

# Exodus 32



Englische King James Version von 1611/1769 mit Strongs

1 And when the people<sup>H5971</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that Moses<sup>H4872</sup> delayed<sup>H954</sup> to come down<sup>H3381</sup> out of the mount<sup>H2022</sup>, the people<sup>H5971</sup> gathered themselves together<sup>H6950</sup> unto Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Up<sup>H6965</sup>, make<sup>H6213</sup> us gods<sup>H430</sup>, which shall go<sup>H3212</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> us; for as for this Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, the man<sup>H376</sup> that brought<sup>H5927</sup> us up out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, we wot<sup>H3045</sup> not what is become of him. 2 And Aaron<sup>H175</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Break off<sup>H6561</sup> the golden<sup>H2091</sup> earrings<sup>H5141</sup>, which are in the ears<sup>H241</sup> of your wives<sup>H802</sup>, of your sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and of your daughters<sup>H1323</sup>, and bring<sup>H935</sup> them unto me. 3 And all the people<sup>H5971</sup> brake off<sup>H6561</sup> the golden<sup>H2091</sup> earrings<sup>H5141</sup> which were in their ears<sup>H241</sup>, and brought<sup>H935</sup> them unto Aaron<sup>H175</sup>. 4 And he received<sup>H3947</sup> them at their hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and fashioned<sup>H6696</sup> it with a graving tool<sup>H2747</sup>, after he had made<sup>H6213</sup> it a molten<sup>H4541</sup> calf<sup>H5695</sup>: and they said<sup>H559</sup>, These be thy gods<sup>H430</sup>, O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, which brought<sup>H5927</sup> thee up out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 5 And when Aaron<sup>H175</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> it, he built<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> it; and Aaron<sup>H175</sup> made proclamation<sup>H7121</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, To morrow<sup>H4279</sup> is a feast<sup>H2282</sup> to the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 6 And they rose up early<sup>H7925</sup> on the morrow<sup>H4283</sup>, and offered<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup>, and brought<sup>H5066</sup> peace offerings<sup>H8002</sup>, and the people<sup>H5971</sup> sat<sup>H3427</sup> down to eat<sup>H398</sup> and to drink<sup>H8354</sup>, and rose up<sup>H6965</sup> to play<sup>H6711</sup>.

7 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, get thee down<sup>H3381</sup>; for thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, which thou broughtest<sup>H5927</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, have corrupted<sup>H7843</sup> themselves: 8 They have turned<sup>H5493</sup> aside quickly<sup>H4118</sup> out of the way<sup>H1870</sup> which I commanded<sup>H6680</sup> them: they have made<sup>H6213</sup> them a molten<sup>H4541</sup> calf<sup>H5695</sup>, and have worshipped<sup>H7812</sup> it, and have sacrificed<sup>H2076</sup> thereunto, and said<sup>H559</sup>, These be thy gods<sup>H430</sup>, O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, which have brought thee up<sup>H5927</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 9 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, I have seen<sup>H7200</sup> this people<sup>H5971</sup>, and, behold, it is a stiffnecked<sup>H7186 H6203</sup> people<sup>H5971</sup>: 10 Now therefore let me alone<sup>H3240</sup>, that my wrath<sup>H639</sup> may wax hot<sup>H2734</sup> against them, and that I may consume<sup>H3615</sup> them: and I will make<sup>H6213</sup> of thee a great<sup>H1419</sup> nation<sup>H1471</sup>. 11 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> besought<sup>H2470 H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> his God<sup>H430</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, why doth thy wrath<sup>H639</sup> wax hot<sup>H2734</sup> against thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, which thou hast brought forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup> with great<sup>H1419</sup> power<sup>H3581</sup>, and with a mighty<sup>H2389</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>? 12 Wherefore should the Egyptians<sup>H4714</sup> speak<sup>H559</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup>, For mischief<sup>H7451</sup> did he bring<sup>H3318</sup> them out, to slay<sup>H2026</sup> them in the mountains<sup>H2022</sup>, and to consume<sup>H3615</sup> them from the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>? Turn<sup>H7725</sup> from thy fierce<sup>H2740</sup> wrath<sup>H639</sup>, and repent<sup>H5162</sup> of this evil<sup>H7451</sup> against thy people<sup>H5971</sup>. 13 Remember<sup>H2142</sup> Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, Isaac<sup>H3327</sup>, and Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, thy servants<sup>H5650</sup>, to whom thou swarest<sup>H7650</sup> by thine own self, and saidst<sup>H1696</sup> unto them, I will multiply<sup>H7235</sup> your seed<sup>H2233</sup> as the stars<sup>H3556</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, and all this land<sup>H776</sup> that I have spoken<sup>H559</sup> of will I give<sup>H5414</sup> unto your seed<sup>H2233</sup>, and they shall inherit<sup>H5157</sup> it for ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 14 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> of the evil<sup>H7451</sup> which he thought<sup>H1696</sup> to do<sup>H6213</sup> unto his people<sup>H5971</sup>.

