## Daniel 3

1 Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> made<sup>H5648</sup> an image<sup>H6755</sup> of gold<sup>H1722</sup>, whose height<sup>H7314</sup> was threescore<sup>H8361</sup> cubits<sup>H521</sup>, and the breadth<sup>H6613</sup> thereof six<sup>H8353</sup> cubits<sup>H521</sup>: he set it up<sup>H6966</sup> in the plain<sup>H1236</sup> of Dura<sup>H1757</sup>, in the province<sup>H4083</sup> of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>. 2 Then Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> sent<sup>H7972</sup> to gather together<sup>H3673</sup> the princes<sup>H324</sup>, the governors<sup>H5460</sup>, and the captains<sup>H6347</sup>, the judges<sup>H148</sup>, the treasurers<sup>H1411</sup>, the counsellors<sup>H1884</sup>, the sheriffs<sup>H8614</sup>, and all<sup>H3606</sup> the rulers<sup>H7984</sup> of the provinces<sup>H4083</sup>, to come<sup>H858</sup> to the dedication<sup>H2597</sup> of the image<sup>H6755</sup> which Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> had set up<sup>H6966</sup>. 3 Then<sup>H116</sup> the princes<sup>H324</sup>, the governors<sup>H5460</sup>, and captains<sup>H6347</sup>, the judges<sup>H148</sup>, the treasurers<sup>H1411</sup>, the counsellors<sup>H1884</sup>, the sheriffs<sup>H8614</sup>, and all<sup>H3606</sup> the rulers<sup>H7984</sup> of the provinces<sup>H4083</sup>, were gathered together<sup>H3673</sup> unto the dedication<sup>H2597</sup> of the image<sup>H6755</sup> that Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> had set up<sup>H6966</sup>; and they stood<sup>H6966</sup> before<sup>H6903</sup> the image<sup>H6755</sup> that Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> had set up<sup>H6966</sup>. 4 Then an herald<sup>H3744</sup> cried<sup>H7123</sup> aloud<sup>H2429</sup>, To you it is commanded<sup>H560</sup>, O people<sup>H5972</sup>, nations<sup>H524</sup>, and languages<sup>H3961</sup>,<sup>12</sup> 5 That at what time<sup>H5732</sup> ye hear<sup>H8086</sup> the sound<sup>H7032</sup> of the cornet<sup>H7162</sup>, flute<sup>H4953</sup>, harp<sup>H7030 H7030</sup>, sackbut<sup>H5443</sup>, psaltery<sup>H6460</sup>, dulcimer<sup>H5481</sup>, and all<sup>H3606</sup> kinds<sup>H2178</sup> of musick<sup>H2170</sup>, ye fall down<sup>H5308</sup> and worship<sup>H5457</sup> the golden<sup>H1722</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup> that Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> hath set up<sup>H6966.3</sup> 6 And whoso<sup>H4479</sup> falleth<sup>H5308</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> down<sup>H5308</sup> and worshippeth<sup>H5457</sup> shall the same hour<sup>H8160</sup> be cast<sup>H7412</sup> into the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of a burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861</sup>. **7** Therefore<sup>H6903 H1836</sup> at that time<sup>H2166</sup>, when<sup>H1768</sup> all<sup>H3606</sup> the people<sup>H5972</sup> heard<sup>H8086</sup> the sound<sup>H7032</sup> of the  $cornet^{H7162}$ , flute<sup>H4953</sup>, harp<sup>H7030 H7030</sup>, sackbut<sup>H5443</sup>, psaltery<sup>H6460</sup>, and all<sup>H3606</sup> kinds<sup>H2178</sup> of musick<sup>H2170</sup>, all<sup>H3606</sup> the people<sup>H5972</sup>, the nations<sup>H524</sup>, and the languages<sup>H3961</sup>, fell down<sup>H5308</sup> and worshipped<sup>H5457</sup> the golden<sup>H1722</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup> that Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> had set up<sup>H6966</sup>.

