

# Genesis 20

1 And Abraham<sup>H85</sup> journeyed<sup>H5265</sup> from thence toward the south<sup>H5045</sup> country<sup>H776</sup>, and dwelled<sup>H3427</sup> between Kadesh<sup>H6946</sup> and Shur<sup>H7793</sup>, and sojourned<sup>H1481</sup> in Gerar<sup>H1642</sup>. 2 And Abraham<sup>H85</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> of<sup>H413</sup> Sarah<sup>H8283</sup> his wife<sup>H802</sup>, She is my sister<sup>H269</sup>: and Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Gerar<sup>H1642</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup>, and took<sup>H3947</sup> Sarah<sup>H8283</sup>.

3 But God<sup>H430</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> to Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> in a dream<sup>H2472</sup> by night<sup>H3915</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> to him, Behold, thou art but a dead man<sup>H4191</sup>, for the woman<sup>H802</sup> which thou hast taken<sup>H3947</sup>; for she is a man's<sup>H1167</sup> wife<sup>H1166</sup>. 4 But Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> had not come near<sup>H7126</sup> her: and he said<sup>H559</sup>, Lord<sup>H136</sup>, wilt thou slay<sup>H2026</sup> also a righteous<sup>H6662</sup> nation<sup>H1471</sup>? 5 Said<sup>H559</sup> he not unto me, She<sup>H1931</sup> is my sister<sup>H269</sup>? and she<sup>H1931</sup>, even<sup>H1571</sup> she<sup>H1931</sup> herself said<sup>H559</sup>, He is my brother<sup>H251</sup>: in the integrity<sup>H8537</sup> of my heart<sup>H3824</sup> and innocency<sup>H5356</sup> of my hands<sup>H3709</sup> have I done<sup>H6213</sup> this.<sup>2</sup> 6 And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him in a dream<sup>H2472</sup>, Yea<sup>H1571</sup>, I know<sup>H3045</sup> that thou didst<sup>H6213</sup> this in the integrity<sup>H8537</sup> of thy heart<sup>H3824</sup>; for I also withheld<sup>H2820</sup> thee from sinning<sup>H2398</sup> against me: therefore suffered<sup>H5414</sup> I thee not to touch<sup>H5060</sup> her. 7 Now therefore restore<sup>H7725</sup> the man<sup>H376</sup> his wife<sup>H802</sup>; for he is a prophet<sup>H5030</sup>, and he shall pray<sup>H6419</sup> for thee<sup>H1157</sup>, and thou shalt live<sup>H2421</sup>: and if thou restore<sup>H7725</sup> her not, know<sup>H3045</sup> thou that thou shalt surely<sup>H4191</sup> die<sup>H4191</sup>, thou, and all that are thine.

8 Therefore Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> rose early<sup>H7925</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, and called<sup>H7121</sup> all his servants<sup>H5650</sup>, and told<sup>H1696</sup> all these things<sup>H1697</sup> in their ears<sup>H241</sup>: and the men<sup>H582</sup> were sore<sup>H3966</sup> afraid<sup>H3372</sup>. 9 Then Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, What hast thou done<sup>H6213</sup> unto us? and what have I offended<sup>H2398</sup> thee, that thou hast brought<sup>H935</sup> on me and on my kingdom<sup>H4467</sup> a great<sup>H1419</sup> sin<sup>H2401</sup>? thou hast done<sup>H6213</sup> deeds<sup>H4639</sup> unto me that ought not to be done<sup>H6213</sup>. 10 And Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, What<sup>H4100</sup> sawest thou<sup>H7200</sup>, that thou hast done<sup>H6213</sup> this thing<sup>H1697</sup>? 11 And Abraham<sup>H85</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Because I thought<sup>H559</sup>, Surely<sup>H7535</sup> the fear<sup>H3374</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> is not in this place<sup>H4725</sup>; and they will slay me<sup>H2026</sup> for my wife's<sup>H802</sup> sake<sup>H1697</sup>. 12 And yet indeed<sup>H546</sup> she is my sister<sup>H269</sup>, she is the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my father<sup>H1</sup>, but not the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my mother<sup>H517</sup>; and she became my wife<sup>H802</sup>. 13 And it came to pass, when God<sup>H430</sup> caused me to wander<sup>H8582</sup> from my father's<sup>H1</sup> house<sup>H1004</sup>, that I said<sup>H559</sup> unto her, This is thy kindness<sup>H2617</sup> which thou shalt shew<sup>H6213</sup> unto me; at every place<sup>H4725</sup> whither we shall come<sup>H935</sup>, say<sup>H559</sup> of me, He is my brother<sup>H251</sup>.

14 And Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, and oxen<sup>H1241</sup>, and menservants<sup>H5650</sup>, and womenservants<sup>H8198</sup>, and gave<sup>H5414</sup> them unto Abraham<sup>H85</sup>, and restored<sup>H7725</sup> him Sarah<sup>H8283</sup> his wife<sup>H802</sup>. 15 And Abimelech<sup>H40</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, my land<sup>H776</sup> is before thee<sup>H6440</sup>: dwell<sup>H3427</sup> where it pleaseth<sup>H2896</sup> thee. 16 And unto Sarah<sup>H8283</sup> he said<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, I have given<sup>H5414</sup> thy brother<sup>H251</sup> a thousand<sup>H505</sup> pieces of silver<sup>H3701</sup>: behold, he is to thee a covering<sup>H3682</sup> of the eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, unto all that are with thee, and with all other: thus she was reproved<sup>H3198</sup>. 17 So Abraham<sup>H85</sup> prayed<sup>H6419</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup>: and God<sup>H430</sup> healed<sup>H7495</sup> Abimelech<sup>H40</sup>, and his wife<sup>H802</sup>, and his maidservants<sup>H519</sup>, and they bare<sup>H3205</sup> children. 18 For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had fast<sup>H6113</sup> closed up<sup>H6113</sup> all the wombs<sup>H7358</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Abimelech<sup>H40</sup>, because<sup>H1697</sup> of Sarah<sup>H8283</sup> Abraham's<sup>H85</sup> wife<sup>H802</sup>.
