

# Deuteronomy 2

1 Then we turned<sup>H6437</sup>, and took our journey<sup>H5265</sup> into the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the Red<sup>H5488</sup> sea<sup>H3220</sup>, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto me: and we compassed<sup>H5437</sup> mount<sup>H2022</sup> Seir<sup>H8165</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>. 2 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H559</sup> unto me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 3 Ye have compassed<sup>H5437</sup> this mountain<sup>H2022</sup> long enough<sup>H7227</sup>: turn<sup>H6437</sup> you northward<sup>H6828</sup>. 4 And command<sup>H6680</sup> thou the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Ye are to pass<sup>H5674</sup> through the coast<sup>H1366</sup> of your brethren<sup>H251</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Esau<sup>H6215</sup>, which dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Seir<sup>H8165</sup>; and they shall be afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of you: take ye good<sup>H3966</sup> heed<sup>H8104</sup> unto yourselves therefore: 5 Meddle<sup>H1624</sup> not with them; for I will not give<sup>H5414</sup> you of their land<sup>H776</sup>, no, not so much as a foot<sup>H7272</sup> breadth<sup>H4096</sup> H3709, because I have given<sup>H5414</sup> mount<sup>H2022</sup> Seir<sup>H8165</sup> unto Esau<sup>H6215</sup> for a possession<sup>H3425</sup>. 6 Ye shall buy<sup>H7666</sup> meat<sup>H400</sup> of them for money<sup>H3701</sup>, that ye may eat<sup>H398</sup>; and ye shall also buy<sup>H3739</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup> of them for money<sup>H3701</sup>, that ye may drink<sup>H8354</sup>. 7 For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hath blessed<sup>H1288</sup> thee in all the works<sup>H4639</sup> of thy hand<sup>H3027</sup>: he knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> thy walking<sup>H3212</sup> through this great<sup>H1419</sup> wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>: these forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hath been with thee; thou hast lacked<sup>H2637</sup> nothing<sup>H1697</sup>.