8 Wherefore<sup>H6903 H3606</sup> at that<sup>H1836</sup> time<sup>H2166</sup> certain<sup>H1400</sup> Chaldeans<sup>H3779</sup> came near<sup>H7127</sup>, and accused<sup>H7170 H399</sup> the Jews<sup>H3062</sup>. **9** They spake<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> to the king<sup>H4430</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, live<sup>H2418</sup> for ever<sup>H5957</sup>. **10** Thou<sup>H607</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, hast made<sup>H7761</sup> a decree<sup>H2942</sup>, that every<sup>H3606</sup> man<sup>H606</sup> that shall hear<sup>H8086</sup> the sound<sup>H7032</sup> of the cornet<sup>H7162</sup>, flute<sup>H4953</sup>, harp<sup>H7030 H7030</sup>, sackbut<sup>H5443</sup>, psaltery<sup>H6460</sup>, and dulcimer<sup>H5481 H5481</sup>, and all<sup>H3606</sup> kinds<sup>H2178</sup> of musick<sup>H2170</sup>, shall fall down<sup>H5308</sup> and worship<sup>H5457</sup> the golden<sup>H1722</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup>: **11** And whoso<sup>H4479</sup> falleth<sup>H5308</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> down<sup>H5308</sup> and worshippeth<sup>H5457</sup>, that he should be cast<sup>H7412</sup> into the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of a burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861</sup>. 12 There are H383 certain H1400 Jews H3062 whom H3487 thou hast set H4483 over H5922 the affairs H5673 of the province H4083 of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>, Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>; these<sup>H479</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, have<sup>H7761</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> regarded<sup>H2942</sup> thee<sup>H5922</sup>: they serve<sup>H6399</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> thy gods<sup>H426</sup>, nor<sup>H3809</sup> worship<sup>H5457</sup> the golden<sup>H1722</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup> which thou hast set up<sup>H6966.4</sup> 13 Then<sup>H116</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> in his rage<sup>H7266</sup> and fury<sup>H2528</sup> commanded<sup>H560</sup> to bring<sup>H858</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>. Then<sup>H116</sup> they brought<sup>H858</sup> these<sup>H479</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup> before<sup>H6925</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup>. 14 Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> spake<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> unto them, Is it true<sup>H6656</sup>, O Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, do not<sup>H3809</sup> ye<sup>H383</sup> serve<sup>H6399</sup> my gods<sup>H426</sup>, nor<sup>H3809</sup> worship<sup>H5457</sup> the golden<sup>H1722</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup> which I have set<sup>H6966</sup> up?<sup>5</sup> 15 Now<sup>H3705</sup> if<sup>H2006</sup> ye be<sup>H383</sup> ready<sup>H6263</sup> that at what time<sup>H5732</sup> ye hear<sup>H8086</sup> the sound<sup>H7032</sup> of the cornet<sup>H7162</sup>, flute<sup>H4953</sup>, harp<sup>H7030</sup>, sackbut<sup>H5443</sup>, psaltery<sup>H6460</sup>, and dulcimer<sup>H5481</sup>, and all<sup>H3606</sup> kinds<sup>H2178</sup> of musick<sup>H2170</sup>, ye fall down<sup>H5308</sup> and worship<sup>H5457</sup> the image<sup>H6755</sup> which I have made<sup>H5648</sup>; well: but if<sup>H2006</sup> ye worship<sup>H5457</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup>, ye shall be cast<sup>H7412</sup> the same hour<sup>H8160</sup> into the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of a burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861</sup>; and who<sup>H4479</sup> is that God<sup>H426</sup> that shall deliver<sup>H7804</sup> you out of<sup>H4481</sup> my hands<sup>H3028</sup>? **16** Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> to the king<sup>H4430</sup>, O Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup>, we<sup>H586</sup> are not<sup>H3809</sup> careful<sup>H2818</sup> to answer<sup>H8421</sup> thee in<sup>H5922</sup> this<sup>H1836</sup> matter<sup>H6600</sup>. **17** If<sup>H2006</sup> it be so, our God<sup>H426</sup> whom we<sup>H586</sup> serve<sup>H6399</sup> is<sup>H383</sup> able<sup>H3202</sup> to deliver<sup>H7804</sup> us from<sup>H4481</sup> the burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861</sup>, and<sup>H4481</sup> he will deliver<sup>H7804</sup> us out of<sup>H4481</sup> thine hand<sup>H3028</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>. **18** But if<sup>H2006</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup>, be it<sup>H1934</sup> known<sup>H3046</sup> unto thee, O king<sup>H4430</sup>, that we will<sup>H383</sup> not<sup>H3809</sup> serve<sup>H6399</sup> thy gods<sup>H426</sup>, nor<sup>H3809</sup> worship<sup>H5457</sup> the golden<sup>H1722</sup> image<sup>H6755</sup> which thou hast set up<sup>H6966</sup>.

