

# Jeremiah 24

1 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shewed<sup>H7200</sup> me, and, behold, two<sup>H8147</sup> baskets<sup>H1736</sup> of figs<sup>H8384</sup> were set<sup>H3259</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the temple<sup>H1964</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, after<sup>H310</sup> that Nebuchadrezzar<sup>H5019</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> had carried away captive<sup>H1540</sup> Jeconiah<sup>H3204</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, with the carpenters<sup>H2796</sup> and smiths<sup>H4525</sup>, from Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and had brought<sup>H935</sup> them to Babylon<sup>H894</sup>. 2 One<sup>H259</sup> basket<sup>H1731</sup> had very<sup>H3966</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup> figs<sup>H8384</sup>, even like the figs<sup>H8384</sup> that are first ripe<sup>H1073</sup>: and the other<sup>H259</sup> basket<sup>H1731</sup> had very<sup>H3966</sup> naughty<sup>H7451</sup> figs<sup>H8384</sup>, which could not be eaten<sup>H398</sup>, they were so bad<sup>H7455</sup>. 1 3 Then said<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> unto me, What seest<sup>H7200</sup> thou, Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup>? And I said<sup>H559</sup>, Figs<sup>H8384</sup>, the good<sup>H2896</sup> figs<sup>H8384</sup>, very<sup>H3966</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup>; and the evil<sup>H7451</sup>, very<sup>H3966</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>, that cannot be eaten<sup>H398</sup>, they are so evil<sup>H7455</sup>. 4 Again the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> came unto me, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 5 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, the God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>; Like these good<sup>H2896</sup> figs<sup>H8384</sup>, so will I acknowledge<sup>H5234</sup> them that are carried away captive<sup>H1546</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, whom I have sent<sup>H7971</sup> out of this place<sup>H4725</sup> into the land<sup>H776</sup> of the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup> for their good<sup>H2896</sup>. 2 6 For I will set<sup>H7760</sup> mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> upon them for good<sup>H2896</sup>, and I will bring them again<sup>H7725</sup> to this land<sup>H776</sup>: and I will build<sup>H1129</sup> them, and not pull them down<sup>H2040</sup>; and I will plant<sup>H5193</sup> them, and not pluck them up<sup>H5428</sup>. 7 And I will give<sup>H5414</sup> them an heart<sup>H3820</sup> to know<sup>H3045</sup> me, that I am the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: and they shall be my people<sup>H5971</sup>, and I will be their God<sup>H430</sup>: for they shall return<sup>H7725</sup> unto me with their whole heart<sup>H3820</sup>. 8 And as the evil<sup>H7451</sup> figs<sup>H8384</sup>, which cannot be eaten<sup>H398</sup>, they are so evil<sup>H7455</sup>; surely thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, So will I give<sup>H5414</sup> Zedekiah<sup>H6667</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and his princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and the residue<sup>H7611</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, that remain<sup>H7604</sup> in this land<sup>H776</sup>, and them that dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>. 9 And I will deliver<sup>H5414</sup> them to be removed<sup>H2189 H2113</sup> into all the kingdoms<sup>H4467</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> for their hurt<sup>H7451</sup>, to be a reproach<sup>H2781</sup> and a proverb<sup>H4912</sup>, a taunt<sup>H8148</sup> and a curse<sup>H7045</sup>, in all places<sup>H4725</sup> whither I shall drive<sup>H5080</sup> them. 3 10 And I will send<sup>H7971</sup> the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, the famine<sup>H7458</sup>, and the pestilence<sup>H1698</sup>, among them, till they be consumed<sup>H8552</sup> from off the land<sup>H127</sup> that I gave<sup>H5414</sup> unto them and to their fathers<sup>H1</sup>.
