

# Acts 26

1 Then<sup>G1161</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup> said<sup>G5346</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>, Thou<sup>G4671</sup> art permitted<sup>G2010</sup> to speak<sup>G3004</sup> for<sup>G5228</sup> thyself<sup>G4572</sup>. Then<sup>G5119</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup> stretched forth<sup>G1614</sup> the hand<sup>G5495</sup>, and answered for himself<sup>G626</sup>. 2 I think<sup>G2233</sup> myself<sup>G1683</sup> happy<sup>G3107</sup>, king<sup>G935</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup>, because I shall<sup>G3195</sup> answer for myself<sup>G626</sup> this day<sup>G4594</sup> before<sup>G1909</sup> thee<sup>G4675</sup> touching<sup>G4012</sup> all the things<sup>G3956</sup> whereof<sup>G3739</sup> I am accused<sup>G1458</sup> of<sup>G5259</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>. 3 Especially<sup>G3122</sup> because I know<sup>G1492</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup> to be<sup>G5607</sup> expert<sup>G1109</sup> in all<sup>G5037</sup> customs<sup>G1485</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> questions<sup>G2213</sup> which are among<sup>G2596</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>: wherefore<sup>G1352</sup> I beseech<sup>G1189</sup> thee<sup>G4675</sup> to hear<sup>G191</sup> me<sup>G3450</sup> patiently<sup>G3116</sup>. 4 My<sup>G3450</sup> manner<sup>G3303</sup> of life<sup>G981</sup> from<sup>G1537</sup> my youth<sup>G3503</sup>, which<sup>G3588</sup> was<sup>G1096</sup> at<sup>G575</sup> the first<sup>G746</sup> among<sup>G1722</sup> mine<sup>G3450</sup> own nation<sup>G1484</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> Jerusalem<sup>G2414</sup>, know<sup>G2467</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>. 5 Which knew<sup>G4267</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> from the beginning<sup>G509</sup>, if<sup>G1437</sup> they would<sup>G2309</sup> testify<sup>G3140</sup>, that<sup>G3754</sup> after<sup>G2596</sup> the most straitest<sup>G196</sup> sect<sup>G139</sup> of our<sup>G2251</sup> religion<sup>G2356</sup> I lived<sup>G2198</sup> a Pharisee<sup>G5330</sup>. 6 And<sup>G2532</sup> now<sup>G3568</sup> I stand<sup>G2476</sup> and am judged<sup>G2919</sup> for<sup>G1909</sup> the hope<sup>G1680</sup> of the promise<sup>G1860</sup> made<sup>G1096</sup> of<sup>G5259</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> our fathers<sup>G3962</sup>. 7 Unto<sup>G1519</sup> which<sup>G3739</sup> promise our<sup>G2257</sup> twelve tribes<sup>G1429</sup>, instantly<sup>G1722</sup> serving<sup>G3000</sup> God day<sup>G2250</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> night<sup>G3571</sup>, hope<sup>G1679</sup> to come<sup>G2658</sup>. For<sup>G4012</sup> which<sup>G3739</sup> hope's sake<sup>G1680</sup>, king<sup>G935</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup>, I am accused<sup>G1458</sup> of<sup>G5259</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>. 8 Why<sup>G5101</sup> should it be thought a thing<sup>G2919</sup> incredible<sup>G571</sup> with<sup>G3844</sup> you<sup>G5213</sup>, that<sup>G1487</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup> should raise<sup>G1453</sup> the dead<sup>G3498</sup>? 9 I<sup>G1473</sup> verily<sup>G3303</sup> thought<sup>G1380</sup> with myself<sup>G1683</sup>, that I ought<sup>G1163</sup> to do<sup>G4238</sup> many things<sup>G4183</sup> contrary<sup>G1727</sup> to<sup>G4314</sup> the name<sup>G3686</sup> of Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> of Nazareth<sup>G3480</sup>. 10 Which thing<sup>G3739</sup> I<sup>G4160</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> did<sup>G4160</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> Jerusalem<sup>G2414</sup>: and<sup>G2532</sup> many<sup>G4183</sup> of the saints<sup>G40</sup> did<sup>G2623</sup> shut up<sup>G1473</sup> in prison<sup>G2623</sup>, having received<sup>G5438</sup> authority<sup>G2983</sup> from<sup>G1849</sup> the chief priests<sup>G749</sup>; and<sup>G5037</sup> when they<sup>G846</sup> were put to death<sup>G337</sup>, I gave<sup>G2702</sup> my voice<sup>G5586</sup> against them. 11 And<sup>G2532</sup> I punished<sup>G5097</sup> them<sup>G846</sup> off<sup>G4178</sup> in<sup>G2596</sup> every<sup>G3956</sup> synagogue<sup>G4864</sup>, and compelled<sup>G315</sup> them to blaspheme<sup>G987</sup>; and<sup>G5037</sup> being<sup>G1693</sup> exceedingly<sup>G4057</sup> mad against<sup>G1693</sup> them<sup>G846</sup>, I persecuted<sup>G1377</sup> them even<sup>G2532</sup> unto<sup>G1519</sup> strange<sup>G1854</sup> cities<sup>G4172</sup>.

