

# Jeremiah 25

1 The word<sup>H1697</sup> that came to Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> concerning all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup> in the fourth<sup>H7243</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Jehoiakim<sup>H3079</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Josiah<sup>H2977</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, that was the first<sup>H7224</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Nebuchadrezzar<sup>H5019</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>; 2 The which Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto all the people<sup>H5971</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and to all the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 3 From the thirteenth<sup>H7969</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> of Josiah<sup>H2977</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Amon<sup>H526</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, even unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>, that is the three<sup>H7969</sup> and twentieth<sup>H6242</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup>, the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath come unto me, and I have spoken<sup>H1696</sup> unto you, rising early<sup>H7925</sup> and speaking<sup>H1696</sup>, but ye have not hearkened<sup>H8085</sup>. 4 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath sent<sup>H7971</sup> unto you all his servants<sup>H5650</sup> the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, rising early<sup>H7925</sup> and sending<sup>H7971</sup> them; but ye have not hearkened<sup>H8085</sup>, nor inclined<sup>H5186</sup> your ear<sup>H241</sup> to hear<sup>H8085</sup>. 5 They said<sup>H559</sup>, Turn ye again<sup>H7725</sup> now every one<sup>H376</sup> from his evil<sup>H7451</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>, and from the evil<sup>H7455</sup> of your doings<sup>H4611</sup>, and dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in the land<sup>H1127</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath given<sup>H5414</sup> unto you and to your fathers<sup>H1</sup> for<sup>H5704</sup> ever<sup>H5769</sup> and ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 6 And go<sup>H3212</sup> not after<sup>H310</sup> other<sup>H312</sup> gods<sup>H430</sup> to serve<sup>H5647</sup> them, and to worship<sup>H7812</sup> them, and provoke me not to anger<sup>H3707</sup> with the works<sup>H4639</sup> of your hands<sup>H3027</sup>, and I will do you no hurt<sup>H7489</sup>. 7 Yet ye have not hearkened<sup>H8085</sup> unto me, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that ye might provoke me to anger<sup>H3707</sup> with the works<sup>H4639</sup> of your hands<sup>H3027</sup> to your own hurt<sup>H7451</sup>.

8 Therefore thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>; Because ye have not heard<sup>H8085</sup> my words<sup>H1697</sup>, 9 Behold, I will send<sup>H7971</sup> and take<sup>H3947</sup> all the families<sup>H4940</sup> of the north<sup>H6828</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and Nebuchadrezzar<sup>H5019</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, my servant<sup>H5650</sup>, and will bring<sup>H935</sup> them against this land<sup>H776</sup>, and against the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> thereof, and against all these nations<sup>H1471</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup>, and will utterly destroy<sup>H2763</sup> them, and make<sup>H7760</sup> them an astonishment<sup>H8047</sup>, and an hissing<sup>H8322</sup>, and perpetual<sup>H5769</sup> desolations<sup>H2723</sup>. 10 Moreover I will take<sup>H6</sup> from them the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of mirth<sup>H8342</sup>, and the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of gladness<sup>H8057</sup>, the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the bridegroom<sup>H2860</sup>, and the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the bride<sup>H3618</sup>, the sound<sup>H6963</sup> of the millstones<sup>H7347</sup>, and the light<sup>H216</sup> of the candle<sup>H5216</sup>. 11 And this whole land<sup>H776</sup> shall be a desolation<sup>H2723</sup>, and an astonishment<sup>H8047</sup>; and these nations<sup>H1471</sup> shall serve<sup>H5647</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup> seventy<sup>H7657</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup>. 12 And it shall come to pass, when seventy<sup>H7657</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> are accomplished<sup>H4390</sup>, that I will punish<sup>H6485</sup> the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Babylon<sup>H894</sup>, and that nation<sup>H1471</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, for their iniquity<sup>H5771</sup>, and the land<sup>H776</sup> of the Chaldeans<sup>H3778</sup>, and will make<sup>H7760</sup> it perpetual<sup>H5769</sup> desolations<sup>H8077</sup>. 13 And I will bring<sup>H935</sup> upon that land<sup>H776</sup> all my words<sup>H1697</sup> which I have pronounced<sup>H1696</sup> against it, even all that is written<sup>H3789</sup> in this book<sup>H5612</sup>, which Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> hath prophesied<sup>H5012</sup> against all the nations<sup>H1471</sup>. 14 For many<sup>H7227</sup> nations<sup>H1471</sup> and great<sup>H1419</sup> kings<sup>H4428</sup> shall serve<sup>H5647</sup> themselves of them also: and I will recompense<sup>H7999</sup> them according to their deeds<sup>H6467</sup>, and according to the works<sup>H4639</sup> of their own hands<sup>H3027</sup>.

