## Exodus 4

1 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> and said<sup>H559</sup>, But, behold, they will not believe<sup>H539</sup> me, nor hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto my voice<sup>H6963</sup>: for they will say<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath not appeared<sup>H7200</sup> unto thee. 2 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, What is that in thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, A rod<sup>H4294</sup>. **3** And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Cast<sup>H7993</sup> it on the ground<sup>H776</sup>. And he cast<sup>H7993</sup> it on the ground<sup>H776</sup>, and it became a serpent<sup>H5175</sup>; and Moses<sup>H4872</sup> fled<sup>H5127</sup> from before<sup>H6440</sup> it. **4** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Put forth<sup>H7971</sup> thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and take<sup>H270</sup> it by the tail<sup>H2180</sup>. And he put forth<sup>H7971</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and caught<sup>H2388</sup> it, and it became a rod<sup>H4294</sup> in his hand<sup>H3709</sup>: 5 That they may believe<sup>H539</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of their fathers<sup>H1</sup>, the God<sup>H430</sup> of Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, the God<sup>H430</sup> of Isaac<sup>H3327</sup>, and the God<sup>H430</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, hath appeared<sup>H7200</sup> unto thee. 6 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> furthermore<sup>H5750</sup> unto him, Put<sup>H935</sup> now thine hand<sup>H3027</sup> into thy bosom<sup>H2436</sup>. And he put<sup>H935</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> into his bosom<sup>H2436</sup>: and when he took<sup>H3318</sup> it out, behold, his hand  $^{H3027}$  was leprous  $^{H6879}$  as snow  $^{H7950}$ . 7 And he said  $^{H559}$ , Put  $^{H7725}$  thine hand  $^{H3027}$  into thy bosom  $^{H2436}$  again  $^{H7725}$ . And he put<sup>H7725</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup> into his bosom<sup>H2436</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup>; and plucked<sup>H3318</sup> it out of his bosom<sup>H2436</sup>, and, behold, it was turned again<sup>H7725</sup> as his other flesh<sup>H1320</sup>. 8 And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe<sup>H539</sup> thee, neither hearken<sup>H8085</sup> to the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the first<sup>H7223</sup> sign<sup>H226</sup>, that they will believe<sup>H539</sup> the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the latter<sup>H314</sup> sign<sup>H226</sup>. 9 And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe<sup>H539</sup> also these two<sup>H8147</sup> signs<sup>H226</sup>, neither hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto thy voice<sup>H6963</sup>, that thou shalt take<sup>H3947</sup> of the water<sup>H4325</sup> of the river<sup>H2975</sup>, and pour<sup>H8210</sup> it upon the dry<sup>H3004</sup> land: and the water<sup>H4325</sup> which thou takest<sup>H3947</sup> out of the river<sup>H2975</sup> shall become blood<sup>H1818</sup> upon the dry<sup>H3006</sup> land.<sup>1</sup>

**10** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, O<sup>H994</sup> my Lord<sup>H136</sup>, I<sup>H376</sup> am not eloquent<sup>H1697</sup>, neither heretofore<sup>H8032</sup> <sup>H8543</sup>, nor since<sup>H227</sup> thou hast spoken<sup>H1696</sup> unto thy servant<sup>H5650</sup>: but I am slow<sup>H3515</sup> of speech<sup>H6310</sup>, and of a slow<sup>H3515</sup> tongue<sup>H3956</sup>.<sup>23</sup> **11** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Who hath made<sup>H7760</sup> man's<sup>H120</sup> mouth<sup>H6310</sup>? or who maketh<sup>H7760</sup> the dumb<sup>H483</sup>, or deaf<sup>H2795</sup>, or the seeing<sup>H6493</sup>, or the blind<sup>H5787</sup>? have not I the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>? **12** Now therefore go<sup>H3212</sup>, and I will be with thy mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, and teach<sup>H3384</sup> thee what thou shalt say<sup>H1696</sup>. **13** And he said<sup>H559</sup>, O<sup>H994</sup> my Lord<sup>H136</sup>, send<sup>H7971</sup>, I pray thee, by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of him whom thou wilt send<sup>H7971</sup>.<sup>4</sup> **14** And the anger<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> was kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, and he said<sup>H559</sup>, Is not Aaron<sup>H175</sup> the Levite<sup>H3881</sup> thy brother<sup>H251</sup>? I know<sup>H3045</sup> that he can speak<sup>H1696</sup> well<sup>H1696</sup>. And also, behold, he cometh forth<sup>H3318</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> thee: and when he seeth<sup>H7200</sup> thee, he will be glad<sup>H8055</sup> in his heart<sup>H3820</sup>. **15** And thou shalt speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto him, and put<sup>H7760</sup> words<sup>H1697</sup> in his mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, and thus halt be to him instead of God<sup>H430</sup>. **17** And thou shalt take<sup>H3947</sup> this rod<sup>H4294</sup> in thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, wherewith thou shalt do<sup>H6213</sup> signs<sup>H226</sup>.