8 And when we passed<sup>H5674</sup> by from our brethren<sup>H251</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Esau<sup>H6215</sup>, which dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Seir<sup>H8165</sup>, through the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the plain<sup>H6160</sup> from Elath<sup>H359</sup>, and from Eziongaber<sup>H6100</sup>, we turned<sup>H6437</sup> and passed<sup>H5674</sup> by the way<sup>H1870</sup> of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>. 9 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Distress<sup>H6696</sup> not the Moabites<sup>H4124</sup>, neither contend<sup>H1624</sup> with them in battle<sup>H4421</sup>: for I will not give<sup>H5414</sup> thee of their land<sup>H776</sup> for a possession<sup>H3425</sup>, because I have given<sup>H5414</sup> Ar<sup>H6144</sup> unto the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Lot<sup>H3876</sup> for a possession<sup>H3425</sup>. 10 The Emims<sup>H368</sup> dwell<sup>H3427</sup> therein in times past<sup>H6440</sup>, a people<sup>H5971</sup> great<sup>H1419</sup>, and many<sup>H7227</sup>, and tall<sup>H7311</sup>, as the Anakims<sup>H6062</sup>; 11 Which<sup>H1992</sup> also were accounted<sup>H2803</sup> giants<sup>H7497</sup>, as the Anakims<sup>H6062</sup>, but the Moabites<sup>H4125</sup> call<sup>H7121</sup> them Emims<sup>H368</sup>. 12 The Horims<sup>H2752</sup> also dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Seir<sup>H8165</sup> beforetime<sup>H6440</sup>, but the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Esau<sup>H6215</sup> succeeded<sup>H3423</sup> them, when they had destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> them from before<sup>H6440</sup> them, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in their stead; as Israel<sup>H3478</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> unto the land<sup>H776</sup> of his possession<sup>H3425</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> gave<sup>H5414</sup> unto them. 13 Now rise up<sup>H6965</sup>, said I, and get you over<sup>H5674</sup> the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Zered<sup>H2218</sup>. And we went over<sup>H5674</sup> the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Zered<sup>H2218</sup>. 14 And the space<sup>H3117</sup> in which we came<sup>H1980</sup> from Kadeshbarnea<sup>H6947</sup>, until we were come over<sup>H5674</sup> the brook<sup>H5158</sup> Zered<sup>H2218</sup>, was thirty<sup>H7970</sup> and eight<sup>H8083</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>; until all the generation<sup>H1755</sup> of the men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> were wasted out<sup>H8552</sup> from among<sup>H7130</sup> the host<sup>H4264</sup>, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto them. 15 For indeed the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was against them, to destroy<sup>H2000</sup> them from among<sup>H7130</sup> the host<sup>H4264</sup>, until they were consumed<sup>H8552</sup>. 16 So it came to pass, when all the men<sup>H582</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> were consumed<sup>H8552</sup> and dead<sup>H4191</sup> from among<sup>H7130</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, 17 That the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 18 Thou art to pass over<sup>H5674</sup> through Ar<sup>H6144</sup>, the coast<sup>H1366</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, this day<sup>H3117</sup>: 19 And when thou comest nigh<sup>H7126</sup> over against<sup>H4136</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup>, distress<sup>H6696</sup> them not, nor meddle<sup>H1624</sup> with them: for I will not give<sup>H5414</sup> thee of the land<sup>H776</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup> any possession<sup>H3425</sup>, because I have given<sup>H5414</sup> it unto the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Lot<sup>H3876</sup> for a possession<sup>H3425</sup>. 20 (That also was accounted<sup>H2803</sup> a land<sup>H776</sup> of giants<sup>H7497</sup>: giants<sup>H7497</sup> dwell<sup>H3427</sup> therein in old time<sup>H6440</sup>; and the Ammonites<sup>H5984</sup> call<sup>H7121</sup> them Zamzummims<sup>H2157</sup>); 21 A people<sup>H5971</sup> great<sup>H1419</sup>, and many<sup>H7227</sup>, and tall<sup>H7311</sup>, as the Anakims<sup>H6062</sup>, but the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> them before<sup>H6440</sup> them; and they succeeded<sup>H3423</sup> them, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in their stead: 22 As he did<sup>H6213</sup> to the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Esau<sup>H6215</sup>, which dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Seir<sup>H8165</sup>, when he destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> the Horims<sup>H2752</sup> from before<sup>H6440</sup> them; and they succeeded<sup>H3423</sup> them, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in their stead even unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>: 23 And the Avims<sup>H5761</sup> which dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Hazerim<sup>H2699</sup>, even unto Azzah<sup>H5804</sup>, the Caphtorims<sup>H3732</sup>, which came forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of Caphtor<sup>H3731</sup>, destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> them, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in their stead.)

24 Rise ye up<sup>H6965</sup>, take your journey<sup>H5265</sup>, and pass over<sup>H5674</sup> the river<sup>H5158</sup> Arnon<sup>H769</sup>: behold<sup>H7200</sup>, I have given<sup>H5414</sup>

