

# Genesis 8

1 And God<sup>H430</sup> remembered<sup>H2142</sup> Noah<sup>H5146</sup>, and every living thing<sup>H2416</sup>, and all the cattle<sup>H929</sup> that was with him in the ark<sup>H8392</sup>: and God<sup>H430</sup> made<sup>H5674</sup> a wind<sup>H7307</sup> to pass<sup>H5674</sup> over<sup>H5921</sup> the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and the waters<sup>H4325</sup> asswaged<sup>H7918</sup>; 2 The fountains<sup>H4599</sup> also of the deep<sup>H8415</sup> and the windows<sup>H699</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup> were stopped<sup>H5534</sup>, and the rain<sup>H1653</sup> from heaven<sup>H8064</sup> was restrained<sup>H3607</sup>; 3 And the waters<sup>H4325</sup> returned<sup>H7725</sup> from off the earth<sup>H776</sup> continually<sup>H1980</sup> H7725: and after the end<sup>H7097</sup> of the hundred<sup>H3967</sup> and fifty<sup>H2572</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> the waters<sup>H4325</sup> were abated<sup>H2637</sup> 1.

4 And the ark<sup>H8392</sup> rested<sup>H5117</sup> in the seventh<sup>H7637</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>, on the seventeenth<sup>H6240</sup> H7651 day<sup>H3117</sup> of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, upon the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> of Ararat<sup>H780</sup>. 5 And the waters<sup>H4325</sup> decreased<sup>H2637</sup> continually<sup>H1980</sup> until<sup>H5704</sup> the tenth<sup>H6224</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>: in the tenth<sup>H6224</sup> month, on the first<sup>H259</sup> day of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, were the tops<sup>H7218</sup> of the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> seen<sup>H7200</sup> 2.

6 And it came to pass at the end<sup>H7093</sup> of forty<sup>H705</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>, that Noah<sup>H5146</sup> opened<sup>H6605</sup> the window<sup>H2474</sup> of the ark<sup>H8392</sup> which he had made<sup>H6213</sup>: 7 And he sent forth<sup>H7971</sup> a raven<sup>H6158</sup>, which went forth<sup>H3318</sup> to<sup>H3318</sup> and fro<sup>H7725</sup>, until the waters<sup>H4325</sup> were dried up<sup>H3001</sup> from off the earth<sup>H776</sup> 3. 8 Also he sent forth<sup>H7971</sup> a dove<sup>H3123</sup> from him, to see<sup>H7200</sup> if the waters<sup>H4325</sup> were abated<sup>H7043</sup> from off the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the ground<sup>H127</sup>; 9 But the dove<sup>H3123</sup> found<sup>H4672</sup> no rest<sup>H4494</sup> for the sole<sup>H3709</sup> of her foot<sup>H7272</sup>, and she returned<sup>H7725</sup> unto him into the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, for the waters<sup>H4325</sup> were on the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the whole earth<sup>H776</sup>: then he put forth<sup>H7971</sup> his hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and took her<sup>H3947</sup>, and pulled her in<sup>H935</sup> unto him into the ark<sup>H8392</sup> 4. 10 And he stayed<sup>H2342</sup> yet other<sup>H312</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>; and again<sup>H3254</sup> he sent forth<sup>H7971</sup> the dove<sup>H3123</sup> out of the ark<sup>H8392</sup>; 11 And the dove<sup>H3123</sup> came in<sup>H935</sup> to him in the evening<sup>H6256</sup> H6153, and, lo, in her mouth<sup>H6310</sup> was an olive<sup>H2132</sup> leaf<sup>H5929</sup> pluckt off<sup>H2965</sup>: so Noah<sup>H5146</sup> knew<sup>H3045</sup> that the waters<sup>H4325</sup> were abated<sup>H7043</sup> from off the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 12 And he stayed<sup>H3176</sup> yet other<sup>H312</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>; and sent forth<sup>H7971</sup> the dove<sup>H3123</sup>, which returned<sup>H7725</sup> not again<sup>H3254</sup> unto him any more<sup>H5750</sup>.

13 And it came to pass in the six<sup>H8337</sup> hundredth<sup>H3967</sup> and first year<sup>H8141</sup>, in the first<sup>H7223</sup> month, the first<sup>H259</sup> day of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, the waters<sup>H4325</sup> were dried up<sup>H2717</sup> from off the earth<sup>H776</sup>: and Noah<sup>H5146</sup> removed<sup>H5493</sup> the covering<sup>H4372</sup> of the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, and looked<sup>H7200</sup>, and, behold, the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the ground<sup>H127</sup> was dry<sup>H2717</sup>. 14 And in the second<sup>H8145</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup>, on the seven<sup>H7651</sup> and twentieth<sup>H6242</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> of the month<sup>H2320</sup>, was the earth<sup>H776</sup> dried<sup>H3001</sup>.

15 And God<sup>H430</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Noah<sup>H5146</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 16 Go forth<sup>H3318</sup> of the ark<sup>H8392</sup>, thou, and thy wife<sup>H802</sup>, and thy sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and thy sons<sup>H1121</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup> with thee. 17 Bring forth<sup>H3318</sup> with thee every living thing<sup>H2416</sup> that is with thee, of all flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, both of fowl<sup>H5775</sup>, and of cattle<sup>H929</sup>, and of every creeping thing<sup>H7431</sup> that creepeth<sup>H7430</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>, that they may breed abundantly<sup>H8317</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and be fruitful<sup>H6509</sup>, and multiply<sup>H7235</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 18 And Noah<sup>H5146</sup> went forth<sup>H3318</sup>, and his sons<sup>H1121</sup>, and his wife<sup>H802</sup>, and his sons<sup>H1121</sup> wives<sup>H802</sup> with him: 19 Every beast<sup>H2416</sup>, every creeping thing<sup>H7431</sup>, and every fowl<sup>H5775</sup>, and whatsoever<sup>H3605</sup> creepeth<sup>H7430</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup>, after their kinds<sup>H4940</sup>, went forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the ark<sup>H8392</sup> 5.

20 And Noah<sup>H5146</sup> builded<sup>H1129</sup> an altar<sup>H4196</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; and took<sup>H3947</sup> of every clean<sup>H2889</sup> beast<sup>H929</sup>, and of every clean<sup>H2889</sup> fowl<sup>H5775</sup>, and offered<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offerings<sup>H5930</sup> on the altar<sup>H4196</sup>. 21 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> smelled<sup>H7306</sup> a sweet<sup>H5207</sup> savour<sup>H7381</sup>; and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> in<sup>H413</sup> his heart<sup>H3820</sup>, I will not again<sup>H3254</sup> curse<sup>H7043</sup> the ground<sup>H127</sup> any more for man's<sup>H120</sup> sake<sup>H5668</sup>, for the imagination<sup>H3336</sup> of man's<sup>H120</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup> is evil<sup>H7451</sup> from his youth<sup>H5271</sup>; neither will I again<sup>H3254</sup> smite<sup>H5221</sup> any more every thing living<sup>H2416</sup>, as I have done<sup>H6213</sup> 67. 22 While the earth<sup>H776</sup> remaineth<sup>H3117</sup>, seedtime<sup>H2233</sup> and harvest<sup>H7105</sup>, and cold<sup>H7120</sup> and heat<sup>H2527</sup>, and summer<sup>H7019</sup> and winter<sup>H2779</sup>, and

day<sup>H3117</sup> and night<sup>H3915</sup> shall not cease<sup>H7673</sup> 8.
