

# Exodus 17



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 And all the congregation<sup>H5712</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> journeyed<sup>H5265</sup> from the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Sin<sup>H5512</sup>, after their journeys<sup>H4550</sup>, according to the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and pitched<sup>H2583</sup> in Rephidim<sup>H7508</sup>: and there was no water<sup>H4325</sup> for the people<sup>H5971</sup> to drink<sup>H8354</sup>. 2 Wherefore the people<sup>H5971</sup> did chide<sup>H7378</sup> with Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Give<sup>H5414</sup> us water<sup>H4325</sup> that we may drink<sup>H8354</sup>. And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Why chide<sup>H7378</sup> ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt<sup>H5254</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>? 3 And the people<sup>H5971</sup> thirsted<sup>H6770</sup> there for water<sup>H4325</sup>, and the people<sup>H5971</sup> murmured<sup>H3885</sup> against Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Wherefore is this that thou hast brought<sup>H5927</sup> us up out of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, to kill<sup>H4191</sup> us and our children<sup>H1121</sup> and our cattle<sup>H4735</sup> with thirst<sup>H6772</sup>? 4 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> cried<sup>H6817</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, What shall I do<sup>H6213</sup> unto this people<sup>H5971</sup>? they be almost<sup>H4592</sup> ready to stone<sup>H5619</sup> me. 5 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Go on<sup>H5674</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, and take<sup>H3947</sup> with thee of the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; and thy rod<sup>H4294</sup>, wherewith thou smotest<sup>H5221</sup> the river<sup>H2975</sup>, take<sup>H3947</sup> in thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and go<sup>H1980</sup>. 6 Behold, I will stand<sup>H5975</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee there upon the rock<sup>H6697</sup> in Horeb<sup>H2722</sup>, and thou shalt smite<sup>H5221</sup> the rock<sup>H6697</sup>, and there shall come<sup>H3318</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup> out of it, that the people<sup>H5971</sup> may drink<sup>H8354</sup>. And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> so in the sight<sup>H5869</sup> of the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 7 And he called<sup>H7121</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the place<sup>H4725</sup> Massah<sup>H4532</sup>, and Meribah<sup>H4809</sup>, because of the chiding<sup>H7379</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and because they tempted<sup>H5254</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Is<sup>H3426</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> among<sup>H7130</sup> us, or not?<sup>12</sup>

8 Then came<sup>H935</sup> Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>, and fought<sup>H3898</sup> with Israel<sup>H3478</sup> in Rephidim<sup>H7508</sup>. 9 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Joshua<sup>H3091</sup>, Choose us out<sup>H977</sup> men<sup>H582</sup>, and go out<sup>H3318</sup>, fight<sup>H3898</sup> with Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>: to morrow<sup>H4279</sup> I will stand<sup>H5324</sup> on the top<sup>H7218</sup> of the hill<sup>H1389</sup> with the rod<sup>H4294</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> in mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 10 So Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> as Moses<sup>H4872</sup> had said<sup>H559</sup> to him, and fought<sup>H3898</sup> with Amalek<sup>H6002</sup>: and Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, and Hur<sup>H2354</sup> went up<sup>H5927</sup> to the top<sup>H7218</sup> of the hill<sup>H1389</sup>. 11 And it came to pass, when Moses<sup>H4872</sup> held up<sup>H7311</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, that Israel<sup>H3478</sup> prevailed<sup>H1396</sup>: and when he let down<sup>H5117</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, Amalek<sup>H6002</sup> prevailed<sup>H1396</sup>. 12 But Moses<sup>H4872</sup> hands<sup>H3027</sup> were heavy<sup>H3515</sup>, and they took<sup>H3947</sup> a stone<sup>H68</sup>, and put<sup>H7760</sup> it under him, and he sat<sup>H3427</sup> thereon; and Aaron<sup>H175</sup> and Hur<sup>H2354</sup> stayed up<sup>H8551</sup> his hands<sup>H3027</sup>, the one on the one side<sup>H259</sup>, and the other on the other side<sup>H259</sup>; and his hands<sup>H3027</sup> were steady<sup>H530</sup> until the going down<sup>H935</sup> of the sun<sup>H8121</sup>. 13 And Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> discomfited<sup>H2522</sup> Amalek<sup>H6002</sup> and his people<sup>H5971</sup> with the edge<sup>H6310</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup>. 14 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Write<sup>H3789</sup> this for a memorial<sup>H2146</sup> in a book<sup>H5612</sup>, and rehearse<sup>H7760</sup> it in the ears<sup>H241</sup> of Joshua<sup>H3091</sup>: for I will utterly<sup>H4229</sup> put out<sup>H4229</sup> the remembrance<sup>H2143</sup> of Amalek<sup>H6002</sup> from under heaven<sup>H8064</sup>. 15 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> built<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of it Jehovahnissi<sup>H3071</sup>. 16 For he said<sup>H559</sup>, Because the LORD<sup>H3050</sup> hath sworn<sup>H3027 H3676</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will have war<sup>H4421</sup> with Amalek<sup>H6002</sup> from generation<sup>H1755</sup> to generation<sup>H1755 56</sup>.

1. Massah: that is, Temptation
2. Meribah: that is, Chiding, or, Strife
3. Joshua: called Jesus
4. Jehovahnissi: that is, The LORD my banner
5. Because...: or, Because the hand of Amalek is against the throne of the LORD, therefore, etc
6. the LORD hath...: Heb. the hand upon the throne of the LORD