into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup> Sihon<sup>H5511</sup> the Amorite<sup>H567</sup>, king<sup>H4428</sup> of Heshbon<sup>H2809</sup>, and his land<sup>H776</sup>: begin<sup>H2490</sup> to possess<sup>H3423</sup> it, and contend<sup>H1624</sup> with him in battle<sup>H4421</sup>. **25** This day<sup>H3117</sup> will I begin<sup>H2490</sup> to put<sup>H5414</sup> the dread<sup>H6343</sup> of thee and the fear<sup>H3374</sup> of thee upon the nations<sup>H6440</sup> H5971 that are under the whole heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, who shall hear<sup>H8085</sup> report<sup>H8088</sup> of thee, and shall tremble<sup>H7264</sup>, and be in anguish<sup>H2342</sup> because of thee<sup>H6440</sup>. **26** And I sent<sup>H7971</sup> messengers<sup>H4397</sup> out of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Kedemoth<sup>H6932</sup> unto Sihon<sup>H5511</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Heshbon<sup>H2809</sup> with words<sup>H1697</sup> of peace<sup>H7965</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, **27** Let me pass<sup>H5674</sup> through thy land<sup>H776</sup>: I will go<sup>H3212</sup> along by the high way<sup>H1870</sup> H1870, I will neither turn<sup>H5493</sup> unto the right hand<sup>H3225</sup> nor to the left<sup>H8040</sup>. **28** Thou shalt sell<sup>H7666</sup> me meat<sup>H400</sup> for money<sup>H3701</sup>, that I may eat<sup>H398</sup>, and give<sup>H5414</sup> me water<sup>H4325</sup> for money<sup>H3701</sup>, that I may drink<sup>H8354</sup>: only I will pass through<sup>H5674</sup> on my feet<sup>H7272</sup>; **29** (As the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Esau<sup>H6215</sup> which dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Seir<sup>H8165</sup>, and the Moabites<sup>H4125</sup> which dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in Ar<sup>H6144</sup>, did<sup>H6213</sup> unto me;) until I shall pass over<sup>H5674</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup> into the land<sup>H776</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> giveth<sup>H5414</sup> us. **30** But Sihon<sup>H5511</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Heshbon<sup>H2809</sup> would<sup>H14</sup> not let us pass<sup>H5674</sup> by him: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hardened<sup>H7185</sup> his spirit<sup>H7307</sup>, and made his heart<sup>H3824</sup> obstinate<sup>H553</sup>, that he might deliver<sup>H5414</sup> him into thy hand<sup>H3027</sup>, as appeareth this day<sup>H3117</sup>. **31** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Behold<sup>H7200</sup>, I have begun<sup>H2490</sup> to give<sup>H5414</sup> Sihon<sup>H5511</sup> and his land<sup>H776</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee: begin<sup>H2490</sup> to possess<sup>H3423</sup>, that thou mayest inherit<sup>H3423</sup> his land<sup>H776</sup>. **32** Then Sihon<sup>H5511</sup> came out<sup>H3318</sup> against<sup>H7125</sup> us, he and all his people<sup>H5971</sup>, to fight<sup>H4421</sup> at Jahaz<sup>H3096</sup>. **33** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> delivered<sup>H5414</sup> him before<sup>H6440</sup> us; and we smote<sup>H5221</sup> him, and his sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and all his people<sup>H5971</sup>. **34** And we took<sup>H3920</sup> all his cities<sup>H5892</sup> at that time<sup>H6256</sup>, and utterly destroyed<sup>H2763</sup> the men<sup>H4962</sup>, and the women<sup>H802</sup>, and the little ones<sup>H2945</sup>, of every city<sup>H5892</sup>, we left<sup>H7604</sup> none to remain<sup>H8300</sup>. **35** Only the cattle<sup>H929</sup> we took for a prey<sup>H962</sup> unto ourselves, and the spoil<sup>H7998</sup> of the cities<sup>H5892</sup> which we took<sup>H3920</sup>. **36** From Aroer<sup>H6177</sup>, which is by the brink<sup>H8193</sup> of the river<sup>H5158</sup> of Arnon<sup>H769</sup>, and from the city<sup>H5892</sup> that is by the river<sup>H5158</sup>, even unto Gilead<sup>H1568</sup>, there was not one city<sup>H7151</sup> too strong<sup>H7682</sup> for us: the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> delivered<sup>H5414</sup> all unto us<sup>H6440</sup>. **37** Only unto the land<sup>H776</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup> thou camest<sup>H7126</sup> not, nor unto any place<sup>H3027</sup> of the river<sup>H5158</sup> Jabbok<sup>H2999</sup>, nor unto the cities<sup>H5892</sup> in the mountains<sup>H2022</sup>, nor unto whatsoever the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> forbad<sup>H6680</sup> us.
