

# Deuteronomy 34

**1** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> from the plains<sup>H6160</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup> unto the mountain<sup>H2022</sup> of Nebo<sup>H5015</sup>, to the top<sup>H7218</sup> of Pisgah<sup>H6449</sup>, that is over against<sup>H6440</sup> Jericho<sup>H3405</sup>. And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shewed<sup>H7200</sup> him all the land<sup>H776</sup> of Gilead<sup>H1568</sup>, unto Dan<sup>H1835</sup>, **2** And all Naphtali<sup>H5321</sup>, and the land<sup>H776</sup> of Ephraim<sup>H669</sup>, and Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup>, and all the land<sup>H776</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, unto the utmost<sup>H314</sup> sea<sup>H3220</sup>, **3** And the south<sup>H5045</sup>, and the plain<sup>H3603</sup> of the valley<sup>H1237</sup> of Jericho<sup>H3405</sup>, the city<sup>H5892</sup> of palm trees<sup>H8558 H5899</sup>, unto Zoar<sup>H6820</sup>. **4** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, This is the land<sup>H776</sup> which I sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, unto Isaac<sup>H3327</sup>, and unto Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, I will give<sup>H5414</sup> it unto thy seed<sup>H2233</sup>: I have caused thee to see<sup>H7200</sup> it with thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, but thou shalt not go over<sup>H5674</sup> thither.

**5** So Moses<sup>H4872</sup> the servant<sup>H5650</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> died<sup>H4191</sup> there in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, according to the word<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **6** And he buried<sup>H6912</sup> him in a valley<sup>H1516</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, over against<sup>H4136</sup> Bethpeor<sup>H1047</sup>: but no man<sup>H376</sup> knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> of his sepulchre<sup>H6900</sup> unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>. **7** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> was an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> old<sup>H1121</sup> when he died<sup>H4194</sup>: his eye<sup>H5869</sup> was not dim<sup>H3543</sup>, nor his natural force<sup>H3893</sup> abated<sup>H5127</sup>. **8** And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> wept<sup>H1058</sup> for Moses<sup>H4872</sup> in the plains<sup>H6160</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup> thirty<sup>H7970</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: so the days<sup>H3117</sup> of weeping<sup>H1065</sup> and mourning<sup>H60</sup> for Moses<sup>H4872</sup> were ended<sup>H8552</sup>.

**9** And Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Nun<sup>H5126</sup> was full<sup>H4392</sup> of the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of wisdom<sup>H2451</sup>; for Moses<sup>H4872</sup> had laid<sup>H5564</sup> his hands<sup>H3027</sup> upon him: and the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> unto him, and did<sup>H6213</sup> as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> Moses<sup>H4872</sup>. **10** And there arose<sup>H6965</sup> not a prophet<sup>H5030</sup> since<sup>H5750</sup> in Israel<sup>H3478</sup> like unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> knew<sup>H3045</sup> face<sup>H6440</sup> to face<sup>H6440</sup>, **11** In all the signs<sup>H226</sup> and the wonders<sup>H4159</sup>, which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> him to do<sup>H6213</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> to Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup>, and to all his servants<sup>H5650</sup>, and to all his land<sup>H776</sup>, **12** And in all that mighty<sup>H2389</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and in all the great<sup>H1419</sup> terror<sup>H4172</sup> which Moses<sup>H4872</sup> shewed<sup>H6213</sup> in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of all Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.
