

## 2. Timothy 4

1 I<sup>G1473</sup> charge<sup>G1263</sup> thee therefore<sup>G3767</sup> before<sup>G1799</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>, who<sup>G3588</sup> shall<sup>G3195</sup> judge<sup>G2919</sup> the quick<sup>G2198</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> the dead<sup>G3498</sup> at<sup>G2596</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> appearing<sup>G2015</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> kingdom<sup>G932</sup>,  
2 Preach<sup>G2784</sup> the word<sup>G3056</sup>, be instant<sup>G2186</sup> in season<sup>G2122</sup>, out of season<sup>G171</sup>; reprove<sup>G1651</sup>, rebuke<sup>G2008</sup>, exhort<sup>G3870</sup> with<sup>G1722</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> longsuffering<sup>G3115</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> doctrine<sup>G1322</sup>. 3 For<sup>G1063</sup> the time<sup>G2540</sup> will come<sup>G2071</sup> when<sup>G3753</sup> they will<sup>G430</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> endure<sup>G430</sup> sound<sup>G5198</sup> doctrine<sup>G1319</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> after<sup>G2596</sup> their own<sup>G2398</sup> lusts<sup>G1939</sup> shall they heap<sup>G2002</sup> to themselves<sup>G1438</sup> teachers<sup>G1320</sup>, having itching<sup>G2833</sup> ears<sup>G189</sup>, 4 And<sup>G2532</sup> they shall turn away<sup>G3303</sup> G654 their ears<sup>G189</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> the truth<sup>G225</sup>, and<sup>G1161</sup> shall be turned<sup>G1624</sup> unto<sup>G1909</sup> fables<sup>G3454</sup>. 5 But<sup>G1161</sup> watch<sup>G3525</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> all things<sup>G3956</sup>, endure afflictions<sup>G2553</sup>, do<sup>G4160</sup> the work<sup>G2041</sup> of an evangelist<sup>G2099</sup>, make full proof<sup>G4135</sup> of thy<sup>G4675</sup> ministry<sup>G1248</sup>. 6 For<sup>G1063</sup> I<sup>G1473</sup> am<sup>G4689</sup> now<sup>G2235</sup> ready to be offered<sup>G4689</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the time<sup>G2540</sup> of my<sup>G1699</sup> departure<sup>G359</sup> is at hand<sup>G2186</sup>. 7 I have fought<sup>G75</sup> a good<sup>G2570</sup> fight<sup>G73</sup>, I have finished<sup>G5055</sup> my course<sup>G1408</sup>, I have kept<sup>G5083</sup> the faith<sup>G4102</sup>. 8 Henceforth<sup>G3063</sup> there is laid up<sup>G606</sup> for me<sup>G3427</sup> a crown<sup>G4735</sup> of righteousness<sup>G1343</sup>, which<sup>G3739</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup>, the righteous<sup>G1342</sup> judge<sup>G2923</sup>, shall give<sup>G591</sup> me<sup>G3427</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> that<sup>G1565</sup> day<sup>G2250</sup>: and<sup>G1161</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> to me<sup>G1698</sup> only<sup>G3440</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> unto all them<sup>G3956</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> that love<sup>G25</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> appearing<sup>G2015</sup>.

