

# Genesis 6

1 And it came to pass, when men<sup>H120</sup> began<sup>H2490</sup> to multiply<sup>H7231</sup> on<sup>H5921</sup> the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>, and daughters<sup>H1323</sup> were born<sup>H3205</sup> unto them, 2 That the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> the daughters<sup>H1323</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup> that they<sup>H2007</sup> were fair<sup>H2896</sup>; and they took<sup>H3947</sup> them wives<sup>H802</sup> of all which they chose<sup>H977</sup>.

3 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, My spirit<sup>H7307</sup> shall not always<sup>H5769</sup> strive<sup>H1777</sup> with man<sup>H120</sup>, for that he also<sup>H1571</sup> is flesh<sup>H1320 H7683</sup>: yet his days<sup>H3117</sup> shall be an hundred<sup>H3967</sup> and twenty<sup>H6242</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>.

4 There were giants<sup>H5303</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup> in those days<sup>H3117</sup>; and also after<sup>H310</sup> that<sup>H3651</sup>, when<sup>H834</sup> the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> came in<sup>H935</sup> unto the daughters<sup>H1323</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>, and they bare<sup>H3205</sup> children to them, the same<sup>H1992</sup> became mighty men<sup>H1368</sup> which were of old<sup>H5769</sup>, men<sup>H582</sup> of renown<sup>H8034</sup>. 5 And GOD<sup>H3068</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> that the wickedness<sup>H7451</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup> was great<sup>H7227</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and that every imagination<sup>H3336</sup> of the thoughts<sup>H4284</sup> of his heart<sup>H3820</sup> was only<sup>H7535</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> continually<sup>H3117 12</sup>.

6 And it repented<sup>H5162</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> that he had made<sup>H6213</sup> man<sup>H120</sup> on the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and it grieved<sup>H6087</sup> him at<sup>H413</sup> his heart<sup>H3820</sup>. 7 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup>, I will destroy<sup>H4229</sup> man<sup>H120</sup> whom I have created<sup>H1254</sup> from the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>; both man<sup>H120</sup>, and<sup>H5704</sup> beast<sup>H929</sup>, and the creeping thing<sup>H7431</sup>, and the fowls<sup>H5775</sup> of the air<sup>H8064</sup>; for it repenteth<sup>H5162</sup> me that I have made<sup>H6213</sup> them.<sup>3</sup>

8 But Noah<sup>H5146</sup> found<sup>H4672</sup> grace<sup>H2580</sup> in the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 9 These are the generations<sup>H8435</sup> of Noah<sup>H5146</sup>: Noah<sup>H5146</sup> was a just<sup>H6662</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> and perfect<sup>H8549</sup> in his generations<sup>H1755</sup>, and Noah<sup>H5146</sup> walked<sup>H1980</sup> with God<sup>H430</sup>. 10 And Noah<sup>H5146</sup> begat<sup>H3205</sup> three<sup>H7969</sup> sons<sup>H1121</sup>, Shem<sup>H8035</sup>, Ham<sup>H2526</sup>, and Japheth<sup>H3315</sup>.

11 The earth<sup>H776</sup> also was corrupt<sup>H7843</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> God<sup>H430</sup>, and the earth<sup>H776</sup> was filled<sup>H4390</sup> with violence<sup>H2555</sup>. 12 And God<sup>H430</sup> looked<sup>H7200</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and, behold, it was corrupt<sup>H7843</sup>; for all flesh<sup>H1320</sup> had corrupted<sup>H7843</sup> his way<sup>H1870</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>.

13 And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Noah<sup>H5146</sup>, The end<sup>H7093</sup> of all flesh<sup>H1320</sup> is come<sup>H935</sup> before me<sup>H6440</sup>, for the earth<sup>H776</sup> is filled with<sup>H4390</sup> violence<sup>H2555</sup> through them<sup>H6440</sup>; and, behold, I will destroy<sup>H7843</sup> them with<sup>H854</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 14 Make<sup>H6213</sup> thee an ark<sup>H8392</sup> of gopher<sup>H1613</sup> wood<sup>H6086</sup>; rooms<sup>H7064</sup> shalt thou make<sup>H6213</sup> in<sup>H854</sup> the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, and shalt pitch<sup>H3722</sup> it within<sup>H1004</sup> and without<sup>H2351</sup> with pitch<sup>H3724</sup>. 15 And this is the fashion which thou shalt make<sup>H6213</sup> it of: The length<sup>H753</sup> of the ark<sup>H8392</sup> shall be three<sup>H7969</sup> hundred<sup>H3967</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> of it fifty<sup>H2572</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, and the height<sup>H6967</sup> of it thirty<sup>H7970</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 16 A window<sup>H6672</sup> shalt thou make<sup>H6213</sup> to the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, and in a cubit<sup>H520</sup> shalt thou finish<sup>H3615</sup> it above<sup>H4605</sup>; and the door<sup>H6607</sup> of the ark<sup>H8392</sup> shalt thou set<sup>H7760</sup> in the side thereof<sup>H6654</sup>; with lower<sup>H8482</sup>, second<sup>H8145</sup>, and third<sup>H7992</sup> stories shalt thou make<sup>H6213</sup> it. 17 And, behold<sup>H2009</sup>, I<sup>H589</sup>, even I, do bring<sup>H935</sup> a flood<sup>H3999</sup> of waters<sup>H4325</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>, to destroy<sup>H7843</sup> all flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, wherein is the breath<sup>H7307</sup> of life<sup>H2416</sup>, from under<sup>H8478</sup> heaven<sup>H8064</sup>; and every thing<sup>H3605</sup> that is in the earth<sup>H776</sup> shall die<sup>H1478</sup>. 18 But with thee will I establish<sup>H6965</sup> my covenant<sup>H1285</sup>; and thou shalt come<sup>H935</sup> into<sup>H413</sup> the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, thou<sup>H859</sup>, and thy sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and thy wife<sup>H802</sup>, and thy sons<sup>H1121</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup> with thee. 19 And of every living thing<sup>H2416</sup> of all flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, two<sup>H8147</sup> of every sort shalt thou bring<sup>H935</sup> into the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, to keep them alive<sup>H2421</sup> with thee; they shall be male<sup>H2145</sup> and female<sup>H5347</sup>. 20 Of fowls<sup>H5775</sup> after their kind<sup>H4327</sup>, and of cattle<sup>H929</sup> after their kind<sup>H4327</sup>, of every creeping thing<sup>H7431</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup> after his kind<sup>H4327</sup>, two<sup>H8147</sup> of every sort shall come<sup>H935</sup> unto thee, to keep them alive<sup>H2421</sup>. 21 And take<sup>H3947</sup> thou unto thee of all food<sup>H3978</sup> that is eaten<sup>H398</sup>, and thou shalt gather<sup>H622</sup> it to thee; and it shall be for food<sup>H402</sup> for thee, and for them.

22 Thus did<sup>H6213</sup> Noah<sup>H5146</sup>; according to all that God<sup>H430</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> him, so did<sup>H6213</sup> he.
