

**1** In the seventeenth<sup>H7651 H6240 H8141</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jotham<sup>H3147</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>. **2** Twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> was Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> sixteen<sup>H8337 H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and did<sup>H6213</sup> not that which was right<sup>H3477</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>, like David<sup>H1732</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup>. **3** But he walked<sup>H3212</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, yea, and made his son<sup>H1121</sup> to pass through<sup>H5674</sup> the fire<sup>H784</sup>, according to the abominations<sup>H8441</sup> of the heathen<sup>H1471</sup>, whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> cast out<sup>H3423</sup> from before<sup>H6440</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. **4** And he sacrificed<sup>H2076</sup> and burnt incense<sup>H6999</sup> in the high places<sup>H1116</sup>, and on the hills<sup>H1389</sup>, and under every green<sup>H7488</sup> tree<sup>H6086</sup>.

**5** Then Rezin<sup>H7526</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> and Pekah<sup>H6492</sup> son<sup>H1121</sup> of Remaliah<sup>H7425</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> came up<sup>H5927</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> to war<sup>H4421</sup>: and they besieged<sup>H6696</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup>, but could<sup>H3201</sup> not overcome<sup>H3898</sup> him. **6** At that time<sup>H6256</sup> Rezin<sup>H7526</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup> recovered<sup>H7725</sup> Elath<sup>H359</sup> to Syria<sup>H758 H130</sup>, and drave<sup>H5394</sup> the Jews<sup>H3064</sup> from Elath<sup>H359</sup>: and the Syrians<sup>H726</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Elath<sup>H359</sup>, and dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> there unto this day<sup>H3117.1</sup> **7** So Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> messengers<sup>H4397</sup> to Tiglathpileser<sup>H8407</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, I am thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> and thy son<sup>H1121</sup>: come up<sup>H5927</sup>, and save<sup>H3467</sup> me out of the hand<sup>H3709</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Syria<sup>H758</sup>, and out of the hand<sup>H3709</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, which rise up<sup>H6965</sup> against me. **8** And Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> the silver<sup>H3701</sup> and gold<sup>H2091</sup> that was found<sup>H4672</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and in the treasures<sup>H214</sup> of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, and sent<sup>H7971</sup> it for a present<sup>H7810</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>. **9** And the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> unto him: for the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> against Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>, and took<sup>H8610</sup> it, and carried the people of it captive<sup>H1540</sup> to Kir<sup>H7024</sup>, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> Rezin<sup>H7526</sup>.

10 And king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> to Damascus<sup>H1834</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> Tiglathpileser<sup>H8407</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Assyria<sup>H804</sup>, and saw<sup>H7200</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> that was at Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>: and king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> to Urijah<sup>H223</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> the fashion<sup>H1823</sup> of the altar<sup>H4196</sup>, and the pattern<sup>H8403</sup> of it, according to all the workmanship<sup>H4639</sup> thereof.<sup>3</sup> 11 And Urijah<sup>H223</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> according to all that king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> had sent<sup>H7971</sup> from Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>: so Urijah<sup>H223</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> it against king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> from Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>. **12** And when the king<sup>H4428</sup> was come<sup>H935</sup> from Damascus<sup>H1834</sup>, the king<sup>H4428</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> the altar<sup>H4196</sup>: and the king<sup>H4428</sup> approached<sup>H7126</sup> to the altar<sup>H4196</sup>, and offered<sup>H5927</sup> thereon. **13** And he burnt<sup>H6999</sup> his burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup> and his meat offering<sup>H4503</sup>, and poured<sup>H5258</sup> his drink offering<sup>H5262</sup>, and sprinkled<sup>H2236</sup> the blood<sup>H1818</sup> of his peace offerings<sup>H8002</sup>, upon the altar<sup>H4196.4</sup> 14 And he brought<sup>H7126</sup> also the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup>, which was before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, from the forefront<sup>H6440</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup>, from between the altar<sup>H4196</sup> and the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and put<sup>H5414</sup> it on the north<sup>H6828</sup> side<sup>H3409</sup> of the altar<sup>H4196</sup>. **15** And king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> Urijah<sup>H223</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Upon the great<sup>H1419</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup> burn<sup>H6999</sup> the morning<sup>H1242</sup> burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>, and the evening<sup>H6153</sup> meat offering<sup>H4503</sup>, and the king's<sup>H4428</sup> burnt sacrifice<sup>H5930</sup>, and his meat offering<sup>H4503</sup>, with the burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup> of all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, and their meat offering<sup>H4503</sup>, and their drink offerings<sup>H5262</sup>; and sprinkle<sup>H2236</sup> upon it all the blood<sup>H1818</sup> of the burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>, and all the blood<sup>H1818</sup> of the sacrifice<sup>H2077</sup>: and the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> altar<sup>H4196</sup> shall be for me to enquire<sup>H1239</sup> by. **16** Thus did<sup>H6213</sup> Urijah<sup>H223</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, according to all that king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup>.

**17** And king<sup>H4428</sup> Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> cut off<sup>H7112</sup> the borders<sup>H4526</sup> of the bases<sup>H4350</sup>, and removed<sup>H5493</sup> the laver<sup>H3595</sup> from off them; and took down<sup>H3381</sup> the sea<sup>H3220</sup> from off the brasen<sup>H5178</sup> oxen<sup>H1241</sup> that were under it, and put<sup>H5414</sup> it upon a pavement<sup>H4837</sup> of stones<sup>H68</sup>. **18** And the covert<sup>H4329 H4329</sup> for the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> that they had built<sup>H1129</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup>, and the king's<sup>H4428</sup> entry<sup>H3996</sup> without<sup>H2435</sup>, turned<sup>H5437</sup> he from the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for<sup>H6440</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of

Assyria<sup>H804</sup>. **19** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> which he did<sup>H6213</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? **20** And Ahaz<sup>H271</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>: and Hezekiah<sup>H2396</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.
