

# Ezekiel 13

1 And the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came unto me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 Son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> against the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> that prophesy<sup>H5012</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> thou unto them that prophesy<sup>H5030</sup> out of their own hearts<sup>H3820</sup>, Hear<sup>H8085</sup> ye the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; 3 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Woe<sup>H1945</sup> unto the foolish<sup>H5036</sup> prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, that follow<sup>H1980</sup> their own spirit<sup>H7307</sup>, and have seen<sup>H7200</sup> nothing!<sup>23</sup> 4 O Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, thy prophets<sup>H5030</sup> are like the foxes<sup>H7776</sup> in the deserts<sup>H2723</sup>. 5 Ye have not gone up<sup>H5927</sup> into the gaps<sup>H6556</sup>, neither made up<sup>H1443</sup> the hedge<sup>H1447</sup> for the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> to stand<sup>H5975</sup> in the battle<sup>H4421</sup> in the day<sup>H3117</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 45 6 They have seen<sup>H2372</sup> vanity<sup>H7723</sup> and lying<sup>H3577</sup> divination<sup>H7081</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saith<sup>H5002</sup>: and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath not sent<sup>H7971</sup> them: and they have made others to hope<sup>H3176</sup> that they would confirm<sup>H6965</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup>. 7 Have ye not seen<sup>H2372</sup> a vain<sup>H7723</sup> vision<sup>H4236</sup>, and have ye not spoken<sup>H1696</sup> a lying<sup>H3577</sup> divination<sup>H4738</sup>, whereas ye say<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saith<sup>H5002</sup> it; albeit I have not spoken<sup>H559</sup>? 8 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Because ye have spoken<sup>H1696</sup> vanity<sup>H7723</sup>, and seen<sup>H2372</sup> lies<sup>H3577</sup>, therefore, behold, I am against you, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>. 9 And mine hand<sup>H3027</sup> shall be upon the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> that see<sup>H2374</sup> vanity<sup>H7723</sup>, and that divine<sup>H7080</sup> lies<sup>H3577</sup>: they shall not be in the assembly<sup>H5475</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup>, neither shall they be written<sup>H3789</sup> in the writing<sup>H3791</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, neither shall they enter<sup>H935</sup> into the land<sup>H127</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; and ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>.

10 Because, even because they have seduced<sup>H2937</sup> my people<sup>H5971</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and there was no peace<sup>H7965</sup>; and one built up<sup>H1129</sup> a wall<sup>H2434</sup>, and, lo<sup>H2009</sup>, others daubed<sup>H2902</sup> it with untempered<sup>H8602</sup> mortar:<sup>7</sup> 11 Say<sup>H559</sup> unto them which daub<sup>H2902</sup> it with untempered<sup>H8602</sup> mortar, that it shall fall<sup>H5307</sup>: there shall be an overflowing<sup>H7857</sup> shower<sup>H1653</sup>; and ye<sup>H859</sup>, O great hailstones<sup>H417</sup>, shall fall<sup>H5307</sup>; and a stormy<sup>H5591</sup> wind<sup>H7307</sup> shall rend<sup>H1234</sup> it. 12 Lo, when the wall<sup>H7023</sup> is fallen<sup>H5307</sup>, shall it not be said<sup>H559</sup> unto you, Where is the daubing<sup>H2915</sup> wherewith ye have daubed<sup>H2902</sup> it? 13 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; I will even rend<sup>H1234</sup> it with a stormy<sup>H5591</sup> wind<sup>H7307</sup> in my fury<sup>H2534</sup>, and there shall be an overflowing<sup>H7857</sup> shower<sup>H1653</sup> in mine anger<sup>H639</sup>, and great hailstones<sup>H417</sup> in my fury<sup>H2534</sup> to consume<sup>H3617</sup> it. 14 So will I break down<sup>H2040</sup> the wall<sup>H7023</sup> that ye have daubed<sup>H2902</sup> with untempered<sup>H8602</sup> mortar, and bring<sup>H5060</sup> it down to the ground<sup>H776</sup>, so that the foundation<sup>H3247</sup> thereof shall be discovered<sup>H1540</sup>, and it shall fall<sup>H5307</sup>, and ye shall be consumed<sup>H3615</sup> in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> thereof: and ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 15 Thus will I accomplish<sup>H3615</sup> my wrath<sup>H2534</sup> upon the wall<sup>H7023</sup>, and upon them that have daubed<sup>H2902</sup> it with untempered<sup>H8602</sup> mortar, and will say<sup>H559</sup> unto you, The wall<sup>H7023</sup> is no more, neither they that daubed<sup>H2902</sup> it; 16 To wit, the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> which prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> concerning Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and which see<sup>H2374</sup> visions<sup>H2377</sup> of peace<sup>H7965</sup> for her, and there is no peace<sup>H7965</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>.

