## Jeremiah 14

**1** The word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> that came to Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> concerning<sup>H1697</sup> the dearth<sup>H1226.1</sup> **2** Judah<sup>H3063</sup> mourneth<sup>H56</sup>, and the gates<sup>H8179</sup> thereof languish<sup>H535</sup>; they are black<sup>H6937</sup> unto the ground<sup>H776</sup>; and the cry<sup>H6682</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> is gone up<sup>H5927</sup>. **3** And their nobles<sup>H117</sup> have sent<sup>H7971</sup> their little ones<sup>H6810</sup> to the waters<sup>H4325</sup>: they came<sup>H935</sup> to the pits<sup>H1356</sup> H1<sup>360</sup>, and found<sup>H4672</sup> no water<sup>H4325</sup>; they returned<sup>H7725</sup> with their vessels<sup>H3627</sup> empty<sup>H7387</sup>; they were ashamed<sup>H954</sup> and confounded<sup>H3637</sup>, and covered<sup>H2645</sup> their heads<sup>H7218</sup>. **4** Because the ground<sup>H127</sup> is chapt<sup>H2865</sup>, for there was no rain<sup>H1653</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup>, the plowmen<sup>H406</sup> were ashamed<sup>H954</sup>, they covered<sup>H2645</sup> their heads<sup>H7218</sup>. **5** Yea, the hind<sup>H365</sup> also calved<sup>H3205</sup> in the field<sup>H7704</sup>, and forsook<sup>H5800</sup> it, because there was no grass<sup>H1877</sup>. **6** And the wild asses<sup>H6501</sup> did stand<sup>H5975</sup> in the high places<sup>H8205</sup>, they snuffed up<sup>H7602</sup> the wind<sup>H7307</sup> like dragons<sup>H8577</sup>; their eyes<sup>H5869</sup> did fail<sup>H3615</sup>, because there was no grass<sup>H6212</sup>. **7** O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, though our iniquities<sup>H5771</sup> testify<sup>H6030</sup> against us, do<sup>H6213</sup> thou it for thy name's<sup>H8034</sup> sake: for our backslidings<sup>H4878</sup> are many<sup>H7231</sup>; we have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against thee. **8** O the hope<sup>H4723</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, the saviour<sup>H3467</sup> thereof in time<sup>H6266</sup> of trouble<sup>H6869</sup>, why shouldest thou be as a stranger<sup>H1616</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup>, and as a wayfaring man<sup>H326</sup> that cannot<sup>H3201</sup> save<sup>H3467</sup>? yet thou, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, art in the midst<sup>H7130</sup> of us, and we are called<sup>H7121</sup> by thy name<sup>H8034</sup>; leave<sup>H3240</sup> us not.<sup>2</sup>