19 Then<sup>H116</sup> was Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> full<sup>H4391</sup> of fury<sup>H2528</sup>, and the form<sup>H6755</sup> of his visage<sup>H600</sup> was changed<sup>H8133</sup> against<sup>H5922</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>: therefore he spake<sup>H6032</sup>, and commanded<sup>H560</sup> that they should heat<sup>H228</sup> the furnace<sup>H861</sup> one<sup>H2298</sup> seven times<sup>H7655</sup> more<sup>H5922</sup> than<sup>H1768</sup> it was wont<sup>H2370</sup> to be heated<sup>H228.6</sup> 20 And he commanded<sup>H560</sup> the most<sup>H2429</sup> mighty<sup>H1401</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup> that were in his army<sup>H2429</sup> to bind<sup>H3729</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>. Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, and to cast<sup>H7412</sup> them into the burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861,7</sup> 21 Then<sup>H116</sup> these<sup>H479</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup> were bound<sup>H3729</sup> in their coats<sup>H5622</sup>, their hosen<sup>H6361</sup> H6361</sup>, and their hats<sup>H3737</sup>, and their other garments<sup>H3831</sup>, and were cast<sup>H7412</sup> into the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of the burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861,89</sup> 22 Therefore<sup>H3606 H6903</sup> because<sup>H4481 H1836</sup> the king's<sup>H4430</sup> commandment<sup>H4406</sup> was urgent<sup>H2685</sup>, and the furnace<sup>H861</sup> exceeding<sup>H3493</sup> hot<sup>H228</sup>, the flame<sup>H7631</sup> of the fire<sup>H5135</sup> slew<sup>H6992</sup> those<sup>H479</sup> men<sup>H1400 H1994</sup> that took up<sup>H5267</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>.<sup>1011</sup> 23 And these<sup>H479</sup> three<sup>H8532</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup>, Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, fell down<sup>H5308</sup> bound<sup>H3729</sup> into the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of the burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861</sup>. **24** Then<sup>H116</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> was astonied<sup>H8429</sup>, and rose up<sup>H6966</sup> in haste<sup>H927</sup>, and spake<sup>H6032</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup> unto his counsellors<sup>H1907</sup>, Did not<sup>H3809</sup> we cast<sup>H7412</sup> three<sup>H8532</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup> bound<sup>H3729</sup> into the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of the fire<sup>H5135</sup>? They answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup> unto the king<sup>H4430</sup>, True<sup>H3330</sup>, O king<sup>H4430</sup>.