

## 2. Samuel 7

1 And it came to pass, when the king<sup>H4428</sup> sat<sup>H3427</sup> in his house<sup>H1004</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had given him rest<sup>H5117</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> from all his enemies<sup>H341</sup>; 2 That the king<sup>H4428</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Nathan<sup>H5416</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, See<sup>H7200</sup> now, I dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in an house<sup>H1004</sup> of cedar<sup>H730</sup>, but the ark<sup>H727</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> dwelleth<sup>H3427</sup> within<sup>H8432</sup> curtains<sup>H3407</sup>. 3 And Nathan<sup>H5416</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to the king<sup>H4428</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, do<sup>H6213</sup> all that is in thine heart<sup>H3824</sup>; for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is with thee.

4 And it came to pass that night<sup>H3915</sup>, that the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came unto Nathan<sup>H5416</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 5 Go<sup>H3212</sup> and tell<sup>H559</sup> my servant<sup>H5650</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Shalt thou build<sup>H1129</sup> me an house<sup>H1004</sup> for me to dwell in<sup>H3427</sup>? 6 Whereas I have not dwelt<sup>H3427</sup> in any house<sup>H1004</sup> since the time<sup>H3117</sup> that I brought up<sup>H5927</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, even to this day<sup>H3117</sup>, but have walked<sup>H1980</sup> in a tent<sup>H168</sup> and in a tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup>. 7 In all the places wherein I have walked<sup>H1980</sup> with all the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> I a word<sup>H1697</sup> with any<sup>H259</sup> of the tribes<sup>H7626</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, whom I commanded<sup>H6680</sup> to feed<sup>H7462</sup> my people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Why build<sup>H1129</sup> ye not me an house<sup>H1004</sup> of cedar<sup>H730</sup>? 8 Now therefore so shalt thou say<sup>H559</sup> unto my servant<sup>H5650</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, I took<sup>H3947</sup> thee from the sheepcote<sup>H5116</sup>, from following<sup>H310</sup> the sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, to be ruler<sup>H5057</sup> over my people<sup>H5971</sup>, over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 9 And I was with thee whithersoever thou wentest<sup>H1980</sup>, and have cut off<sup>H3772</sup> all thine enemies<sup>H341</sup> out of thy sight<sup>H6440</sup>, and have made<sup>H6213</sup> thee a great<sup>H1419</sup> name<sup>H8034</sup>, like unto the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the great<sup>H1419</sup> men that are in the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 10 Moreover I will appoint<sup>H7760</sup> a place<sup>H4725</sup> for my people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and will plant<sup>H5193</sup> them, that they may dwell<sup>H7931</sup> in a place of their own, and move<sup>H7264</sup> no more; neither shall the children<sup>H1121</sup> of wickedness<sup>H5766</sup> afflict<sup>H6031</sup> them any more<sup>H3254</sup>, as beforetime<sup>H7223</sup>, 11 And as since the time<sup>H3117</sup> that I commanded<sup>H6680</sup> judges<sup>H8199</sup> to be over my people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and have caused thee to rest<sup>H5117</sup> from all thine enemies<sup>H341</sup>. Also the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> telleth<sup>H5046</sup> thee that he will make<sup>H6213</sup> thee an house<sup>H1004</sup>. 12 And when thy days<sup>H3117</sup> be fulfilled<sup>H4390</sup>, and thou shalt sleep<sup>H7901</sup> with thy fathers<sup>H1</sup>, I will set up<sup>H6965</sup> thy seed<sup>H2233</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> thee, which shall proceed<sup>H3318</sup> out of thy bowels<sup>H4578</sup>, and I will establish<sup>H3559</sup> his kingdom<sup>H4467</sup>. 13 He shall build<sup>H1129</sup> an house<sup>H1004</sup> for my name<sup>H8034</sup>, and I will stablish<sup>H3559</sup> the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of his kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 14 I will be his father<sup>H1</sup>, and he shall be my son<sup>H1121</sup>. If he commit iniquity<sup>H5753</sup>, I will chasten<sup>H3198</sup> him with the rod<sup>H7626</sup> of men<sup>H582</sup>, and with the stripes<sup>H5061</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>. 15 But my mercy<sup>H2617</sup> shall not depart away<sup>H5493</sup> from him, as I took<sup>H5493</sup> it from Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, whom I put away<sup>H5493</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee. 16 And thine house<sup>H1004</sup> and thy kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> shall be established<sup>H539</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee: thy throne<sup>H3678</sup> shall be established<sup>H3559</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 17 According to all these words<sup>H1697</sup>, and according to all this vision<sup>H2384</sup>, so did Nathan<sup>H5416</sup> speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto David<sup>H1732</sup>.

