

## 2. Samuel 5

1 Then came<sup>H935</sup> all the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup> unto Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>, and spake<sup>H559</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, we are thy bone<sup>H6106</sup> and thy flesh<sup>H1320</sup>. 2 Also in time past<sup>H865 H8032</sup>, when Saul<sup>H7586</sup> was king<sup>H4428</sup> over us, thou wast he that leddest out<sup>H3318</sup> and broughtest in<sup>H935</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to thee, Thou shalt feed<sup>H7462</sup> my people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and thou shalt be a captain<sup>H5057</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 3 So all the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup> to Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>; and king<sup>H4428</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> made<sup>H3772</sup> a league<sup>H1285</sup> with them in Hebron<sup>H2275</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and they anointed<sup>H4886</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 4 David<sup>H1732</sup> was thirty<sup>H7970</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he began to reign<sup>H4427</sup>, and he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. 5 In Hebron<sup>H2275</sup> he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> over Judah<sup>H3063</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> and six<sup>H8337</sup> months<sup>H2320</sup>: and in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> he reigned<sup>H4427</sup> thirty<sup>H7970</sup> and three<sup>H7969</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> over all Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>.

6 And the king<sup>H4428</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> to Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> unto the Jebusites<sup>H2983</sup>, the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>: which spake<sup>H559</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Except thou take away<sup>H5493</sup> the blind<sup>H5787</sup> and the lame<sup>H6455</sup>, thou shalt not come in<sup>H935</sup> hither: thinking<sup>H559</sup>, David<sup>H1732</sup> cannot come in<sup>H935</sup> hither.<sup>1</sup> 7 Nevertheless David<sup>H1732</sup> took<sup>H3920</sup> the strong hold<sup>H4686</sup> of Zion<sup>H6726</sup>: the same is the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. 8 And David<sup>H1732</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> on that day<sup>H3117</sup>, Whosoever getteth up<sup>H5060</sup> to the gutter<sup>H6794</sup>, and smiteth<sup>H5221</sup> the Jebusites<sup>H2983</sup>, and the lame<sup>H6455</sup> and the blind<sup>H5787</sup>, that are hated<sup>H8130</sup> of David's<sup>H1732</sup> soul<sup>H5315</sup>, he shall be chief and captain. Wherefore they said<sup>H559</sup>, The blind<sup>H5787</sup> and the lame<sup>H6455</sup> shall not come<sup>H935</sup> into the house<sup>H1004</sup>.<sup>2</sup> 9 So David<sup>H1732</sup> dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in the fort<sup>H4686</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> it the city<sup>H5892</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. And David<sup>H1732</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> from Millo<sup>H4407</sup> and inward<sup>H1004</sup>.<sup>3</sup> 10 And David<sup>H1732</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> on<sup>H1980</sup>, and grew great<sup>H1419</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup> was with him.<sup>3</sup>

11 And Hiram<sup>H2438</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Tyre<sup>H6865</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> messengers<sup>H4397</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>, and cedar<sup>H730</sup> trees<sup>H6086</sup>, and carpenters<sup>H2796</sup>, and masons<sup>H7023 H68</sup>: and they built<sup>H1129</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> an house<sup>H1004</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 12 And David<sup>H1732</sup> perceived<sup>H3045</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had established<sup>H3559</sup> him king<sup>H4428</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and that he had exalted<sup>H5375</sup> his kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> for his people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel's<sup>H3478</sup> sake. 13 And David<sup>H1732</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> him more concubines<sup>H6370</sup> and wives<sup>H802</sup> out of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> he was come<sup>H935</sup> from Hebron<sup>H2275</sup>: and there were yet sons<sup>H1121</sup> and daughters<sup>H1323</sup> born<sup>H3205</sup> to David<sup>H1732</sup>. 14 And these be the names<sup>H8034</sup> of those that were born<sup>H3209</sup> unto him in Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, Shammua<sup>H8051</sup>, and Shobab<sup>H7727</sup>, and Nathan<sup>H5416</sup>, and Solomon<sup>H8010</sup>, 15 Ibhar<sup>H2984</sup> also, and Elishua<sup>H474</sup>, and Nepheg<sup>H5298</sup>, and Japhia<sup>H3309</sup>, 16 And Elishama<sup>H476</sup>, and Eliada<sup>H450</sup>, and Eliphalet<sup>H467</sup>.

17 But when the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> that they had anointed<sup>H4886</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, all the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> came up<sup>H5927</sup> to seek<sup>H1245</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, and David<sup>H1732</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> of it, and went down<sup>H3381</sup> to the hold<sup>H4686</sup>. 18 The Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> also came<sup>H935</sup> and spread<sup>H5203</sup> themselves in the valley<sup>H6010</sup> of Rephaim<sup>H7497</sup>. 19 And David<sup>H1732</sup> enquired<sup>H7592</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Shall I go up<sup>H5927</sup> to the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>? wilt thou deliver<sup>H5414</sup> them into mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>? And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>, Go up<sup>H5927</sup>: for I will doubtless<sup>H5414</sup> deliver<sup>H5414</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 20 And David<sup>H1732</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Baalperazim<sup>H1188</sup>, and David<sup>H1732</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> them there, and said<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath broken forth<sup>H6555</sup> upon mine enemies<sup>H341</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> me, as the breach<sup>H6556</sup> of waters<sup>H4325</sup>. Therefore he called<sup>H7121</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of that place<sup>H4725</sup> Baalperazim<sup>H1188</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 21 And there they left<sup>H5800</sup> their images<sup>H6091</sup>, and David<sup>H1732</sup> and his men<sup>H582</sup> burned<sup>H5375</sup> them.<sup>6</sup> 22 And the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> came up<sup>H5927</sup> yet again<sup>H3254</sup>, and spread<sup>H5203</sup> themselves in the valley<sup>H6010</sup> of Rephaim<sup>H7497</sup>. 23 And when David<sup>H1732</sup> enquired<sup>H7592</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, he said<sup>H559</sup>, Thou shalt not go up<sup>H5927</sup>; but fetch a compass<sup>H5437</sup> behind<sup>H310</sup> them, and come<sup>H935</sup> upon them over against<sup>H4136</sup> the mulberry trees<sup>H1057</sup>. 24 And let it be, when thou hearest<sup>H8085</sup> the sound<sup>H6963</sup> of a going<sup>H6807</sup> in the tops<sup>H7218</sup> of the mulberry trees<sup>H1057</sup>, that then thou shalt bestir<sup>H2782</sup> thyself: for then shall the

LORD<sup>H3068</sup> go out<sup>H3318</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee, to smite<sup>H5221</sup> the host<sup>H4264</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>. **25** And David<sup>H1732</sup> did so<sup>H6213</sup>, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had commanded<sup>H6680</sup> him; and smote<sup>H5221</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup> from Geba<sup>H1387</sup> until thou come<sup>H935</sup> to Gazer<sup>H1507</sup>.

3. went...: Heb. went, going and growing
4. masons: Heb. hewers of the stone of the wall
5. Baalperazim: that is, the plain of breaches
6. burned...: or, took them away
