

# Isaiah 51

**1** Hearken<sup>H8085</sup> to me, ye that follow after<sup>H7291</sup> righteousness<sup>H6664</sup>, ye that seek<sup>H1245</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: look<sup>H5027</sup> unto the rock<sup>H6697</sup> whence ye are hewn<sup>H2672</sup>, and to the hole<sup>H4718</sup> of the pit<sup>H953</sup> whence ye are digged<sup>H5365</sup>. **2** Look<sup>H5027</sup> unto Abraham<sup>H85</sup> your father<sup>H1</sup>, and unto Sarah<sup>H8283</sup> that bare<sup>H2342</sup> you: for I called<sup>H7121</sup> him alone<sup>H259</sup>, and blessed<sup>H1288</sup> him, and increased<sup>H7235</sup> him. **3** For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall comfort<sup>H5162</sup> Zion<sup>H6726</sup>: he will comfort<sup>H5162</sup> all her waste places<sup>H2723</sup>, and he will make<sup>H7760</sup> her wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> like Eden<sup>H5731</sup>, and her desert<sup>H6160</sup> like the garden<sup>H1588</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, joy<sup>H8342</sup> and gladness<sup>H8057</sup> shall be found<sup>H4672</sup> therein, thanksgiving<sup>H8426</sup>, and the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of melody<sup>H2172</sup>.

**4** Hearken<sup>H7181</sup> unto me, my people<sup>H5971</sup>; and give ear<sup>H238</sup> unto me, O my nation<sup>H3816</sup>: for a law<sup>H8451</sup> shall proceed<sup>H3318</sup> from me, and I will make my judgment<sup>H4941</sup> to rest<sup>H7280</sup> for a light<sup>H216</sup> of the people<sup>H5971</sup>. **5** My righteousness<sup>H6664</sup> is near<sup>H7138</sup>, my salvation<sup>H3468</sup> is gone forth<sup>H3318</sup>, and mine arms<sup>H2220</sup> shall judge<sup>H8199</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>; the isles<sup>H339</sup> shall wait<sup>H6960</sup> upon me, and on mine arm<sup>H2220</sup> shall they trust<sup>H3176</sup>. **6** Lift up<sup>H5375</sup> your eyes<sup>H5869</sup> to the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>, and look<sup>H5027</sup> upon the earth<sup>H776</sup> beneath: for the heavens<sup>H8064</sup> shall vanish away<sup>H4414</sup> like smoke<sup>H6227</sup>, and the earth<sup>H776</sup> shall wax old<sup>H1086</sup> like a garment<sup>H899</sup>, and they that dwell<sup>H3427</sup> therein shall die<sup>H4191</sup> in like<sup>H3644</sup> manner<sup>H3654</sup>: but my salvation<sup>H3444</sup> shall be for ever<sup>H5769</sup>, and my righteousness<sup>H6666</sup> shall not be abolished<sup>H2865</sup>. **7** Hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto me, ye that know<sup>H3045</sup> righteousness<sup>H6664</sup>, the people<sup>H5971</sup> in whose heart<sup>H3820</sup> is my law<sup>H8451</sup>; fear<sup>H3372</sup> ye not the reproach<sup>H2781</sup> of men<sup>H582</sup>, neither be ye afraid<sup>H2865</sup> of their revilings<sup>H1421</sup>. **8** For the moth<sup>H6211</sup> shall eat them up<sup>H398</sup> like a garment<sup>H899</sup>, and the worm<sup>H5580</sup> shall eat<sup>H398</sup> them like wool<sup>H6785</sup>: but my righteousness<sup>H6666</sup> shall be for ever<sup>H5769</sup>, and my salvation<sup>H3444</sup> from generation<sup>H1755</sup> to generation<sup>H1755</sup>.

