

## 2. Samuel 15

1 And it came to pass after this<sup>H310</sup>, that Absalom<sup>H53</sup> prepared<sup>H6213</sup> him chariots<sup>H4818</sup> and horses<sup>H5483</sup>, and fifty<sup>H2572</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> to run<sup>H7323</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> him. 2 And Absalom<sup>H53</sup> rose up early<sup>H7925</sup>, and stood<sup>H5975</sup> beside<sup>H3027</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the gate<sup>H8179</sup>: and it was so, that when any man<sup>H376</sup> that had a controversy<sup>H7379</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> for judgment<sup>H4941</sup>, then Absalom<sup>H53</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> unto him, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Of what<sup>H335</sup> city<sup>H5892</sup> art thou? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> is of one<sup>H259</sup> of the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 3 And Absalom<sup>H53</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, See<sup>H7200</sup>, thy matters<sup>H1697</sup> are good<sup>H2896</sup> and right<sup>H5228</sup>; but there is no man deputed of the king<sup>H4428</sup> to hear<sup>H8085</sup> thee.<sup>2</sup> 4 Absalom<sup>H53</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> moreover, Oh that I were made<sup>H7760</sup> judge<sup>H8199</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup>, that every man<sup>H376</sup> which hath any suit<sup>H7379</sup> or cause<sup>H4941</sup> might come<sup>H935</sup> unto me, and I would do him justice<sup>H6663</sup>! 5 And it was so, that when any man<sup>H376</sup> came night<sup>H7126</sup> to him to do him obeisance<sup>H7812</sup>, he put forth<sup>H7971</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and took<sup>H2388</sup> him, and kissed<sup>H5401</sup> him. 6 And on this manner<sup>H1697</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> Absalom<sup>H53</sup> to all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> that came<sup>H935</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> for judgment<sup>H4941</sup>: so Absalom<sup>H53</sup> stole<sup>H1589</sup> the hearts<sup>H3820</sup> of the men<sup>H582</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.

7 And it came to pass after<sup>H7093</sup> forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>, that Absalom<sup>H53</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>, I pray thee, let me go<sup>H3212</sup> and pay<sup>H7999</sup> my vow<sup>H5088</sup>, which I have vowed<sup>H5087</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, in Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>. 8 For thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> vowed<sup>H5087</sup> a vow<sup>H5088</sup> while I abode<sup>H3427</sup> at Geshur<sup>H1650</sup> in Syria<sup>H758</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, If the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall bring me again<sup>H7725</sup> indeed to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, then I will serve<sup>H5647</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 9 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Go<sup>H3212</sup> in peace<sup>H7965</sup>. So he arose<sup>H6965</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> to Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>. 10 But Absalom<sup>H53</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> spies<sup>H7270</sup> throughout all the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, As soon as ye hear<sup>H8085</sup> the sound<sup>H6963</sup> of the trumpet<sup>H7782</sup>, then ye shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Absalom<sup>H53</sup> reigneth<sup>H4427</sup> in Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>. 11 And with Absalom<sup>H53</sup> went<sup>H1980</sup> two hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> out of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, that were called<sup>H7121</sup>; and they went<sup>H1980</sup> in their simplicity<sup>H8537</sup>, and they knew<sup>H3045</sup> not any thing<sup>H1697</sup>. 12 And Absalom<sup>H53</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> for Ahithophel<sup>H302</sup> the Gilonite<sup>H1526</sup>, David's<sup>H1732</sup> counsellor<sup>H3289</sup>, from his city<sup>H5892</sup>, even from Giloh<sup>H1542</sup>, while he offered<sup>H2076</sup> sacrifices<sup>H2077</sup>. And the conspiracy<sup>H7195</sup> was strong<sup>H533</sup>; for the people<sup>H5971</sup> increased<sup>H7227</sup> continually<sup>H1980</sup> with Absalom<sup>H53</sup>.