15 For thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> unto me; Take<sup>H3947</sup> the wine<sup>H3196</sup> cup<sup>H3563</sup> of this fury<sup>H2534</sup> at my hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and cause all the nations<sup>H1471</sup>, to whom I send<sup>H7971</sup> thee, to drink<sup>H8248</sup> it. 16 And they shall drink<sup>H8354</sup>, and be moved<sup>H1607</sup>, and be mad<sup>H1984</sup>, because<sup>H6440</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup> that I will send<sup>H7971</sup> among them. 17 Then took<sup>H3947</sup> I the cup<sup>H3563</sup> at the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> hand<sup>H3027</sup>, and made all the nations<sup>H1471</sup> to drink<sup>H8248</sup>, unto whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> had sent<sup>H7971</sup> me: 18 To wit, Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, and the cities<sup>H5892</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and the kings<sup>H4428</sup> thereof, and the princes<sup>H8269</sup> thereof, to make<sup>H5414</sup> them a desolation<sup>H2723</sup>, an astonishment<sup>H8047</sup>, an hissing<sup>H8322</sup>, and a curse<sup>H7045</sup>, as it is this day<sup>H3117</sup>; 19 Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup> king<sup>H4428</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, and his servants<sup>H5650</sup>, and his princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and all his people<sup>H5971</sup>; 20 And all the mingled<sup>H6154</sup> people, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Uz<sup>H5780</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and Ashkelon<sup>H831</sup>, and Azzah<sup>H5804</sup>, and Ekron<sup>H6138</sup>, and the remnant<sup>H7611</sup> of Ashdod<sup>H795</sup>, 21 Edom<sup>H123</sup>, and Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, and the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Ammon<sup>H5983</sup>, 22 And all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Tyrus<sup>H6865</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Zidon<sup>H6721</sup>, and the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the isles<sup>H339</sup> which are beyond<sup>H5676</sup> the sea<sup>H3220</sup>, 23

Dedan<sup>H1719</sup>, and Tema<sup>H8485</sup>, and Buz<sup>H938</sup>, and all that are in the utmost<sup>H7112</sup> corners<sup>H6285 4</sup>, **24** And all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Arabia<sup>H6152</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the mingled people<sup>H6154</sup> that dwell<sup>H7931</sup> in the desert<sup>H4057</sup>, **25** And all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Zimri<sup>H2174</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Elam<sup>H5867</sup>, and all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the Medes<sup>H4074</sup>, **26** And all the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the north<sup>H6828</sup>, far<sup>H7350</sup> and near<sup>H7138</sup>, one<sup>H376</sup> with another<sup>H251</sup>, and all the kingdoms<sup>H4467</sup> of the world<sup>H776</sup>, which are upon the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>: and the king<sup>H4428</sup> of Sheshach<sup>H8347</sup> shall drink<sup>H8354</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> them. **27** Therefore thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, the God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, Drink<sup>H8354</sup> ye, and be drunken<sup>H7937</sup>, and spue<sup>H7006</sup>, and fall<sup>H5307</sup>, and rise<sup>H6965</sup> no more, because<sup>H6440</sup> of the sword<sup>H2719</sup> which I will send<sup>H7971</sup> among you. **28** And it shall be, if they refuse<sup>H3985</sup> to take<sup>H3947</sup> the cup<sup>H3563</sup> at thine hand<sup>H3027</sup> to drink<sup>H8354</sup>, then shalt thou say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>; Ye shall certainly<sup>H8354</sup> drink<sup>H8354</sup>. **29** For, lo, I begin<sup>H2490</sup> to bring evil<sup>H7489</sup> on the city<sup>H5892</sup> which is called<sup>H7121</sup> by my name<sup>H8034</sup>, and should ye be utterly<sup>H5352</sup> unpunished<sup>H5352</sup>? Ye shall not be unpunished<sup>H5352</sup>: for I will call<sup>H7121</sup> for a sword<sup>H2719</sup> upon all the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635 5</sup>.

