

# Amos 2

1 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; For three<sup>H7969</sup> transgressions<sup>H6588</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, and for four<sup>H702</sup>, I will not turn away<sup>H7725</sup> the punishment thereof; because he burned<sup>H8313</sup> the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Edom<sup>H123</sup> into lime<sup>H7875</sup>. 2 But I will send<sup>H7971</sup> a fire<sup>H784</sup> upon Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, and it shall devour<sup>H398</sup> the palaces<sup>H759</sup> of Kerioth<sup>H7152</sup>: and Moab<sup>H4124</sup> shall die<sup>H4191</sup> with tumult<sup>H7588</sup>, with shouting<sup>H8643</sup>, and with the sound<sup>H6963</sup> of the trumpet<sup>H7782</sup>. 3 And I will cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the judge<sup>H8199</sup> from the midst<sup>H7130</sup> thereof, and will slay<sup>H2026</sup> all the princes<sup>H8269</sup> thereof with him, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 4 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; For three<sup>H7969</sup> transgressions<sup>H6588</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and for four<sup>H702</sup>, I will not turn away<sup>H7725</sup> the punishment thereof; because they have despised<sup>H3988</sup> the law<sup>H8451</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and have not kept<sup>H8104</sup> his commandments<sup>H2706</sup>, and their lies<sup>H3577</sup> caused them to err<sup>H8582</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> the which their fathers<sup>H1</sup> have walked<sup>H1980</sup>. 5 But I will send<sup>H7971</sup> a fire<sup>H784</sup> upon Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and it shall devour<sup>H398</sup> the palaces<sup>H759</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 6 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; For three<sup>H7969</sup> transgressions<sup>H6588</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and for four<sup>H702</sup>, I will not turn away<sup>H7725</sup> the punishment thereof; because they sold<sup>H4376</sup> the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> for silver<sup>H3701</sup>, and the poor<sup>H34</sup> for a pair of shoes<sup>H5275</sup>; 7 That pant<sup>H7602</sup> after the dust<sup>H6083</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> on the head<sup>H7218</sup> of the poor<sup>H1800</sup>, and turn aside<sup>H5186</sup> the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the meek<sup>H6035</sup>: and a man<sup>H376</sup> and his father<sup>H1</sup> will go<sup>H3212</sup> in unto the same maid<sup>H5291</sup>, to profane<sup>H2490</sup> my holy<sup>H6944</sup> name<sup>H8034.1</sup>. 8 And they lay themselves down<sup>H5186</sup> upon clothes<sup>H899</sup> laid to pledge<sup>H2254</sup> by<sup>H681</sup> every altar<sup>H4196</sup>, and they drink<sup>H8354</sup> the wine<sup>H3196</sup> of the condemned<sup>H6064</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of their god<sup>H430.2</sup>.

9 Yet destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> I the Amorite<sup>H567</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> them, whose height<sup>H1363</sup> was like the height<sup>H1363</sup> of the cedars<sup>H730</sup>, and he was strong<sup>H2634</sup> as the oaks<sup>H437</sup>; yet I destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> his fruit<sup>H6529</sup> from above<sup>H4605</sup>, and his roots<sup>H8328</sup> from beneath. 10 Also I brought you up<sup>H5927</sup> from the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, and led<sup>H3212</sup> you forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> through the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>, to possess<sup>H3423</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup> of the Amorite<sup>H567</sup>. 11 And I raised up<sup>H6965</sup> of your sons<sup>H1121</sup> for prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, and of your young men<sup>H970</sup> for Nazarites<sup>H5139</sup>. Is it not even thus, O ye children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 12 But ye gave the Nazarites<sup>H5139</sup> wine<sup>H3196</sup> to drink<sup>H8248</sup>, and commanded<sup>H6680</sup> the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Prophecy<sup>H5012</sup> not. 13 Behold, I am pressed<sup>H5781</sup> under you, as a cart<sup>H5699</sup> is pressed<sup>H5781</sup> that is full<sup>H4392</sup> of sheaves<sup>H5995.3</sup>. 14 Therefore the flight<sup>H4498</sup> shall perish<sup>H6</sup> from the swift<sup>H7031</sup>, and the strong<sup>H2389</sup> shall not strengthen<sup>H553</sup> his force<sup>H3581</sup>, neither shall the mighty<sup>H1368</sup> deliver<sup>H4422</sup> himself<sup>H5315.4</sup>. 15 Neither shall he stand<sup>H5975</sup> that handleth<sup>H8610</sup> the bow<sup>H7198</sup>; and he that is swift<sup>H7031</sup> of foot<sup>H7272</sup> shall not deliver<sup>H4422</sup> himself: neither shall he that rideth<sup>H7392</sup> the horse<sup>H5483</sup> deliver<sup>H4422</sup> himself<sup>H5315</sup>. 16 And he that is courageous<sup>H533 H3820</sup> among the mighty<sup>H1368</sup> shall flee away<sup>H5127</sup> naked<sup>H6174</sup> in that day<sup>H3117</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068.5</sup>.