17 Likewise, thou son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, set<sup>H7760</sup> thy face<sup>H6440</sup> against the daughters<sup>H1323</sup> of thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, which prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> out of their own heart<sup>H3820</sup>; and prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> thou against them, 18 And say<sup>H559</sup>, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Woe<sup>H1945</sup> to the women that sew<sup>H8609</sup> pillows<sup>H3704</sup> to all armholes<sup>H679</sup>, and make<sup>H6213</sup> kerchiefs<sup>H4555</sup> upon the head<sup>H7218</sup> of every stature<sup>H6967</sup> to hunt<sup>H6679</sup> souls<sup>H5315</sup>! Will ye hunt<sup>H6679</sup> the souls<sup>H5315</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup>, and will ye save<sup>H2421</sup> the souls<sup>H5315</sup> alive<sup>H2421</sup> that come unto you?<sup>8</sup> 19 And will ye pollute<sup>H2490</sup> me among my people<sup>H5971</sup> for handfuls<sup>H8168</sup> of barley<sup>H8184</sup> and for pieces<sup>H6595</sup> of bread<sup>H3899</sup>, to slay<sup>H4191</sup> the souls<sup>H5315</sup> that should not die<sup>H4191</sup>, and to save<sup>H2421</sup> the souls<sup>H5315</sup> alive<sup>H2421</sup> that should not live<sup>H2421</sup>, by your lying<sup>H3576</sup> to my people<sup>H5971</sup> that hear<sup>H8085</sup> your lies<sup>H3577</sup>? 20 Wherefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>; Behold, I am against your pillows<sup>H3704</sup>, wherewith ye<sup>H859</sup> there hunt<sup>H6679</sup> the souls<sup>H5315</sup> to make them fly<sup>H6524</sup>, and I will tear<sup>H7167</sup> them from your arms<sup>H2220</sup>, and will let the souls<sup>H5315</sup> go<sup>H7971</sup>, even the souls<sup>H5315</sup> that ye hunt<sup>H6679</sup> to make them fly<sup>H6524</sup>. 9 21 Your kerchiefs<sup>H4555</sup> also will I tear<sup>H7167</sup>, and deliver<sup>H5337</sup> my people<sup>H5971</sup> out of your hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and they shall be no more in your hand<sup>H3027</sup> to be

hunted<sup>H4686</sup>; and ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **22** Because with lies<sup>H8267</sup> ye have made the heart<sup>H3820</sup> of the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> sad<sup>H3512</sup>, whom I have not made sad<sup>H3510</sup>; and strengthened<sup>H2388</sup> the hands<sup>H3027</sup> of the wicked<sup>H7451</sup>, that he should not return<sup>H7725</sup> from his wicked<sup>H7563</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>, by promising him life<sup>H2421,10</sup>: **23** Therefore ye shall see<sup>H2372</sup> no more vanity<sup>H7723</sup>, nor divine<sup>H7080</sup> divinations<sup>H7081</sup>: for I will deliver<sup>H5337</sup> my people<sup>H5971</sup> out of your hand<sup>H3027</sup>: and ye shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