13 And there came<sup>H935</sup> a messenger<sup>H5046</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The hearts<sup>H3820</sup> of the men<sup>H376</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> are after<sup>H310</sup> Absalom<sup>H53</sup>. 14 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto all his servants<sup>H5650</sup> that were with him at Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, Arise<sup>H6965</sup>, and let us flee<sup>H1272</sup>, for we shall not else escape<sup>H6413</sup> from<sup>H6440</sup> Absalom<sup>H53</sup>: make speed<sup>H4116</sup> to depart<sup>H3212</sup>, lest he overtake<sup>H5381</sup> us suddenly<sup>H4116</sup>, and bring<sup>H5080</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> upon us, and smite<sup>H5221</sup> the city<sup>H5892</sup> with the edge<sup>H6310</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup>. 15 And the king's<sup>H4428</sup> servants<sup>H5650</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the king<sup>H4428</sup>, Behold, thy servants<sup>H5650</sup> are ready to do whatsoever my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> shall appoint<sup>H977</sup>. 16 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> went forth<sup>H3318</sup>, and all his household<sup>H1004</sup> after<sup>H7272</sup> him. And the king<sup>H4428</sup> left<sup>H5800</sup> ten<sup>H6235</sup> women<sup>H802</sup>, which were concubines<sup>H6370</sup>, to keep<sup>H8104</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup>. 17 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> went forth<sup>H3318</sup>, and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> after<sup>H7272</sup> him, and tarried<sup>H5975</sup> in a place<sup>H1004</sup> that was far off<sup>H4801</sup> H1023. 18 And all his servants<sup>H5650</sup> passed on<sup>H5674</sup> beside<sup>H3027</sup> him; and all the Cherethites<sup>H3774</sup>, and all the Pelethites<sup>H6432</sup>, and all the Gittites<sup>H1663</sup>, six<sup>H8337</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> men<sup>H376</sup> which came<sup>H935</sup> after<sup>H7272</sup> him from Gath<sup>H1661</sup>, passed on<sup>H5674</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>. 19 Then said<sup>H559</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> to Ittai<sup>H863</sup> the Gittite<sup>H1663</sup>, Wherefore goest<sup>H3212</sup> thou also with us? return<sup>H7725</sup> to thy place<sup>H4725</sup>, and abide<sup>H3427</sup> with the king<sup>H4428</sup>: for thou art a stranger<sup>H5237</sup>, and also an exile<sup>H1540</sup>. 20 Whereas thou camest<sup>H935</sup> but yesterday<sup>H8543</sup>, should I this day<sup>H3117</sup> make thee go<sup>H3212</sup> up and down<sup>H5128</sup> H5128 with us? seeing I go<sup>H1980</sup> whither I may, return<sup>H7725</sup> thou, and take back<sup>H7725</sup> thy brethren<sup>H251</sup>: mercy<sup>H2617</sup> and truth<sup>H571</sup> be with thee. 21 And Ittai<sup>H863</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, As the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>, and as my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> liveth<sup>H2416</sup>, surely in what place<sup>H4725</sup> my lord<sup>H113</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> shall be, whether in death<sup>H4194</sup> or life<sup>H2416</sup>, even there also will thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> be. 22 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Ittai<sup>H863</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> and pass over<sup>H5674</sup>. And Ittai<sup>H863</sup> the Gittite<sup>H1663</sup> passed over<sup>H5674</sup>, and all his men<sup>H582</sup>, and all the little

ones<sup>H2945</sup> that were with him. **23** And all the country<sup>H776</sup> wept<sup>H1058</sup> with a loud<sup>H1419</sup> voice<sup>H6963</sup>, and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> passed over<sup>H5674</sup>: the king<sup>H4428</sup> also himself passed over<sup>H5674</sup> the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Kidron<sup>H6939</sup>, and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> passed over<sup>H5674</sup>, toward<sup>H6440</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>.<sup>7</sup>