15 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> turned<sup>H6437</sup>, and went down<sup>H3381</sup> from the mount<sup>H2022</sup>, and the two<sup>H8147</sup> tables<sup>H3871</sup> of the testimony<sup>H5715</sup> were in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>: the tables<sup>H3871</sup> were written<sup>H3789</sup> on both<sup>H8147</sup> their sides<sup>H5676</sup>; on the one side and on the other were they written<sup>H3789</sup>. 16 And the tables<sup>H3871</sup> were the work<sup>H4639</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, and the writing<sup>H4385</sup> was the writing<sup>H4385</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, graven<sup>H2801</sup> upon the tables<sup>H3871</sup>. 17 And when Joshua<sup>H3091</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> the noise<sup>H6963</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> as they shouted<sup>H7452</sup>, he said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, There is a noise<sup>H6963</sup> of war<sup>H4421</sup> in the camp<sup>H4264</sup>. 18 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, It is not the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of them that shout<sup>H6030</sup> for mastery<sup>H1369</sup>, neither is it the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of them that cry<sup>H6030</sup> for being overcome<sup>H2476</sup>: but the noise<sup>H6963</sup> of them that sing<sup>H6031</sup> do I hear<sup>H8085</sup>. 19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh<sup>H7126</sup> unto the camp<sup>H4264</sup>, that he saw<sup>H7200</sup> the calf<sup>H5695</sup>, and the dancing<sup>H4246</sup>: and Moses<sup>H4872</sup> anger<sup>H639</sup> waxed hot<sup>H2734</sup>, and he cast<sup>H7993</sup> the tables<sup>H3871</sup> out of his hands<sup>H3027</sup>, and brake<sup>H7665</sup> them beneath<sup>H8478</sup> the mount<sup>H2022</sup>. 20 And he took<sup>H3947</sup> the calf<sup>H5695</sup> which they had made<sup>H6213</sup>, and burnt<sup>H8313</sup> it in the fire<sup>H784</sup>, and ground<sup>H2912</sup> it to powder<sup>H1854</sup>, and strawed<sup>H2219</sup> it upon<sup>H6440</sup> the water<sup>H4325</sup>, and made the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> drink<sup>H8248</sup> of it.

