## **Deuteronomy 7**

1 When the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> shall bring<sup>H935</sup> thee into the land<sup>H776</sup> whither thou goest<sup>H935</sup> to possess<sup>H3423</sup> it, and hath cast out<sup>H5394</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> nations<sup>H1471</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee, the Hittites<sup>H2850</sup>, and the Girgashites<sup>H1622</sup>, and the Amorites<sup>H567</sup>, and the Canaanites<sup>H3669</sup>, and the Perizzites<sup>H6522</sup>, and the Hivites<sup>H2340</sup>, and the Jebusites<sup>H2983</sup>, seven<sup>H7651</sup> nations<sup>H1471</sup> greater<sup>H7227</sup> and mightier<sup>H6099</sup> than thou; 2 And when the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> shall deliver<sup>H5414</sup> them before H6440 thee; thou shalt smite H5221 them, and utterly H2763 destroy H2763 them; thou shalt make H3772 no covenant H1285 with them, nor shew mercy<sup>H2603</sup> unto them: **3** Neither shalt thou make marriages<sup>H2859</sup> with them; thy daughter<sup>H1323</sup> thou shalt not give H5414 unto his son H1121, nor his daughter H1323 shalt thou take H3947 unto thy son H1121. 4 For they will turn away<sup>H5493</sup> thy son<sup>H1121</sup> from following<sup>H310</sup> me, that they may serve<sup>H5647</sup> other<sup>H312</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup>: so will the anger<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> be kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against you, and destroy<sup>H8045</sup> thee suddenly<sup>H4118</sup>. **5** But thus shall ye deal<sup>H6213</sup> with them; ye shall destroy H5422 their altars H4196, and break down H7665 their images H4676, and cut down H1438 their groves H842, and burn H8313 their graven images H6456 with fire H784.1 6 For thou art an holy P6918 people people unto the LORD thy God<sup>H430</sup>: the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> hath chosen<sup>H977</sup> thee to be a special<sup>H5459</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup> unto himself, above all people<sup>H5971</sup> that are upon the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>. **7** The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> did not set his love<sup>H2836</sup> upon you, nor choose H977 you, because ye were more H7230 in number than any people H5971; for ye were the fewest of all people<sup>H5971</sup>: 8 But because the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> loved<sup>H160</sup> you, and because he would keep<sup>H8104</sup> the oath<sup>H7621</sup> which he had redeemed<sup>H6299</sup> you out of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of bondmen<sup>H5650</sup>, from the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 9 Know H3045 therefore that the LORD H3068 thy God H430, he is God H430, the faithful H539 God H410, which keepeth H8104 covenant H1285 and mercy H2617 with them that love H157 him and keep H8104 his commandments H4687 to a thousand H505 generations H1755; 10 And repayeth H7999 them that hate H8130 him to their face H6440, to destroy them: he will not be slack<sup>H309</sup> to him that hateth<sup>H8130</sup> him, he will repay<sup>H7999</sup> him to his face<sup>H6440</sup>. 11 Thou shalt therefore keep<sup>H8104</sup> the commandments<sup>H4687</sup>, and the statutes<sup>H2706</sup>, and the judgments<sup>H4941</sup>, which I command<sup>H6680</sup> thee this day<sup>H3117</sup>, to do<sup>H6213</sup> them.