18 Then went<sup>H935</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> in, and sat<sup>H3427</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and he said<sup>H559</sup>, Who am I, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>? and what is my house<sup>H1004</sup>, that thou hast brought<sup>H935</sup> me hitherto<sup>H1988</sup>? 19 And this was yet a small thing<sup>H6994</sup> in thy sight<sup>H5869</sup>, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; but thou hast spoken<sup>H1696</sup> also of thy servant's<sup>H5650</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup> for a great while to come<sup>H7350</sup>. And is this the manner<sup>H8452</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>? 20 And what can<sup>H3254</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> say<sup>H1696</sup> more<sup>H3254</sup> unto thee? for thou, Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, knowest<sup>H3045</sup> thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>. 21 For thy word's<sup>H1697</sup> sake, and according to thine own heart<sup>H3820</sup>, hast thou done<sup>H6213</sup> all these great things<sup>H1420</sup>, to make thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> know<sup>H3045</sup> them. 22 Wherefore thou art great<sup>H1431</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>: for there is none like thee, neither is there any God<sup>H430</sup> beside<sup>H2108</sup> thee, according to all that we have heard<sup>H8085</sup> with our ears<sup>H241</sup>. 23 And what one<sup>H259</sup> nation<sup>H1471</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup> is like thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, even like Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, whom God<sup>H430</sup> went<sup>H1980</sup> to redeem<sup>H6299</sup> for a people<sup>H5971</sup> to himself, and to make<sup>H7760</sup> him a name<sup>H8034</sup>, and to do<sup>H6213</sup> for you great things<sup>H1420</sup> and terrible<sup>H3372</sup>, for thy land<sup>H776</sup>, before<sup>H6440</sup> thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, which thou redeemedst<sup>H6299</sup> to thee from Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, from the nations<sup>H1471</sup> and their gods<sup>H430</sup>? 24 For thou hast confirmed<sup>H3559</sup> to thyself thy people<sup>H5971</sup> Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to be a people<sup>H5971</sup> unto thee

for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup>: and thou, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, art become<sup>H1961</sup> their God<sup>H430</sup>. **25** And now, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, the word<sup>H1697</sup> that thou hast spoken<sup>H1696</sup> concerning thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>, and concerning his house<sup>H1004</sup>, establish<sup>H6965</sup> it for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup>, and do<sup>H6213</sup> as thou hast said<sup>H1696</sup>. **26** And let thy name<sup>H8034</sup> be magnified<sup>H1431</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup> is the God<sup>H430</sup> over Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: and let the house<sup>H1004</sup> of thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> David<sup>H1732</sup> be established<sup>H3559</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee. **27** For thou, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, hast revealed<sup>H1540 H241</sup> to thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, I will build<sup>H1129</sup> thee an house<sup>H1004</sup>: therefore hath thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> found<sup>H4672</sup> in his heart<sup>H3820</sup> to pray<sup>H6419</sup> this prayer<sup>H8605</sup> unto thee.<sup>6</sup> **28** And now, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, thou art that God<sup>H430</sup>, and thy words<sup>H1697</sup> be true<sup>H571</sup>, and thou hast promised<sup>H1696</sup> this goodness<sup>H2896</sup> unto thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>: **29** Therefore now let it please<sup>H2974</sup> thee to bless<sup>H1288</sup> the house<sup>H1004</sup> of thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>, that it may continue for ever<sup>H5769</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee: for thou, O Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>, hast spoken<sup>H1696</sup> it: and with thy blessing<sup>H1293</sup> let the house<sup>H1004</sup> of thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> be blessed<sup>H1288</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>.<sup>7</sup>