**18** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> and returned<sup>H7725</sup> to Jethro<sup>H3500</sup> his father in law<sup>H2859</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Let me go<sup>H3212</sup>, I pray thee, and return<sup>H7725</sup> unto my brethren<sup>H251</sup> which are in Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, and see<sup>H7200</sup> whether they be yet<sup>H5750</sup> alive<sup>H2416</sup>. And Jethro<sup>H3503</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> in peace<sup>H7965.5</sup> **19** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup> in Midian<sup>H4080</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup>, return<sup>H7725</sup> into Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>: for all the men<sup>H582</sup> are dead<sup>H4191</sup> which sought<sup>H1245</sup> thy life<sup>H5315</sup>. **20** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> his wife<sup>H802</sup> and his sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and set<sup>H7392</sup> them upon an ass<sup>H2543</sup>, and he returned<sup>H7725</sup> to the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>: and Moses<sup>H4872</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> the rod<sup>H4294</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>. **21** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, When thou goest<sup>H3212</sup> to return<sup>H7725</sup> into Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, see<sup>H7200</sup> that thou do<sup>H6213</sup> all those wonders<sup>H4159</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup>, which I have put<sup>H7760</sup> in thine hand<sup>H3027</sup>: but I will harden<sup>H2388</sup> his heart<sup>H3820</sup>, that he shall not let the people<sup>H5971</sup> go<sup>H7971</sup>. **22** And thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> unto Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Israel<sup>H3478</sup> is my son<sup>H1121</sup>, even my firstborn<sup>H1060</sup>: **23** And I say<sup>H559</sup> unto thee, Let my son<sup>H1121</sup> go<sup>H7971</sup>, that he may serve<sup>H5647</sup> me: and if thou refuse<sup>H3985</sup> to let him go<sup>H7971</sup>, behold, I will slay<sup>H2026</sup> thy son<sup>H1121</sup>, even thy

**24** And it came to pass by the way<sup>H1870</sup> in the inn<sup>H4411</sup>, that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> met<sup>H6298</sup> him, and sought<sup>H1245</sup> to kill<sup>H4191</sup> him. **25** Then Zipporah<sup>H6855</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> a sharp stone<sup>H6864</sup>, and cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the foreskin<sup>H6190</sup> of her son<sup>H1121</sup>, and cast<sup>H5060</sup> it at his feet<sup>H7272</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Surely a bloody<sup>H1818</sup> husband<sup>H2860</sup> art thou to me.<sup>67</sup> **26** So he let him go<sup>H7503</sup>: then she said<sup>H559</sup>, A bloody<sup>H1818</sup> husband<sup>H2860</sup> thou art, because of the circumcision<sup>H4139</sup>. **27** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> to Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> into the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> Moses<sup>H4872</sup>. And he went<sup>H3212</sup>, and met<sup>H6298</sup> him in the mount<sup>H2022</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, and kissed<sup>H5401</sup> him. **28** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> told<sup>H5046</sup> Aaron<sup>H175</sup> all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> who had sent<sup>H7971</sup> him, and all the signs<sup>H226</sup> which he had commanded<sup>H6680</sup> him. **29** And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> and Aaron<sup>H175</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> and gathered together<sup>H622</sup> all the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>: **30** And Aaron<sup>H175</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> all the words<sup>H1697</sup> which the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had spoken<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, and did<sup>H6213</sup> the signs<sup>H226</sup> in the sight<sup>H5699</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>. **31** And the people<sup>H5971</sup> believed<sup>H539</sup>: and when they heard<sup>H8085</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had visited<sup>H6485</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.