12 Whereupon<sup>G1722</sup> as I went<sup>G3739</sup> to<sup>G4198</sup> Damascus<sup>G1154</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> authority<sup>G1849</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> commission<sup>G2011</sup> from<sup>G3844</sup> the chief priests<sup>G749</sup>, 13 At midday<sup>G2250</sup> I saw<sup>G3319</sup>, O king<sup>G935</sup>, I saw<sup>G1492</sup> in<sup>G2596</sup> the way<sup>G3598</sup> a light<sup>G5457</sup> from heaven<sup>G3771</sup>, above<sup>G5228</sup> the brightness<sup>G2987</sup> of the sun<sup>G2246</sup>, shining round about<sup>G4034</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> them which journeyed<sup>G4198</sup> with<sup>G4862</sup> me<sup>G1698</sup>. 14 And<sup>G1161</sup> when we<sup>G2257</sup> were<sup>G2667</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> fallen<sup>G2667</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> the earth<sup>G1093</sup>, I heard<sup>G191</sup> a voice<sup>G5456</sup> speaking<sup>G2980</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> saying<sup>G3004</sup> in the Hebrew<sup>G1446</sup> tongue<sup>G1258</sup>, Saul<sup>G4549</sup>, Saul<sup>G4549</sup>, why<sup>G5101</sup> persecutest thou<sup>G1377</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup>? it is hard<sup>G4642</sup> for thee<sup>G4671</sup> to kick<sup>G2979</sup> against<sup>G4314</sup> the pricks<sup>G2759</sup>. 15 And<sup>G1161</sup> I said<sup>G2036</sup>, Who<sup>G5101</sup> art thou<sup>G1488</sup>, Lord<sup>G2962</sup>? And<sup>G1161</sup> he said<sup>G2036</sup>, I<sup>G1473</sup> am<sup>G1510</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> whom<sup>G3739</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> persecutest<sup>G1377</sup>. 16 But<sup>G235</sup> rise<sup>G450</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> stand<sup>G2476</sup> upon<sup>G1909</sup> thy<sup>G4675</sup> feet<sup>G4228</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> I have appeared<sup>G3700</sup> unto thee<sup>G4671</sup> for<sup>G1519</sup> this purpose<sup>G5124</sup>, to make<sup>G4400</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup> a minister<sup>G5257</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> a witness<sup>G3144</sup> both<sup>G5037</sup> of these things which<sup>G3739</sup> thou hast seen<sup>G1492</sup>, and<sup>G5037</sup> of those things in the which<sup>G3739</sup> I will appear<sup>G3700</sup> unto thee<sup>G4671</sup>; 17 Delivering<sup>G1807</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup> from<sup>G1537</sup> the people<sup>G2992</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> from the Gentiles<sup>G1484</sup>, unto<sup>G1519</sup> whom<sup>G3739</sup> now<sup>G3568</sup> I send<sup>G649</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup>, 18 To open<sup>G455</sup> their<sup>G846</sup> eyes<sup>G3788</sup>, and to turn<sup>G1994</sup> them from<sup>G575</sup> darkness<sup>G4655</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> light<sup>G5457</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> from the power<sup>G1849</sup> of Satan<sup>G4567</sup> unto<sup>G1909</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, that they<sup>G846</sup> may receive<sup>G2983</sup> forgiveness<sup>G859</sup> of sins<sup>G266</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> inheritance<sup>G2819</sup> among<sup>G1722</sup> them which are sanctified<sup>G37</sup> by faith<sup>G4102</sup> that is in<sup>G1519</sup> me<sup>G1691</sup>. 19 Whereupon<sup>G3606</sup>, O king<sup>G935</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup>, I was<sup>G1096</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> disobedient<sup>G545</sup> unto the heavenly<sup>G3770</sup> vision<sup>G3701</sup>: 20 But<sup>G235</sup> shewed<sup>G518</sup> first<sup>G4412</sup> unto them of<sup>G1722</sup> Damascus<sup>G1154</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> at Jerusalem<sup>G2414</sup>, and<sup>G5037</sup> throughout<sup>G1519</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> the coasts<sup>G5561</sup> of Judaea<sup>G2449</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> then to the Gentiles<sup>G1484</sup>, that they should repent<sup>G3340</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> turn<sup>G1994</sup> to<sup>G1909</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, and do<sup>G4238</sup> works<sup>G2041</sup> meet<sup>G514</sup> for repentance<sup>G3341</sup>. 21 For<sup>G1752</sup> these causes<sup>G5130</sup> the Jews<sup>G2453</sup> caught<sup>G4815</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the temple<sup>G2411</sup>, and went about<sup>G3987</sup> to kill<sup>G1315</sup> me. 22 Having<sup>G5177</sup> therefore<sup>G3767</sup> obtained<sup>G5177</sup> help<sup>G1947</sup> of<sup>G3844</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, I continue<sup>G2476</sup> unto<sup>G891</sup> this<sup>G5026</sup> day<sup>G2250</sup>,