12 Wherefore it shall come to pass, if He118 ye hearken to these judgments H4941, and keep H8104, and do H6213 them, that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> shall keep<sup>H8104</sup> unto thee the covenant<sup>H1285</sup> and the mercy<sup>H2617</sup> which he sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto thy fathers<sup>H1</sup>:<sup>2</sup> 13 And he will love<sup>H157</sup> thee, and bless<sup>H1288</sup> thee, and multiply<sup>H7235</sup> thee: he will also bless<sup>H1288</sup> the fruit H6529 of thy womb H990, and the fruit H6529 of thy land H127, thy corn H1715, and thy wine H8492, and thine oil H3323, the increase<sup>H7698</sup> of thy kine<sup>H504</sup>, and the flocks<sup>H6251</sup> of thy sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, in the land<sup>H127</sup> which he sware<sup>H7650</sup> unto thy fathers<sup>H1</sup> to give<sup>H5414</sup> thee. **14** Thou shalt be blessed<sup>H1288</sup> above all people<sup>H5971</sup>: there shall not be male<sup>H6135</sup> or female barren<sup>H6135</sup> among you, or among your cattle<sup>H929</sup>. **15** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will take away<sup>H5493</sup> from thee all sickness<sup>H2483</sup>, and will put<sup>H7760</sup> none of the evil<sup>H7451</sup> diseases<sup>H4064</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, which thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup>, upon thee; but will lay<sup>H5414</sup> them upon all them that hate H8130 thee. 16 And thou shalt consume all the people H5971 which the LORD thy God<sup>H430</sup> shall deliver<sup>H5414</sup> thee; thine eye<sup>H5869</sup> shall have no pity<sup>H2347</sup> upon them: neither shalt thou serve<sup>H5647</sup> their  $gods^{H430}$ ; for that will be a snare  $^{H4170}$  unto thee. 17 If thou shalt say  $^{H559}$  in thine heart  $^{H3824}$ , These nations  $^{H1471}$  are more H7227 than I; how H349 can H3201 I dispossess H3423 them? 18 Thou shalt not be afraid H3372 of them: but shalt well H2142 remember H2142 what the LORD H3068 thy God H430 did H6213 unto Pharaoh H6547, and unto all Egypt H4714; 19 The great H1419 temptations H4531 which thine eyes saw saw saw, and the signs saw, and the wonders and the mighty saw, and the mighty saw.  $hand^{H3027}$ , and the stretched out  $^{H5186}$  arm  $^{H2220}$ , whereby the LORD  $^{H3068}$  thy God  $^{H430}$  brought thee out  $^{H3318}$ : so shall the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> do<sup>H6213</sup> unto all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of whom thou art afraid<sup>H3373</sup> H6440. **20** Moreover the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> will send<sup>H7971</sup> the hornet<sup>H6880</sup> among them, until they that are left<sup>H7604</sup>, and hide<sup>H5641</sup> themselves from<sup>H6440</sup> thee, be destroyed  $^{H6}$ . 21 Thou shalt not be affrighted  $^{H6206}$  at  $^{H6440}$  them: for the LORD  $^{H3068}$  thy God  $^{H430}$  is among  $^{H7130}$ 

you, a mighty<sup>H1419</sup> God<sup>H410</sup> and terrible<sup>H3372</sup>. **22** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> will put out<sup>H5394</sup> those<sup>H411</sup> nations<sup>H1471</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee by little<sup>H4592</sup> and little<sup>H4592</sup>: thou mayest<sup>H3201</sup> not consume<sup>H3615</sup> them at once<sup>H4118</sup>, lest the beasts<sup>H2416</sup> of the field<sup>H7704</sup> increase<sup>H7235</sup> upon thee.<sup>3</sup> **23** But the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup> shall deliver<sup>H5414</sup> them unto thee<sup>H6440</sup>, and shall destroy<sup>H1949</sup> them with a mighty<sup>H1419</sup> destruction<sup>H4103</sup>, until they be destroyed<sup>H8045</sup>.<sup>4</sup> **24** And he shall deliver<sup>H5414</sup> their kings<sup>H4428</sup> into thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and thou shalt destroy<sup>H6</sup> their name<sup>H8034</sup> from under heaven<sup>H8064</sup>: there shall no man<sup>H376</sup> be able to stand<sup>H3320</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee, until thou have destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> them. **25** The graven images<sup>H6456</sup> of their gods<sup>H430</sup> shall ye burn<sup>H8313</sup> with fire<sup>H784</sup>: thou shalt not desire<sup>H2530</sup> the silver<sup>H3701</sup> or gold<sup>H2091</sup> that is on them, nor take<sup>H3947</sup> it unto thee, lest thou be snared<sup>H3369</sup> therein: for it is an abomination<sup>H8441</sup> to the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>. **26** Neither shalt thou bring<sup>H935</sup> an abomination<sup>H8441</sup> into thine house<sup>H1004</sup>, lest thou be a cursed thing<sup>H2764</sup> like it: but thou shalt utterly<sup>H8581</sup> detest<sup>H262</sup> it, and thou shalt utterly<sup>H8581</sup> abhor<sup>H8581</sup> it; for it is a cursed thing<sup>H2764</sup>.