**24** And lo Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> also, and all the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> were with him, bearing<sup>H5375</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>: and they set down<sup>H3332</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>; and Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup>, until all the people<sup>H5971</sup> had done<sup>H8552</sup> passing<sup>H5674</sup> out of the city<sup>H5892</sup>. **25** And the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Zadok<sup>H6659</sup>, Carry back<sup>H7725</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> into the city<sup>H5892</sup>: if I shall find<sup>H4672</sup> favour<sup>H2580</sup> in the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, he will bring me again<sup>H7725</sup>, and shew<sup>H7200</sup> me both it, and his habitation<sup>H5116</sup>: **26** But if he thus say<sup>H559</sup>, I have no delight<sup>H2654</sup> in thee; behold, here am I, let him do<sup>H6213</sup> to me as seemeth<sup>H5869</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup> unto him. **27** The king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> also unto Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, Art not thou a seer<sup>H7200</sup>? return<sup>H7725</sup> into the city<sup>H5892</sup> in peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and your two<sup>H8147</sup> sons<sup>H1121</sup> with you, Ahimaa<sup>H290</sup> thy son<sup>H1121</sup>, and Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Abiathar<sup>H54</sup>. **28** See<sup>H7200</sup>, I will tarry<sup>H4102</sup> in the plain<sup>H6160</sup><sup>H5679</sup> of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>, until there come<sup>H935</sup> word<sup>H1697</sup> from you to certify<sup>H5046</sup> me. **29** Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> therefore and Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> carried<sup>H7725</sup> the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>: and they tarried<sup>H3427</sup> there. **30** And David<sup>H1732</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> by the ascent<sup>H4608</sup> of mount Olivet<sup>H2132</sup>, and wept<sup>H1058</sup> as he went up<sup>H5927</sup>, and had his head<sup>H7218</sup> covered<sup>H2645</sup>, and he went<sup>H1980</sup> barefoot<sup>H3182</sup>: and all the people<sup>H5971</sup> that was with him covered<sup>H2645</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> his head<sup>H7218</sup>, and they went up<sup>H5927</sup>, weeping<sup>H1058</sup> as they went up<sup>H5927</sup>.<sup>8</sup>

**31** And one told<sup>H5046</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Ahithophel<sup>H302</sup> is among the conspirators<sup>H7194</sup> with Absalom<sup>H53</sup>. And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, I pray thee, turn the counsel<sup>H6098</sup> of Ahithophel<sup>H302</sup> into foolishness<sup>H5528</sup>. **32** And it came to pass, that when David<sup>H1732</sup> was come<sup>H935</sup> to the top<sup>H7218</sup> of the mount, where he worshipped<sup>H7812</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, behold, Hushai<sup>H2365</sup> the Archite<sup>H757</sup> came to meet<sup>H7125</sup> him with his coat<sup>H3801</sup> rent<sup>H7167</sup>, and earth<sup>H127</sup> upon his head<sup>H7218</sup>: **33** Unto whom David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, If thou passest on<sup>H5674</sup> with me, then thou shalt be a burden<sup>H4853</sup> unto me: **34** But if thou return<sup>H7725</sup> to the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto Absalom<sup>H53</sup>, I will be thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>, O king<sup>H4428</sup>, as I have been thy father's<sup>H1</sup> servant<sup>H5650</sup> hitherto<sup>H227</sup>, so will I now also be thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>: then mayest thou for me defeat<sup>H6565</sup> the counsel<sup>H6098</sup> of Ahithophel<sup>H302</sup>. **35** And hast thou not there with thee Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> and Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the priests<sup>H3548</sup>? therefore it shall be, that what thing<sup>H1697</sup> soever thou shalt hear<sup>H8085</sup> out of the king's<sup>H4428</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, thou shalt tell<sup>H5046</sup> it to Zadok<sup>H6659</sup> and Abiathar<sup>H54</sup> the priests<sup>H3548</sup>. **36** Behold, they have there with them their two<sup>H8147</sup> sons<sup>H1121</sup>, Ahimaa<sup>H290</sup> Zadok's<sup>H6659</sup> son, and Jonathan<sup>H3083</sup> Abiathar's<sup>H54</sup> son; and by them<sup>H3027</sup> ye shall send<sup>H7971</sup> unto me every thing<sup>H1697</sup> that ye can hear<sup>H8085</sup>. **37** So Hushai<sup>H2365</sup> David's<sup>H1732</sup> friend<sup>H7463</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> into the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and Absalom<sup>H53</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> into Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>.
