

## 2. Thessalonians 3

1 Finally<sup>G3063</sup>, brethren<sup>G80</sup>, pray<sup>G4336</sup> for<sup>G4012</sup> us<sup>G2257</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> the word<sup>G3056</sup> of the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> may have free course<sup>G5143</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> be glorified<sup>G1392</sup>, even<sup>G2532</sup> as<sup>G2531</sup> it is with<sup>G4314</sup> you<sup>G5209</sup>.<sup>1</sup> 2 And<sup>G2532</sup> that<sup>G2443</sup> we may be delivered<sup>G4506</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> unreasonable<sup>G824</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> wicked<sup>G4190</sup> men<sup>G444</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> men have not<sup>G3756</sup> faith<sup>G4102</sup>.<sup>2</sup> 3 But<sup>G1161</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> is<sup>G2076</sup> faithful<sup>G4103</sup>, who<sup>G3739</sup> shall stablish<sup>G4741</sup> you<sup>G5209</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> keep<sup>G5442</sup> you from<sup>G575</sup> evil<sup>G4190</sup>. 4 And<sup>G1161</sup> we have confidence<sup>G3982</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> touching<sup>G1909</sup> you<sup>G5209</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> ye both<sup>G2532</sup> do<sup>G4160</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> will do<sup>G4160</sup> the things which<sup>G3739</sup> we command<sup>G3853</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup>. 5 And<sup>G1161</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> direct<sup>G2720</sup> your<sup>G5216</sup> hearts<sup>G2588</sup> into<sup>G1519</sup> the love<sup>G26</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> into<sup>G1519</sup> the patient waiting<sup>G5281</sup> for Christ<sup>G5547</sup>.<sup>3</sup>

6 Now<sup>G1161</sup> we command<sup>G3853</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup>, brethren<sup>G80</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> the name<sup>G3686</sup> of our<sup>G2257</sup> Lord<sup>G2962</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>, that ye withdraw<sup>G4724</sup> yourselves<sup>G5209</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> every<sup>G3956</sup> brother<sup>G80</sup> that walketh<sup>G4043</sup> disorderly<sup>G814</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> not<sup>G3361</sup> after<sup>G2596</sup> the tradition<sup>G3862</sup> which<sup>G3739</sup> he received<sup>G3880</sup> of<sup>G3844</sup> us<sup>G2257</sup>. 7 For<sup>G1063</sup> yourselves<sup>G846</sup> know<sup>G1492</sup> how<sup>G4459</sup> ye ought<sup>G1163</sup> to follow<sup>G3401</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup>: for<sup>G3754</sup> we behaved<sup>G812</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> ourselves disorderly<sup>G812</sup> among<sup>G1722</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup>; 8 Neither<sup>G3761</sup> did we eat<sup>G5315</sup> any man's<sup>G3844</sup> bread<sup>G740</sup> for nought<sup>G1432</sup>; but<sup>G235</sup> wrought<sup>G2038</sup> with<sup>G1722</sup> labour<sup>G2873</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> travail<sup>G3449</sup> night<sup>G3571</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> day<sup>G2250</sup>, that<sup>G4314</sup> we might<sup>G1912</sup> not<sup>G3361</sup> be chargeable<sup>G1912</sup> to any<sup>G5100</sup> of you<sup>G5216</sup>. 9 Not<sup>G3756</sup> because<sup>G3754</sup> we have<sup>G2192</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> power<sup>G1849</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> to<sup>G2443</sup> make<sup>G1325</sup> ourselves<sup>G1438</sup> an ensample<sup>G5179</sup> unto you<sup>G5213</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> follow<sup>G3401</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup>. 10 For<sup>G1063</sup> even<sup>G2532</sup> when<sup>G3753</sup> we were<sup>G2258</sup> with<sup>G4314</sup> you<sup>G5209</sup>, this<sup>G5124</sup> we commanded<sup>G3853</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> if any<sup>G1536</sup> would<sup>G2309</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> work<sup>G2038</sup>, neither<sup>G3366</sup> should he eat<sup>G2068</sup>. 11 For<sup>G1063</sup> we hear<sup>G191</sup> that there are some<sup>G5100</sup> which walk<sup>G4043</sup> among<sup>G1722</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup> disorderly<sup>G814</sup>, working<sup>G2038</sup> not at all<sup>G3367</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> are busybodies<sup>G4020</sup>. 12 Now<sup>G1161</sup> them that are such<sup>G5108</sup> we command<sup>G3853</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> exhort<sup>G3870</sup> by<sup>G1223</sup> our<sup>G2257</sup> Lord<sup>G2962</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> quietness<sup>G2271</sup> they work<sup>G2038</sup>, and eat<sup>G2068</sup> their own<sup>G1438</sup> bread<sup>G740</sup>. 13 But<sup>G1161</sup> ye<sup>G5210</sup>, brethren<sup>G80</sup>, be<sup>G1573</sup> not<sup>G3361</sup> weary<sup>G1573</sup> in well doing<sup>G2569</sup>. 14 And<sup>G1161</sup> if any man<sup>G1536</sup> obey<sup>G5219</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> our<sup>G2257</sup> word<sup>G3056</sup> by<sup>G1223</sup> this epistle<sup>G1992</sup>, note<sup>G4593</sup> that<sup>G5126</sup> man, and<sup>G2532</sup> have<sup>G4874</sup> no<sup>G3361</sup> company with<sup>G4874</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> he may be ashamed<sup>G1788</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 15 Yet<sup>G2532</sup> count<sup>G2233</sup> him not<sup>G3361</sup> as<sup>G5613</sup> an enemy<sup>G2190</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> admonish<sup>G3560</sup> him as<sup>G5613</sup> a brother<sup>G80</sup>.

16 Now<sup>G1161</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> of peace<sup>G1515</sup> himself<sup>G846</sup> give<sup>G1325</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup> peace<sup>G1515</sup> always<sup>G1223</sup> by<sup>G1722</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> means<sup>G5158</sup>. The Lord<sup>G2962</sup> be with<sup>G3326</sup> you<sup>G5216</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup>. 17 The salutation<sup>G783</sup> of Paul<sup>G3972</sup> with mine own<sup>G1699</sup> hand<sup>G5495</sup>, which<sup>G3739</sup> is<sup>G2076</sup> the token<sup>G4592</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> every<sup>G3956</sup> epistle<sup>G1992</sup>: so<sup>G3779</sup> I write<sup>G1125</sup>. 18 The grace<sup>G5485</sup> of our<sup>G2257</sup> Lord<sup>G2962</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> be with<sup>G3326</sup> you<sup>G5216</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup>. Amen<sup>G281</sup>.<sup>6</sup>