<sup>12</sup> **25** He answered<sup>H6032</sup> and said<sup>H560</sup>, Lo<sup>H1888</sup>, I<sup>H576</sup> see<sup>H2370</sup> four<sup>H703</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup> loose<sup>H8271</sup>, walking<sup>H1981</sup> in the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of the fire<sup>H5135</sup>, and they have<sup>H383</sup> no<sup>H3809</sup> hurt<sup>H2257</sup>; and the form<sup>H7299</sup> of the fourth<sup>H7244</sup> is like<sup>H1821</sup> the Son<sup>H1247</sup> of God<sup>H426,13</sup> 26 Then<sup>H116</sup> Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> came near<sup>H7127</sup> to the mouth<sup>H8651</sup> of the burning<sup>H3345</sup> fiery<sup>H5135</sup> furnace<sup>H861</sup>, and spake<sup>H6032</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup>, Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, ye servants<sup>H5649</sup> of the most high<sup>H5943</sup> God<sup>H426</sup>, come forth<sup>H5312</sup>, and come<sup>H858</sup> hither. Then<sup>H116</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, came forth<sup>H5312</sup> of<sup>H4481</sup> the midst<sup>H1459</sup> of the fire<sup>H5135,14</sup> 27 And the princes<sup>H324</sup>, governors<sup>H5460</sup>, and captains<sup>H6347</sup>, and the king's<sup>H4430</sup> counsellors<sup>H1907</sup>, being gathered together<sup>H3673</sup>, saw<sup>H2370</sup> these<sup>H479</sup> men<sup>H1400</sup>, upon whose bodies<sup>H1655</sup> the fire<sup>H5135</sup> had no<sup>H3809</sup> power<sup>H7981</sup>, nor<sup>H3809</sup> was an hair<sup>H8177</sup> of their head<sup>H7217</sup> singed<sup>H2761</sup>, neither<sup>H3809</sup> were their coats<sup>H5622</sup> changed<sup>H8133</sup>, nor<sup>H3809</sup> the smell<sup>H7382</sup> of fire<sup>H5135</sup> had passed<sup>H5709</sup> on them.

**28** Then Nebuchadnezzar<sup>H5020</sup> spake<sup>H6032</sup>, and said<sup>H560</sup>, Blessed<sup>H1289</sup> be the God<sup>H426</sup> of Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, who hath sent<sup>H7972</sup> his angel<sup>H4398</sup>, and delivered<sup>H7804</sup> his servants<sup>H5649</sup> that trusted<sup>H7365</sup> in him<sup>H5922</sup>, and have changed<sup>H8133</sup> the king's<sup>H4430</sup> word<sup>H4406</sup>, and yielded<sup>H3052</sup> their bodies<sup>H1655</sup>, that they might not<sup>H3809</sup> serve<sup>H6399</sup> nor<sup>H3809</sup> worship<sup>H5457</sup> any<sup>H3606</sup> god<sup>H426</sup>, except<sup>H3861</sup> their own God<sup>H426</sup>. **29** Therefore I<sup>H4481</sup> make<sup>H7761</sup> a decree<sup>H2942</sup>, That every<sup>H3606</sup> people<sup>H5972</sup>, nation<sup>H524</sup>, and language<sup>H3961</sup>, which speak<sup>H560</sup> any thing amiss<sup>H7960 H7955</sup> against<sup>H5922</sup> the God<sup>H426</sup> of Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, shall be cut<sup>H5648</sup> in pieces<sup>H1917</sup>, and their houses<sup>H1005</sup> shall be made<sup>H7739</sup> a dunghill<sup>H5122</sup>: because<sup>H6903 H3606</sup> there is<sup>H383</sup> no<sup>H3809</sup> other<sup>H321</sup> God<sup>H426</sup> that can<sup>H3202</sup> deliver<sup>H5388</sup> after this<sup>H1836</sup> sort.<sup>151617</sup> **30** Then<sup>H116</sup> the king<sup>H4430</sup> promoted<sup>H6744</sup> Shadrach<sup>H7715</sup>, Meshach<sup>H4336</sup>, and Abednego<sup>H5665</sup>, in the province<sup>H4083</sup> of Babylon<sup>H895</sup>.<sup>18</sup>
