

## 2. Kings 21

1 Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> was twelve<sup>H8147 H6240</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and reigned<sup>H4427</sup> fifty<sup>H2572</sup> and five<sup>H2568</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. And his mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> was Hephzibah<sup>H2657</sup>. 2 And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, after the abominations<sup>H8441</sup> of the heathen<sup>H1471</sup>, whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> cast out<sup>H3423</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 3 For he built up<sup>H1129</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup> the high places<sup>H1116</sup> which Hezekiah<sup>H2396</sup> his father<sup>H1</sup> had destroyed<sup>H6</sup>; and he reared up<sup>H6965</sup> altars<sup>H4196</sup> for Baal<sup>H1168</sup>, and made<sup>H6213</sup> a grove<sup>H842</sup>, as did<sup>H6213</sup> Ahab<sup>H256</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; and worshipped<sup>H7812</sup> all the host<sup>H6635</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, and served<sup>H5647</sup> them. 4 And he built<sup>H1129</sup> altars<sup>H4196</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, of which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, In Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> will I put<sup>H7760</sup> my name<sup>H8034</sup>. 5 And he built<sup>H1129</sup> altars<sup>H4196</sup> for all the host<sup>H6635</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup> in the two<sup>H8147</sup> courts<sup>H2691</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 6 And he made his son<sup>H1121</sup> pass<sup>H5674</sup> through the fire<sup>H784</sup>, and observed times<sup>H6049</sup>, and used enchantments<sup>H5172</sup>, and dealt<sup>H6213</sup> with familiar spirits<sup>H178</sup> and wizards<sup>H3049</sup>: he wrought<sup>H6213</sup> much<sup>H7235</sup> wickedness<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, to provoke him to anger<sup>H3707</sup>. 7 And he set<sup>H7760</sup> a graven image<sup>H6459</sup> of the grove<sup>H842</sup> that he had made<sup>H6213</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup>, of which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and to Solomon<sup>H8010</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup>, In this house<sup>H1004</sup>, and in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, which I have chosen<sup>H977</sup> out of all tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, will I put<sup>H7760</sup> my name<sup>H8034</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 8 Neither will I make the feet<sup>H7272</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> move<sup>H5110</sup> any more<sup>H3254</sup> out of the land<sup>H127</sup> which I gave<sup>H5414</sup> their fathers<sup>H1</sup>; only if they will observe<sup>H8104</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> according to all that I have commanded<sup>H6680</sup> them, and according to all the law<sup>H8451</sup> that my servant<sup>H5650</sup> Moses<sup>H4872</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> them. 9 But they hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> not: and Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> seduced<sup>H8582</sup> them to do<sup>H6213</sup> more evil<sup>H7451</sup> than did the nations<sup>H1471</sup> whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.

10 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> by<sup>H3027</sup> his servants<sup>H5650</sup> the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 11 Because Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> hath done<sup>H6213</sup> these abominations<sup>H8441</sup>, and hath done wickedly<sup>H7489</sup> above all that the Amorites<sup>H567</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup>, which were before<sup>H6440</sup> him, and hath made Judah<sup>H3063</sup> also to sin<sup>H2398</sup> with his idols<sup>H1544</sup>: 12 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Behold, I am bringing<sup>H935</sup> such evil<sup>H7451</sup> upon Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, that whosoever heareth<sup>H8085</sup> of it, both<sup>H8147</sup> his ears<sup>H241</sup> shall tingle<sup>H6750</sup>. 13 And I will stretch<sup>H5186</sup> over Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> the line<sup>H6957</sup> of Samaria<sup>H8111</sup>, and the plummet<sup>H4949</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahab<sup>H256</sup>: and I will wipe<sup>H4229</sup> Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> as a man wipeth<sup>H4229</sup> a dish<sup>H6747</sup>, wiping<sup>H4229</sup> it, and turning<sup>H2015</sup> it upside down<sup>H6440</sup>. 14 And I will forsake<sup>H5203</sup> the remnant<sup>H7611</sup> of mine inheritance<sup>H5159</sup>, and deliver<sup>H5414</sup> them into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of their enemies<sup>H341</sup>; and they shall become a prey<sup>H957</sup> and a spoil<sup>H4933</sup> to all their enemies<sup>H341</sup>: 15 Because they have done<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in my sight<sup>H5869</sup>, and have provoked<sup>H4480</sup> me to anger<sup>H3707</sup>, since the day<sup>H3117</sup> their fathers<sup>H1</sup> came forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, even unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>. 16 Moreover Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> shed<sup>H8210</sup> innocent<sup>H5355</sup> blood<sup>H1818</sup> very<sup>H3966</sup> much<sup>H7235</sup>, till he had filled<sup>H4390</sup> Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> from one end<sup>H6310</sup> to another<sup>H6310</sup>, beside his sin<sup>H2403</sup> wherewith he made Judah<sup>H3063</sup> to sin<sup>H2398</sup>, in doing<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 17 Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup>, and all that he did<sup>H6213</sup>, and his sin<sup>H2403</sup> that he sinned<sup>H2398</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? 18 And Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> slept<sup>H7901</sup> with his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in the garden<sup>H1588</sup> of his own house<sup>H1004</sup>, in the garden<sup>H1588</sup> of Uzza<sup>H5798</sup>: and Amon<sup>H526</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.

19 Amon<sup>H526</sup> was twenty<sup>H6242</sup> and two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> two<sup>H8147</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. And his mother's<sup>H517</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup> was Meshullemeth<sup>H4922</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of Haruz<sup>H2743</sup> of Jotbah<sup>H3192</sup>. 20 And he did<sup>H6213</sup> that which was evil<sup>H7451</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, as his father<sup>H1</sup> Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup>. 21 And he walked<sup>H3212</sup> in all the way<sup>H1870</sup> that his father<sup>H1</sup> walked in<sup>H1980</sup>, and served<sup>H5647</sup> the idols<sup>H1544</sup> that his father<sup>H1</sup> served<sup>H5647</sup>, and worshipped<sup>H7812</sup> them: 22 And he forsook<sup>H5800</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of

his fathers<sup>H1</sup>, and walked<sup>H1980</sup> not in the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **23** And the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Amon<sup>H526</sup> conspired<sup>H7194</sup> against him, and slew<sup>H4191</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> in his own house<sup>H1004</sup>. **24** And the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> slew<sup>H5221</sup> all them that had conspired<sup>H7194</sup> against king<sup>H4428</sup> Amon<sup>H526</sup>; and the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> made Josiah<sup>H2977</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> king<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead. **25** Now the rest<sup>H3499</sup> of the acts<sup>H1697</sup> of Amon<sup>H526</sup> which he did<sup>H6213</sup>, are they not written<sup>H3789</sup> in the book<sup>H5612</sup> of the chronicles<sup>H1697 H3117</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? **26** And he was buried<sup>H6912</sup> in his sepulchre<sup>H6900</sup> in the garden<sup>H1588</sup> of Uzza<sup>H5798</sup>; and Josiah<sup>H2977</sup> his son<sup>H1121</sup> reigned<sup>H4427</sup> in his stead.<sup>3</sup>