**9** Awake<sup>H5782</sup>, awake<sup>H5782</sup>, put on<sup>H3847</sup> strength<sup>H5797</sup>, O arm<sup>H2220</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; awake<sup>H5782</sup>, as in the ancient<sup>H6924</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>, in the generations<sup>H1755</sup> of old<sup>H5769</sup>. Art thou not it that hath cut<sup>H2672</sup> Rahab<sup>H7294</sup>, and wounded<sup>H2490</sup> the dragon<sup>H8577</sup>? **10** Art thou not it which hath dried<sup>H2717</sup> the sea<sup>H3220</sup>, the waters<sup>H4325</sup> of the great<sup>H7227</sup> deep<sup>H8415</sup>, that hath made<sup>H7760</sup> the depths<sup>H4615</sup> of the sea<sup>H3220</sup> a way<sup>H1870</sup> for the ransomed<sup>H1350</sup> to pass over<sup>H5674</sup>? **11** Therefore the redeemed<sup>H6299</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall return<sup>H7725</sup>, and come<sup>H935</sup> with singing<sup>H7440</sup> unto Zion<sup>H6726</sup>; and everlasting<sup>H5769</sup> joy<sup>H8057</sup> shall be upon their head<sup>H7218</sup>: they shall obtain<sup>H5381</sup> gladness<sup>H8342</sup> and joy<sup>H8057</sup>; and sorrow<sup>H3015</sup> and mourning<sup>H585</sup> shall flee away<sup>H5127</sup>. **12** I, even I, am he that comforteth<sup>H5162</sup> you: who art thou, that thou shouldst be afraid<sup>H3372</sup> of a man<sup>H582</sup> that shall die<sup>H4191</sup>, and of the son<sup>H1121</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup> which shall be made<sup>H5414</sup> as grass<sup>H2682</sup>; **13** And forgettest<sup>H7911</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy maker<sup>H6213</sup>, that hath stretched forth<sup>H5186</sup> the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>, and laid the foundations<sup>H3245</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>; and hast feared<sup>H6342</sup> continually<sup>H8548</sup> every day<sup>H3117</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of the fury<sup>H2534</sup> of the oppressor<sup>H6693</sup>, as if<sup>H834</sup> he were ready<sup>H3559</sup> to destroy<sup>H7843</sup>? and where is the fury<sup>H2534</sup> of the oppressor<sup>H6693</sup>? **14** The captive exile<sup>H6808</sup> hasteneth<sup>H4116</sup> that he may be loosed<sup>H6605</sup>, and that he should not die<sup>H4191</sup> in the pit<sup>H7845</sup>, nor that his bread<sup>H3899</sup> should fail<sup>H2637</sup>. **15** But I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> thy God<sup>H430</sup>, that divided<sup>H7280</sup> the sea<sup>H3220</sup>, whose waves<sup>H1530</sup> roared<sup>H1993</sup>: The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup> is his name<sup>H8034</sup>. **16** And I have put<sup>H7760</sup> my words<sup>H1697</sup> in thy mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, and I have covered<sup>H3680</sup> thee in the shadow<sup>H6738</sup> of mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, that I may plant<sup>H5193</sup> the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>, and lay the foundations<sup>H3245</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto Zion<sup>H6726</sup>, Thou art my people<sup>H5971</sup>.

**17** Awake<sup>H5782</sup>, awake<sup>H5782</sup>, stand up<sup>H6965</sup>, O Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, which hast drunk<sup>H8354</sup> at the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> the cup<sup>H3563</sup> of his fury<sup>H2534</sup>; thou hast drunken<sup>H8354</sup> the dregs<sup>H6907</sup> of the cup<sup>H3563</sup> of trembling<sup>H8653</sup>, and wrung them out<sup>H4680</sup>. **18** There is none to guide<sup>H5095</sup> her among all the sons<sup>H1121</sup> whom she hath brought forth<sup>H3205</sup>; neither is there any that taketh<sup>H2388</sup> her by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of all the sons<sup>H1121</sup> that she hath brought up<sup>H1431</sup>. **19** These two<sup>H8147</sup> things are come<sup>H7122</sup> unto thee; who shall be sorry<sup>H5110</sup> for thee? desolation<sup>H7701</sup>, and destruction<sup>H7667</sup>, and the famine<sup>H7458</sup>, and the sword<sup>H2719</sup>: by whom shall I comfort<sup>H5162</sup> thee? **20** Thy sons<sup>H1121</sup> have fainted<sup>H5968</sup>, they lie<sup>H7901</sup> at the head<sup>H7218</sup> of

all the streets<sup>H2351</sup>, as a wild bull<sup>H8377</sup> in a net<sup>H4364</sup>: they are full<sup>H4392</sup> of the fury<sup>H2534</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the rebuke<sup>H1606</sup> of thy God<sup>H430</sup>. **21** Therefore hear<sup>H8085</sup> now this, thou afflicted<sup>H6041</sup>, and drunken<sup>H7937</sup>, but not with wine<sup>H3196</sup>: **22** Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> thy Lord<sup>H113</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and thy God<sup>H430</sup> that pleadeth<sup>H7378</sup> the cause of his people<sup>H5971</sup>, Behold, I have taken out<sup>H3947</sup> of thine hand<sup>H3027</sup> the cup<sup>H3563</sup> of trembling<sup>H8653</sup>, even the dregs<sup>H6907</sup> of the cup<sup>H3563</sup> of my fury<sup>H2534</sup>; thou shalt no more<sup>H3254</sup> drink it again<sup>H8354</sup>: **23** But I will put<sup>H7760</sup> it into the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of them that afflict<sup>H3013</sup> thee; which have said<sup>H559</sup> to thy soul<sup>H5315</sup>, Bow down<sup>H7812</sup>, that we may go over<sup>H5674</sup>: and thou hast laid<sup>H7760</sup> thy body<sup>H1460</sup> as the ground<sup>H776</sup>, and as the street<sup>H2351</sup>, to them that went over<sup>H5674</sup>.
