

# Deuteronomy 27

1 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> with the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Keep<sup>H8104</sup> all the commandments<sup>H4687</sup> which I command<sup>H6680</sup> you this day<sup>H3117</sup>. 2 And it shall be on the day<sup>H3117</sup> when ye shall pass over<sup>H5674</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup> unto the land<sup>H776</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> giveth<sup>H5414</sup> thee, that thou shalt set thee up<sup>H6965</sup> great<sup>H1419</sup> stones<sup>H68</sup>, and plaister<sup>H7874</sup> them with plaister<sup>H7875</sup>. 3 And thou shalt write<sup>H3789</sup> upon them all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this law<sup>H8451</sup>, when thou art passed over<sup>H5674</sup>, that thou mayest go in<sup>H935</sup> unto the land<sup>H776</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> giveth<sup>H5414</sup> thee, a land<sup>H776</sup> that floweth<sup>H2100</sup> with milk<sup>H2461</sup> and honey<sup>H1706</sup>; as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of thy fathers<sup>H1</sup> hath promised<sup>H1696</sup> thee. 4 Therefore it shall be when ye be gone over<sup>H5674</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup>, that ye shall set up<sup>H6965</sup> these stones<sup>H68</sup>, which I command<sup>H6680</sup> you this day<sup>H3117</sup>, in mount<sup>H2022</sup> Ebal<sup>H5858</sup>, and thou shalt plaister<sup>H7875</sup> them with plaister<sup>H7874</sup>. 5 And there shalt thou build<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, an altar<sup>H4196</sup> of stones<sup>H68</sup>: thou shalt not lift up<sup>H5130</sup> any iron<sup>H1270</sup> tool upon them. 6 Thou shalt build<sup>H1129</sup> the altar<sup>H4196</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> of whole<sup>H8003</sup> stones<sup>H68</sup>: and thou shalt offer<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> thereon unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>. 7 And thou shalt offer<sup>H2076</sup> peace offerings<sup>H8002</sup>, and shalt eat<sup>H398</sup> there, and rejoice<sup>H8055</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>. 8 And thou shalt write<sup>H3789</sup> upon the stones<sup>H68</sup> all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this law<sup>H8451</sup> very<sup>H3190</sup> plainly<sup>H874</sup>. 9 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> and the priests<sup>H3548</sup> the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Take heed<sup>H5535</sup>, and hearken<sup>H8085</sup>, O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; this day<sup>H3117</sup> thou art become<sup>H1961</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>. 10 Thou shalt therefore obey<sup>H8085</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, and do<sup>H6213</sup> his commandments<sup>H4687</sup> and his statutes<sup>H2706</sup>, which I command<sup>H6680</sup> thee this day<sup>H3117</sup>.

11 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> charged<sup>H6680</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> the same day<sup>H3117</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 12 These shall stand<sup>H5975</sup> upon mount<sup>H2022</sup> Gerizim<sup>H1630</sup> to bless<sup>H1288</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, when ye are come over<sup>H5674</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup>; Simeon<sup>H8095</sup>, and Levi<sup>H3878</sup>, and Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and Issachar<sup>H3485</sup>, and Joseph<sup>H3130</sup>, and Benjamin<sup>H1144</sup>: 13 And these shall stand<sup>H5975</sup> upon mount<sup>H2022</sup> Ebal<sup>H5858</sup> to curse<sup>H7045</sup>; Reuben<sup>H7205</sup>, Gad<sup>H1410</sup>, and Asher<sup>H836</sup>, and Zebulun<sup>H2074</sup>, Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, and Naphtali<sup>H5321</sup>. 14 And the Levites<sup>H3881</sup> shall speak<sup>H6030</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto all the men<sup>H376</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> with a loud<sup>H7311</sup> voice<sup>H6963</sup>, 15 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be the man<sup>H376</sup> that maketh<sup>H6213</sup> any graven<sup>H6459</sup> or molten image<sup>H4541</sup>, an abomination<sup>H8441</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the work<sup>H4639</sup> of the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of the craftsman<sup>H2796</sup>, and putteth<sup>H7760</sup> it in a secret<sup>H5643</sup> place. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall answer<sup>H6030</sup> and say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 16 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that setteth light<sup>H7034</sup> by his father<sup>H1</sup> or his mother<sup>H517</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 17 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that removeth<sup>H5253</sup> his neighbour's<sup>H7453</sup> landmark<sup>H1366</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 18 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that maketh the blind<sup>H5787</sup> to wander<sup>H7686</sup> out of the way<sup>H1870</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 19 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that perverteth<sup>H5186</sup> the judgment<sup>H4941</sup> of the stranger<sup>H1616</sup>, fatherless<sup>H3490</sup>, and widow<sup>H490</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 20 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that lieth<sup>H7901</sup> with his father's<sup>H1</sup> wife<sup>H802</sup>; because he uncovereth<sup>H1540</sup> his father's<sup>H1</sup> skirt<sup>H3671</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 21 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that lieth<sup>H7901</sup> with any manner of beast<sup>H929</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 22 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that lieth<sup>H7901</sup> with his sister<sup>H269</sup>, the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of his father<sup>H1</sup>, or the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of his mother<sup>H517</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 23 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that lieth<sup>H7901</sup> with his mother in law<sup>H2859</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 24 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that smiteth<sup>H5221</sup> his neighbour<sup>H7453</sup> secretly<sup>H5643</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 25 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that taketh<sup>H3947</sup> reward<sup>H7810</sup> to slay<sup>H5221</sup> an innocent<sup>H5355</sup> person<sup>H5315 H1818</sup>. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>. 26 Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be he that confirmeth<sup>H6965</sup> not all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this law<sup>H8451</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> them. And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> shall say<sup>H559</sup>, Amen<sup>H543</sup>.
