1 This<sup>G5124</sup> know<sup>G1097</sup> also<sup>G1161</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the last<sup>G2078</sup> days<sup>G2250</sup> perilous<sup>G5467</sup> times<sup>G2540</sup> shall come<sup>G1764</sup>. 2 For<sup>G1063</sup> men<sup>G444</sup> shall be<sup>G2071</sup> lovers of their own selves<sup>G5367</sup>, covetous<sup>G5366</sup>, boasters<sup>G213</sup>, proud<sup>G5244</sup>, blasphemers<sup>G989</sup>, disobedient<sup>G545</sup> to parents<sup>G1118</sup>, unthankful<sup>G884</sup>, unholy<sup>G462</sup>, 3 Without natural affection<sup>G794</sup>, trucebreakers<sup>G786</sup>, false accusers<sup>G1228</sup>, incontinent<sup>G193</sup>, fierce<sup>G434</sup>, despisers of those that are good<sup>G865</sup>, 4 Traitors<sup>G4273</sup>, heady<sup>G4312</sup>, highminded<sup>G5187</sup>, lovers of pleasures<sup>G5369</sup> more<sup>G3123</sup> than<sup>G2228</sup> lovers of God<sup>G5377</sup>; 5 Having<sup>G2192</sup> a form<sup>G3446</sup> of godliness<sup>G2150</sup>, but<sup>G1161</sup> denying<sup>G720</sup> the power<sup>G1411</sup> thereof<sup>G846</sup>: from<sup>G2532</sup> such<sup>G5128</sup> turn away<sup>G665</sup>. 6 For<sup>G1063</sup> of<sup>G1537</sup> this sort<sup>G5130</sup> are they<sup>G1526</sup> which creep<sup>G1744</sup> into<sup>G1519</sup> houses<sup>G3614</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> lead captive<sup>G162</sup> silly women<sup>G1133</sup> laden<sup>G4987</sup> with sins<sup>G266</sup>, led away<sup>G71</sup> with divers<sup>G4164</sup> lusts<sup>G1939</sup>, 7 Ever<sup>G3842</sup> learning<sup>G3129</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> never<sup>G3368</sup> able<sup>G1410</sup> to come<sup>G2064</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> the knowledge<sup>G1922</sup> of the truth<sup>G225</sup>. 8 Now<sup>G1161</sup> as<sup>G5158</sup> Jannes<sup>G2389</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> Jambres<sup>G2387</sup> withstood<sup>G436</sup> Moses<sup>G3475</sup>, so<sup>G3779</sup> do<sup>G436</sup> these<sup>G3778</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> resist<sup>G436</sup> the truth<sup>G225</sup>: men<sup>G444</sup> of corrupt<sup>G2704</sup> minds<sup>G3563</sup>, reprobate<sup>G96</sup> concerning<sup>G4012</sup> the faith<sup>G4102</sup>. 9 But<sup>G235</sup> they shall proceed<sup>G4298</sup> no<sup>G3756</sup> further<sup>G1909</sup> G4119: for<sup>G1063</sup> their<sup>G846</sup> folly<sup>G454</sup> shall be<sup>G2071</sup> manifest<sup>G1552</sup> unto all<sup>G3956</sup> men, as<sup>G5613</sup> theirs<sup>G1565</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> was<sup>G1096</sup>.

10 But<sup>G1161</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> hast fully known<sup>G3877</sup> my<sup>G3450</sup> doctrine<sup>G1319</sup>, manner of life<sup>G72</sup>, purpose<sup>G4286</sup>, faith<sup>G4102</sup>, longsuffering<sup>G3115</sup>, charity<sup>G26</sup>, patience<sup>G5281</sup>. 11 Persecutions<sup>G1375</sup>, afflictions<sup>G3804</sup>, which<sup>G3634</sup> came<sup>G1096</sup> unto me<sup>G3427</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> Antioch<sup>G490</sup>, at<sup>G1722</sup> Iconium<sup>G2430</sup>, at<sup>G1722</sup> Lystra<sup>G3082</sup>, what<sup>G3634</sup> persecutions<sup>G1375</sup> I endured<sup>G5297</sup>: but<sup>G2532</sup> out of<sup>G1537</sup> them all<sup>G3956</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> delivered<sup>G4506</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>. 12 Yea<sup>G1161</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> that will<sup>G2309</sup> live<sup>G2198</sup> godly<sup>G2153</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> shall suffer persecution<sup>G1377</sup>. 13 But<sup>G1161</sup> evil<sup>G4190</sup> men<sup>G444</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> seducers<sup>G1114</sup> shall wax<sup>G4298</sup> worse and worse<sup>G1909</sup> G5501, deceiving<sup>G4105</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> being deceived<sup>G4105</sup>. 14 But<sup>G1161</sup> continue<sup>G3306</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the things which<sup>G3739</sup> thou hast learned<sup>G3129</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> hast been assured of<sup>G4104</sup>, knowing<sup>G1492</sup> of<sup>G3844</sup> whom<sup>G5101</sup> thou hast learned<sup>G3129</sup> them; 15 And<sup>G2532</sup> that<sup>G3754</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> a child<sup>G1025</sup> thou hast known<sup>G1492</sup> the holy<sup>G2413</sup> scriptures<sup>G1121</sup>, which<sup>G3588</sup> are able<sup>G1410</sup> to make<sup>G4679</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup> wise<sup>G4679</sup> unto<sup>G1519</sup> salvation<sup>G4991</sup> through<sup>G1223</sup> faith<sup>G4102</sup> which<sup>G3588</sup> is in<sup>G1722</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>. 16 All<sup>G3956</sup> scripture<sup>G1124</sup> is given by inspiration of God<sup>G2315</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> is profitable<sup>G5624</sup> for<sup>G4314</sup> doctrine<sup>G1319</sup>, for<sup>G4314</sup> reproof<sup>G1650</sup>, for<sup>G4314</sup> correction<sup>G1882</sup>, for<sup>G4314</sup> instruction<sup>G3809</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> righteousness<sup>G1343</sup>. 17 That<sup>G2443</sup> the man<sup>G444</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup> may be<sup>G5600</sup> perfect<sup>G739</sup>, throughly furnished<sup>G1822</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> good<sup>G18</sup> works<sup>G2041</sup>.
