1 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, stand<sup>H5975</sup> upon thy feet<sup>H7272</sup>, and I will speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto thee. 2 And the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> entered<sup>H935</sup> into me when he spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto me, and set<sup>H5975</sup> me upon my feet<sup>H7272</sup>, that I heard<sup>H8085</sup> him that spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto me. 3 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, I send<sup>H7971</sup> thee to the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, to a rebellious<sup>H4775</sup> nation<sup>H1471</sup> that hath rebelled<sup>H4775</sup> against me: they and their fathers<sup>H1</sup> have transgressed<sup>H6586</sup> against me, even unto this very<sup>H6106</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>. 4 For they are impudent<sup>H7186</sup> H6440 children<sup>H1121</sup> and stiffhearted<sup>H2389</sup> H3820. I do send<sup>H7971</sup> thee unto them; and thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>. 5 And they, whether they will hear<sup>H8085</sup>, or whether they will forbear<sup>H2308</sup>, (for they are a rebellious<sup>H4805</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>,) yet shall know<sup>H3045</sup> that there hath been a prophet<sup>H5030</sup> among<sup>H8432</sup> them.

6 And thou, son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, be not afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of them, neither be afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of their words<sup>H1697</sup>, though briers<sup>H5621</sup> and thorns<sup>H5544</sup> be with thee, and thou dost dwell<sup>H3427</sup> among scorpions<sup>H6137</sup>: be not afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of their words<sup>H1697</sup>, nor be dismayed<sup>H2865</sup> at their looks<sup>H6440</sup>, though they be a rebellious<sup>H4805</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>.<sup>3</sup> 7 And thou shalt speak<sup>H1696</sup> my words<sup>H1697</sup> unto them, whether they will hear<sup>H8085</sup>, or whether they will forbear<sup>H2308</sup>: for they are most rebellious<sup>H4805</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 8 But thou, son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>, hear<sup>H8085</sup> what I say<sup>H1696</sup> unto thee; Be not<sup>H1961</sup> thou rebellious<sup>H4805</sup> like that rebellious<sup>H4805</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>: open<sup>H6475</sup> thy mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, and eat<sup>H398</sup> that I give<sup>H5414</sup> thee. 9 And when I looked<sup>H7200</sup>, behold, an hand<sup>H3027</sup> was sent<sup>H7971</sup> unto me; and, lo, a roll<sup>H4039</sup> of a book<sup>H5612</sup> was therein; 10 And he spread<sup>H6566</sup> it before<sup>H6440</sup> me; and it was written<sup>H3789</sup> within<sup>H6440</sup> and without<sup>H268</sup>: and there was written<sup>H3789</sup> therein lamentations<sup>H7015</sup>, and mourning<sup>H1899</sup>, and woe<sup>H1958</sup>.