**30** Therefore prophesy<sup>H5012</sup> thou against them all these words<sup>H1697</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall roar<sup>H7580</sup> from on high<sup>H4791</sup>, and utter<sup>H5414</sup> his voice<sup>H6963</sup> from his holy<sup>H6944</sup> habitation<sup>H4583</sup>; he shall mightily<sup>H7580</sup> roar<sup>H7580</sup> upon his habitation<sup>H5116</sup>; he shall give<sup>H6030</sup> a shout<sup>H1959</sup>, as they that tread<sup>H1869</sup> the grapes, against all the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. **31** A noise<sup>H7588</sup> shall come<sup>H935</sup> even to the ends<sup>H7097</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>; for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath a controversy<sup>H7379</sup> with the nations<sup>H1471</sup>, he will plead<sup>H8199</sup> with all flesh<sup>H1320</sup>; he will give<sup>H5414</sup> them that are wicked<sup>H7563</sup> to the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **32** Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, Behold, evil<sup>H7451</sup> shall go forth<sup>H3318</sup> from nation<sup>H1471</sup> to nation<sup>H1471</sup>, and a great<sup>H1419</sup> whirlwind<sup>H5591</sup> shall be raised up<sup>H5782</sup> from the coasts<sup>H3411</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. **33** And the slain<sup>H2491</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall be at that day<sup>H3117</sup> from one end<sup>H7097</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> even unto the other end<sup>H7097</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>: they shall not be lamented<sup>H5594</sup>, neither gathered<sup>H622</sup>, nor buried<sup>H6912</sup>; they shall be dung<sup>H1828</sup> upon<sup>H6440</sup> the ground<sup>H127</sup>. **34** Howl<sup>H3213</sup>, ye shepherds<sup>H7462</sup>, and cry<sup>H2199</sup>; and wallow<sup>H6428</sup> yourselves in the ashes, ye principal<sup>H117</sup> of the flock<sup>H6629</sup>: for the days<sup>H3117</sup> of your slaughter<sup>H2873</sup> and of your dispersions<sup>H8600</sup> are accomplished<sup>H4390</sup>; and ye shall fall<sup>H5307</sup> like a pleasant<sup>H2532</sup> vessel<sup>H3627 67</sup>. **35** And the shepherds<sup>H7462</sup> shall have no way<sup>H4498</sup> to flee<sup>H6</sup>, nor the principal<sup>H117</sup> of the flock<sup>H6629</sup> to escape<sup>H6413 8</sup>. **36** A voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the cry<sup>H6818</sup> of the shepherds<sup>H7462</sup>, and an howling<sup>H3215</sup> of the principal<sup>H117</sup> of the flock<sup>H6629</sup>, shall be heard: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath spoiled<sup>H7703</sup> their pasture<sup>H4830</sup>. **37** And the peaceable<sup>H7965</sup> habitations<sup>H4999</sup> are cut down<sup>H1826</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of the fierce<sup>H2740</sup> anger<sup>H639</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **38** He hath forsaken<sup>H5800</sup> his covert<sup>H5520</sup>, as the lion<sup>H3715</sup>: for their land<sup>H776</sup> is desolate<sup>H8047</sup> because<sup>H6440</sup> of the fierceness<sup>H2740</sup> of the oppressor<sup>H3238</sup>, and because<sup>H6440</sup> of his fierce<sup>H2740</sup> anger<sup>H639 9</sup>.