10 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> unto this people<sup>H5971</sup>, Thus have they loved<sup>H157</sup> to wander<sup>H5128</sup>, they have not refrained<sup>H2820</sup> their feet<sup>H7272</sup>, therefore the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> doth not accept<sup>H7521</sup> them; he will now remember<sup>H2142</sup> their iniquity<sup>H5771</sup>, and visit<sup>H6485</sup> their sins<sup>H2403</sup>. **11** Then said<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> unto me, Pray<sup>H6419</sup> not for this people<sup>H5971</sup> for their good<sup>H2896</sup>. **12** When they fast<sup>H6684</sup>, I will not hear<sup>H8085</sup> their cry<sup>H7440</sup>; and when they offer<sup>H5927</sup> burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup> and an oblation<sup>H4503</sup>, I will not accept<sup>H7521</sup> them: but I will consume<sup>H3615</sup> them by the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and by the famine<sup>H7458</sup>, and by the pestilence<sup>H1698</sup>. **13** Then said<sup>H559</sup> I, Ah<sup>H162</sup>, Lord<sup>H136</sup> GOD<sup>H3069</sup>! behold, the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Ye shall not see<sup>H7200</sup> the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, neither shall ye have famine<sup>H7458</sup>; but I will give<sup>H5414</sup> you assured<sup>H571</sup> peace<sup>H7965</sup> in this place<sup>H4725.3</sup> 14 Then the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, The prophets<sup>H5030</sup> prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> lies<sup>H8267</sup> in my name<sup>H8034</sup>: I sent<sup>H7971</sup> them not, neither have I commanded<sup>H6680</sup> them, neither spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto them: they prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> unto you a false<sup>H8267</sup> vision<sup>H2377</sup> and divination<sup>H7081</sup>, and a thing of nought<sup>H457 H434</sup>, and the deceit<sup>H8649</sup> of their heart<sup>H3820</sup>. 15 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> concerning the prophets<sup>H5030</sup> that prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> in my name<sup>H8034</sup>, and I sent<sup>H7971</sup> them not, yet they say<sup>H559</sup>, Sword<sup>H2719</sup> and famine<sup>H7458</sup> shall not be in this land<sup>H776</sup>; By sword<sup>H2719</sup> and famine<sup>H7458</sup> shall those prophets<sup>H5030</sup> be consumed<sup>H8552</sup>. **16** And the people<sup>H5971</sup> to whom they prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> shall be cast out<sup>H7993</sup> in the streets<sup>H2351</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of the famine<sup>H7458</sup> and the sword<sup>H2719</sup>; and they shall have none to bury<sup>H6912</sup> them<sup>H1992</sup>, them, their wives<sup>H802</sup>, nor their sons<sup>H1121</sup>, nor their daughters<sup>H1323</sup>: for I will pour<sup>H8210</sup> their wickedness<sup>H7451</sup> upon them.

**17** Therefore thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> this word<sup>H1697</sup> unto them; Let mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> run down<sup>H3381</sup> with tears<sup>H1832</sup> night<sup>H3915</sup> and day<sup>H3119</sup>, and let them not cease<sup>H1820</sup>: for the virgin<sup>H1330</sup> daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup> is broken<sup>H7665</sup> with a great<sup>H1419</sup> breach<sup>H7667</sup>, with a very<sup>H3966</sup> grievous<sup>H2470</sup> blow<sup>H4347</sup>. **18** If I go forth<sup>H3318</sup> into the field<sup>H7704</sup>, then behold the slain<sup>H2491</sup> with the sword<sup>H2719</sup>! and if I enter<sup>H935</sup> into the city<sup>H5892</sup>, then behold them that are sick<sup>H8463</sup> with famine<sup>H7458</sup>! yea, both the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> go about<sup>H5503</sup> into a land<sup>H776</sup> that they know<sup>H3045</sup> not.<sup>4</sup> **19** Hast thou utterly<sup>H3988</sup> rejected<sup>H3988</sup> Judah<sup>H3063</sup>? hath thy soul<sup>H5315</sup> lothed<sup>H1602</sup> Zion<sup>H6726</sup>? why hast thou smitten<sup>H5221</sup> us, and there is no healing<sup>H4832</sup> for us? we looked<sup>H6960</sup> for peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and there is no good<sup>H2896</sup>; and for the time<sup>H6256</sup> of healing<sup>H4832</sup>, and behold trouble<sup>H1205</sup>! **20** We acknowledge<sup>H3045</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, our wickedness<sup>H7562</sup>, and the iniquity<sup>H5771</sup> of our fathers<sup>H1</sup>: for we have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against thee. **21** Do not abhor<sup>H5006</sup> us, for thy name's<sup>H8034</sup> sake, do not disgrace<sup>H5034</sup> the throne<sup>H3678</sup> of thy glory<sup>H3519</sup>: remember<sup>H2142</sup>, break<sup>H6565</sup> not thy covenant<sup>H1285</sup> with us. **22** Are there<sup>H3426</sup> any among

the vanities<sup>H1892</sup> of the Gentiles<sup>H1471</sup> that can cause rain<sup>H1652</sup>? or can the heavens<sup>H8064</sup> give<sup>H5414</sup> showers<sup>H7241</sup>? art not thou he, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>? therefore we will wait<sup>H6960</sup> upon thee: for thou hast made<sup>H6213</sup> all these things.