witnessing<sup>G3140</sup> both<sup>G5037</sup> to small<sup>G3398</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> great<sup>G3173</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup> none other things<sup>G3762</sup> than<sup>G1622</sup> those which<sup>G3739</sup> the prophets<sup>G4396</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> Moses<sup>G3475</sup> did say<sup>G2980</sup> should<sup>G3195</sup> come<sup>G1096</sup>. **23** That<sup>G1487</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> should suffer<sup>G3805</sup>, and that<sup>G1487</sup> he should be the first<sup>G4413</sup> that should rise<sup>G386</sup> from<sup>G1537</sup> the dead<sup>G3498</sup>, and should<sup>G3195</sup> shew<sup>G2605</sup> light<sup>G5457</sup> unto the people<sup>G2992</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> to the Gentiles<sup>G1484</sup>.

**24** And<sup>G1161</sup> as he<sup>G846</sup> thus<sup>G5023</sup> spake for himself<sup>G626</sup>, Festus<sup>G5347</sup> said<sup>G5346</sup> with a loud<sup>G3173</sup> voice<sup>G5456</sup>, Paul<sup>G3972</sup>, thou art beside thyself<sup>G3105</sup>; much<sup>G4183</sup> learning<sup>G1121</sup> doth make<sup>G4062</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup> mad<sup>G1519</sup>. **25** But<sup>G1161</sup> he said<sup>G5346</sup>, I am<sup>G3105</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> mad<sup>G3105</sup>, most noble<sup>G2903</sup> Festus<sup>G5347</sup>; but<sup>G235</sup> speak forth<sup>G669</sup> the words<sup>G4487</sup> of truth<sup>G225</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> soberness<sup>G4997</sup>. **26** For<sup>G1063</sup> the king<sup>G935</sup> knoweth<sup>G1987</sup> of these<sup>G4012</sup> things, before<sup>G5130</sup> whom<sup>G4314</sup> also<sup>G3739</sup> I speak<sup>G2980</sup> freely<sup>G3955</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> I am persuaded<sup>G3982</sup> that<sup>G3756</sup> none<sup>G5100</sup> of these things<sup>G5130</sup> are hidden<sup>G2990</sup> from him<sup>G846</sup>; for<sup>G1063</sup> this thing<sup>G5124</sup> was<sup>G2076</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> done<sup>G4238</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> a corner<sup>G1137</sup>. **27** King<sup>G935</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup>, believest thou<sup>G4100</sup> the prophets<sup>G4396</sup>? I know<sup>G1492</sup> that<sup>G3754</sup> thou believest<sup>G4100</sup>. **28** Then<sup>G1161</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup> said<sup>G5346</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup>, Almost<sup>G1722</sup> thou persuadest<sup>G3982</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> to be<sup>G1096</sup> a Christian<sup>G5546</sup>. **29** And<sup>G1161</sup> Paul<sup>G3972</sup> said<sup>G2036</sup>, I would<sup>G302</sup> to God<sup>G2316</sup>, that not<sup>G3756</sup> only<sup>G3440</sup> thou<sup>G4571</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> that hear<sup>G191</sup> me<sup>G3450</sup> this day<sup>G4594</sup>, were<sup>G1096</sup> both<sup>G2532</sup> almost<sup>G1722</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> altogether<sup>G1722</sup> such<sup>G5108</sup> as<sup>G3697</sup> I am<sup>G1510</sup>, except<sup>G3924</sup> these<sup>G5130</sup> bonds<sup>G1199</sup>. **30** And<sup>G2532</sup> when he<sup>G846</sup> had<sup>G2036</sup> thus<sup>G5023</sup> spoken<sup>G2036</sup>, the king<sup>G935</sup> rose up<sup>G450</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the governor<sup>G2232</sup>, and<sup>G5037</sup> Bernice<sup>G959</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> they that sat with<sup>G4775</sup> them<sup>G846</sup>: **31** And<sup>G2532</sup> when they were gone aside<sup>G402</sup>, they talked<sup>G2980</sup> between<sup>G4314</sup> themselves<sup>G240</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, This<sup>G3778</sup> man<sup>G444</sup> doeth<sup>G4238</sup> nothing<sup>G3762</sup> worthy<sup>G514</sup> of death<sup>G2288</sup> or<sup>G2228</sup> of bonds<sup>G1199</sup>. **32** Then<sup>G1161</sup> said<sup>G5346</sup> Agrippa<sup>G67</sup> unto Festus<sup>G5347</sup>, This<sup>G3778</sup> man<sup>G444</sup> might<sup>G1410</sup> have been set at liberty<sup>G630</sup>, if<sup>G1508</sup> he had<sup>G1941</sup> not<sup>G1508</sup> appealed unto<sup>G1941</sup> Caesar<sup>G2541</sup>.
