

# Jeremiah 11

1 The word<sup>H1697</sup> that came to Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> from the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 Hear<sup>H8085</sup> ye the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this covenant<sup>H1285</sup>, and speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto the men<sup>H376</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and to the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, 3 And say<sup>H559</sup> thou unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; Cursed<sup>H779</sup> be the man<sup>H376</sup> that obeyeth<sup>H8085</sup> not the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this covenant<sup>H1285</sup>, 4 Which I commanded<sup>H6680</sup> your fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the day<sup>H3117</sup> that I brought them forth<sup>H3318</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, from the iron<sup>H1270</sup> furnace<sup>H3564</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Obey<sup>H8085</sup> my voice<sup>H6963</sup>, and do<sup>H6213</sup> them, according to all which I command<sup>H6680</sup> you: so shall ye be my people<sup>H5971</sup>, and I will be your God<sup>H430</sup>. 5 That I may perform<sup>H6965</sup> the oath<sup>H7621</sup> which I have sworn<sup>H7650</sup> unto your fathers<sup>H1</sup>, to give<sup>H5414</sup> them a land<sup>H776</sup> flowing<sup>H2100</sup> with milk<sup>H2461</sup> and honey<sup>H1706</sup>, as it is this day<sup>H3117</sup>. Then answered<sup>H6030</sup> I, and said<sup>H559</sup>, So be it<sup>H543</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 6 Then the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Proclaim<sup>H7121</sup> all these words<sup>H1697</sup> in the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and in the streets<sup>H2351</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Hear<sup>H8085</sup> ye the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this covenant<sup>H1285</sup>, and do<sup>H6213</sup> them. 7 For I earnestly<sup>H5749</sup> protested<sup>H5749</sup> unto your fathers<sup>H1</sup> in the day<sup>H3117</sup> that I brought them up<sup>H5927</sup> out of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, even unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>, rising early<sup>H7925</sup> and protesting<sup>H5749</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Obey<sup>H8085</sup> my voice<sup>H6963</sup>. 8 Yet they obeyed<sup>H8085</sup> not, nor inclined<sup>H5186</sup> their ear<sup>H241</sup>, but walked<sup>H3212</sup> every one<sup>H376</sup> in the imagination<sup>H8307</sup> of their evil<sup>H7451</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup>: therefore I will bring<sup>H935</sup> upon them all the words<sup>H1697</sup> of this covenant<sup>H1285</sup>, which I commanded<sup>H6680</sup> them to do<sup>H6213</sup>, but they did<sup>H6213</sup> them not.<sup>2</sup> 9 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, A conspiracy<sup>H7195</sup> is found<sup>H4672</sup> among the men<sup>H376</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and among the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>. 10 They are turned back<sup>H7725</sup> to the iniquities<sup>H5771</sup> of their forefathers<sup>H7223</sup> H1, which refused<sup>H3985</sup> to hear<sup>H8085</sup> my words<sup>H1697</sup>; and they went<sup>H1980</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> other<sup>H312</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup> to serve<sup>H5647</sup> them: the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> have broken<sup>H6565</sup> my covenant<sup>H1285</sup> which I made<sup>H3772</sup> with their fathers<sup>H1</sup>.