9 Do thy diligence<sup>G4704</sup> to come<sup>G2064</sup> shortly<sup>G5030</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>. 10 For<sup>G1063</sup> Demas<sup>G1214</sup> hath forsaken<sup>G1459</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>, having loved<sup>G25</sup> this present<sup>G3568</sup> world<sup>G165</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> is departed<sup>G4198</sup> unto<sup>G1519</sup> Thessalonica<sup>G2332</sup>, Crescens<sup>G2913</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> Galatia<sup>G1053</sup>, Titus<sup>G5103</sup> unto<sup>G1519</sup> Dalmatia<sup>G1149</sup>. 11 Only<sup>G3441</sup> Luke<sup>G3065</sup> is<sup>G2076</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> me<sup>G1700</sup>. Take<sup>G353</sup> Mark<sup>G3138</sup>, and bring him<sup>G71</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> thee<sup>G4572</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> he is<sup>G2076</sup> profitable<sup>G2173</sup> to me<sup>G3427</sup> for<sup>G1519</sup> the ministry<sup>G1248</sup>. 12 And<sup>G1161</sup> Tychicus<sup>G5190</sup> have I sent<sup>G649</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> Ephesus<sup>G2181</sup>. 13 The cloke<sup>G5341</sup> that<sup>G3739</sup> I left<sup>G620</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> Troas<sup>G5174</sup> with<sup>G3844</sup> Carpus<sup>G2591</sup>, when thou comest<sup>G2064</sup>, bring<sup>G5342</sup> with thee, and<sup>G2532</sup> the books<sup>G975</sup>, but especially<sup>G3122</sup> the parchments<sup>G3200</sup>. 14 Alexander<sup>G223</sup> the coppersmith<sup>G5471</sup> did<sup>G1731</sup> me<sup>G3427</sup> much<sup>G4183</sup> evil<sup>G2556</sup>: the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> reward<sup>G591</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> according to<sup>G2596</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> works<sup>G2041</sup>: 15 Of whom<sup>G3739</sup> be<sup>G5442</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> ware<sup>G5442</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup>, for<sup>G1063</sup> he hath<sup>G436</sup> greatly<sup>G3029</sup> withstood<sup>G436</sup> our<sup>G2251</sup> words<sup>G3056</sup>.

16 At<sup>G1722</sup> my<sup>G3450</sup> first<sup>G4413</sup> answer<sup>G627</sup> no man<sup>G3762</sup> stood<sup>G4836</sup> with me<sup>G3427</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> men forsook<sup>G1459</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>: I pray God that it may<sup>G3049</sup> not<sup>G3361</sup> be laid<sup>G3049</sup> to their charge<sup>G846</sup>. 17 Notwithstanding<sup>G1161</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> stood<sup>G3936</sup> with me<sup>G3427</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> strengthened<sup>G1743</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> by<sup>G1223</sup> me<sup>G1700</sup> the preaching<sup>G2782</sup> might be fully known<sup>G4135</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> that all<sup>G3956</sup> the Gentiles<sup>G1484</sup> might hear<sup>G191</sup>: and<sup>G2532</sup> I was delivered<sup>G4506</sup> out of<sup>G1537</sup> the mouth<sup>G4750</sup> of the lion<sup>G3023</sup>. 18 And<sup>G2532</sup> the Lord<sup>G2962</sup> shall deliver<sup>G4506</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> every<sup>G3956</sup> evil<sup>G4190</sup> work<sup>G2041</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> will preserve<sup>G4982</sup> me unto<sup>G1519</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> heavenly<sup>G2032</sup> kingdom<sup>G932</sup>: to whom<sup>G3739</sup> be glory<sup>G1391</sup> for<sup>G1519</sup> ever<sup>G165</sup> and ever<sup>G165</sup>. Amen<sup>G281</sup>. 19 Salute<sup>G782</sup> Prisca<sup>G4251</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> Aquila<sup>G207</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the household<sup>G3624</sup> of Onesiphorus<sup>G3683</sup>. 20 Erastus<sup>G2037</sup> abode<sup>G3306</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> Corinth<sup>G2882</sup>: but<sup>G1161</sup> Trophimus<sup>G5161</sup> have I left<sup>G620</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> Miletum<sup>G3399</sup> sick<sup>G770</sup>. 21 Do thy diligence<sup>G4704</sup> to come<sup>G2064</sup> before<sup>G4253</sup> winter<sup>G5494</sup>. Eubulus<sup>G2103</sup> greeteth<sup>G782</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> Pudens<sup>G4227</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> Linus<sup>G3044</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> Claudia<sup>G2803</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> the brethren<sup>G80</sup>. 22 The Lord<sup>G2962</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> be with<sup>G3326</sup> thy<sup>G4675</sup> spirit<sup>G4151</sup>. Grace<sup>G5485</sup> be with<sup>G3326</sup> you<sup>G5216</sup>. Amen<sup>G281</sup>.