21 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, What did<sup>H6213</sup> this people<sup>H5971</sup> unto thee, that thou hast brought<sup>H935</sup> so great<sup>H1419</sup> a sin<sup>H2401</sup> upon them? 22 And Aaron<sup>H175</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Let not the anger<sup>H639</sup> of my lord<sup>H113</sup> wax hot<sup>H2734</sup>: thou knowest<sup>H3045</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, that they are set on mischief<sup>H7451</sup>. 23 For they said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Make<sup>H6213</sup> us gods<sup>H430</sup>, which shall go<sup>H3212</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> us: for as for this Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, the man<sup>H376</sup> that brought us up<sup>H5927</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, we wot<sup>H3045</sup> not what is become of him. 24 And I said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Whosoever hath any gold<sup>H2091</sup>, let them break<sup>H6561</sup> it off. So they gave<sup>H5414</sup> it me: then I cast<sup>H7993</sup> it into the fire<sup>H784</sup>, and there came out<sup>H3318</sup> this calf<sup>H5695</sup>. 25 And when Moses<sup>H4872</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that the people<sup>H5971</sup> were naked<sup>H6544</sup>; (for Aaron<sup>H175</sup> had made them naked<sup>H6544</sup> unto their shame<sup>H8103</sup> among their enemies<sup>H6965</sup>;) 26 Then Moses<sup>H4872</sup> stood<sup>H5975</sup> in the gate<sup>H8179</sup> of the camp<sup>H4264</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Who is on the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> side? let him come unto me. And all the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Levi<sup>H3878</sup> gathered<sup>H622</sup> themselves together unto him. 27 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Put<sup>H7760</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> his sword<sup>H2719</sup> by his side<sup>H3409</sup>, and go<sup>H5674</sup> in and out<sup>H7725</sup> from gate<sup>H8179</sup> to gate<sup>H8179</sup> throughout the camp<sup>H4264</sup>, and slay<sup>H2026</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> his brother<sup>H251</sup>, and every man<sup>H376</sup> his companion<sup>H7453</sup>, and every man<sup>H376</sup> his neighbour<sup>H7138</sup>. 28 And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Levi<sup>H3878</sup> did<sup>H6213</sup> according to the word<sup>H1697</sup> of Moses<sup>H4872</sup>: and there fell<sup>H5307</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup> that day<sup>H3117</sup> about three<sup>H7969</sup> thousand<sup>H505</sup> men<sup>H376</sup>. 29 For Moses<sup>H4872</sup> had said<sup>H559</sup>, Consecrate yourselves<sup>H4390 H3027</sup> to day<sup>H3117</sup> to the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, even<sup>H3588</sup> every man<sup>H376</sup> upon his son<sup>H1121</sup>, and upon his brother<sup>H251</sup>; that he may bestow<sup>H5414</sup> upon you a blessing<sup>H1293</sup> this day<sup>H3117</sup>.<sup>45</sup>

30 And it came to pass on the morrow<sup>H4283</sup>, that Moses<sup>H4872</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the people<sup>H5971</sup>, Ye have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> a great<sup>H1419</sup> sin<sup>H2401</sup>: and now I will go up<sup>H5927</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; peradventure<sup>H194</sup> I shall make an atonement<sup>H3722</sup> for<sup>H1157</sup> your sin<sup>H2403</sup>. 31 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> returned<sup>H7725</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Oh<sup>H577</sup>, this people<sup>H5971</sup> have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> a great<sup>H1419</sup> sin<sup>H2401</sup>, and have made<sup>H6213</sup> them gods<sup>H430</sup> of gold<sup>H2091</sup>. 32 Yet now, if thou wilt forgive<sup>H5375</sup> their sin<sup>H2403</sup>--; and if not, blot<sup>H4229</sup> me, I pray thee, out of thy book<sup>H5612</sup> which thou hast written<sup>H3789</sup>. 33 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Whosoever<sup>H834</sup> hath sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against me, him will I blot out<sup>H4229</sup> of my book<sup>H5612</sup>. 34 Therefore now go<sup>H3212</sup>, lead<sup>H5148</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup> unto the place of which I have spoken<sup>H1696</sup> unto thee: behold, mine Angel<sup>H4397</sup> shall go<sup>H3212</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> thee: nevertheless in the day<sup>H3117</sup> when I visit<sup>H6485</sup> I will visit<sup>H6485</sup> their sin<sup>H2403</sup> upon them. 35 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> plagued<sup>H5062</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, because<sup>H834</sup> they made<sup>H6213</sup> the calf<sup>H5695</sup>, which<sup>H834</sup> Aaron<sup>H175</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup>.