11 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, Behold, I will bring<sup>H935</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> upon them, which they shall not be able<sup>H3201</sup> to escape<sup>H3318</sup>; and though they shall cry<sup>H2199</sup> unto me, I will not hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto them.<sup>3</sup> 12 Then shall the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> and inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> go<sup>H1980</sup>, and cry<sup>H2199</sup> unto the gods<sup>H430</sup> unto whom they offer incense<sup>H6999</sup>: but they shall not save<sup>H3467</sup> them at all<sup>H3467</sup> in the time<sup>H6256</sup> of their trouble<sup>H7451</sup>.<sup>4</sup> 13 For according to the number<sup>H4557</sup> of thy cities<sup>H5892</sup> were thy gods<sup>H430</sup>, O Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and according to the number<sup>H4557</sup> of the streets<sup>H2351</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> have ye set up<sup>H7760</sup> altars<sup>H4196</sup> to that shameful thing<sup>H1322</sup>, even altars<sup>H4196</sup> to burn incense<sup>H6999</sup> unto Baal<sup>H1168</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 14 Therefore pray<sup>H6419</sup> not thou for this people<sup>H5971</sup>, neither lift up<sup>H5375</sup> a cry<sup>H7440</sup> or prayer<sup>H8605</sup> for them: for I will not hear<sup>H8085</sup> them in the time<sup>H6256</sup> that they cry<sup>H7121</sup> unto me for their trouble<sup>H7451</sup>.<sup>6</sup> 15 What hath my beloved<sup>H3039</sup> to do in mine house<sup>H1004</sup>, seeing she hath wrought<sup>H6213</sup> lewdness<sup>H4209</sup> with many<sup>H7227</sup>, and the holy<sup>H6944</sup> flesh<sup>H1320</sup> is passed<sup>H5674</sup> from thee? when thou doest evil<sup>H7451</sup>, then thou rejoicest<sup>H5937</sup>.<sup>7 8</sup> 16 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> called<sup>H7121</sup> thy name<sup>H8034</sup>, A green<sup>H7488</sup> olive tree<sup>H2132</sup>, fair<sup>H3303</sup>, and of goodly<sup>H8389</sup> fruit<sup>H6529</sup>: with the noise<sup>H6963</sup> of a great<sup>H1419</sup> tumult<sup>H1999</sup> he hath kindled<sup>H3341</sup> fire<sup>H784</sup> upon it, and the branches<sup>H1808</sup> of it are broken<sup>H7489</sup>. 17 For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, that planted<sup>H5193</sup> thee, hath pronounced<sup>H1696</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> against thee, for<sup>H1558</sup> the evil<sup>H7451</sup> of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> and of the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, which they have done<sup>H6213</sup> against themselves to provoke me to anger<sup>H3707</sup> in offering incense<sup>H6999</sup> unto Baal<sup>H1168</sup>.

18 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath given me knowledge<sup>H3045</sup> of it, and I know<sup>H3045</sup> it: then thou shewedst<sup>H7200</sup> me their doings<sup>H4611</sup>. 19 But I was like a lamb<sup>H3532</sup> or an ox<sup>H441</sup> that is brought<sup>H2986</sup> to the slaughter<sup>H2873</sup>; and I knew<sup>H3045</sup> not that they had devised<sup>H2803</sup> devices<sup>H4284</sup> against me, saying, Let us destroy<sup>H7843</sup> the tree<sup>H6086</sup> with the fruit<sup>H3899</sup> thereof, and let us cut him off<sup>H3772</sup> from the land<sup>H776</sup> of the living<sup>H2416</sup>, that his name<sup>H8034</sup> may be no more remembered<sup>H2142</sup>.<sup>9</sup> 20 But, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, that judgest<sup>H8199</sup> righteously<sup>H6664</sup>, that triest<sup>H974</sup> the reins<sup>H3629</sup> and the heart<sup>H3820</sup>, let me see<sup>H7200</sup> thy vengeance<sup>H5360</sup> on them: for unto thee have I revealed<sup>H1540</sup> my cause<sup>H7379</sup>. 21 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the

LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of the men<sup>H582</sup> of Anathoth<sup>H6068</sup>, that seek<sup>H1245</sup> thy life<sup>H5315</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Prophecy<sup>H5012</sup> not in the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that thou die<sup>H4191</sup> not by our hand<sup>H3027</sup>: **22** Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, Behold, I will punish<sup>H6485</sup> them: the young men<sup>H970</sup> shall die<sup>H4191</sup> by the sword<sup>H2719</sup>; their sons<sup>H1121</sup> and their daughters<sup>H1323</sup> shall die<sup>H4191</sup> by famine<sup>H7458,10</sup>: **23** And there shall be no remnant<sup>H7611</sup> of them: for I will bring<sup>H935</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> upon the men<sup>H582</sup> of Anathoth<sup>H6068</sup>, even the year<sup>H8141</sup> of their visitation<sup>H6486</sup>.
