

# Jeremiah 47

1 The word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> that came to Jeremiah<sup>H3414</sup> the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> against the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, before that Pharaoh<sup>H6547</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> Gaza<sup>H5804</sup>. 2 Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; Behold, waters<sup>H4325</sup> rise up<sup>H5927</sup> out of the north<sup>H6828</sup>, and shall be an overflowing<sup>H7857</sup> flood<sup>H5158</sup>, and shall overflow<sup>H7857</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>, and all that is therein<sup>H4393</sup>, the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and them that dwell<sup>H3427</sup> therein: then the men<sup>H120</sup> shall cry<sup>H2199</sup>, and all the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> shall howl<sup>H3213</sup>. 3 At the noise<sup>H6963</sup> of the stamping<sup>H8161</sup> of the hoofs<sup>H6541</sup> of his strong<sup>H47</sup> horses, at the rushing<sup>H7494</sup> of his chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and at the rumbling<sup>H1995</sup> of his wheels<sup>H1534</sup>, the fathers<sup>H1</sup> shall not look back<sup>H6437</sup> to their children<sup>H1121</sup> for feebleness<sup>H7510</sup> of hands<sup>H3027</sup>; 4 Because of the day<sup>H3117</sup> that cometh<sup>H935</sup> to spoil<sup>H7703</sup> all the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, and to cut off<sup>H3772</sup> from Tyrus<sup>H6865</sup> and Zidon<sup>H6721</sup> every helper<sup>H5826</sup> that remaineth<sup>H8300</sup>: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will spoil<sup>H7703</sup> the Philistines<sup>H6430</sup>, the remnant<sup>H7611</sup> of the country<sup>H339</sup> of Caphtor<sup>H3731</sup>. 5 Baldness<sup>H7144</sup> is come<sup>H935</sup> upon Gaza<sup>H5804</sup>, Ashkelon<sup>H831</sup> is cut off<sup>H1820</sup> with the remnant<sup>H7611</sup> of their valley<sup>H6010</sup>: how long wilt thou cut<sup>H1413</sup> thyself? 6 O<sup>H1945</sup> thou sword<sup>H2719</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, how long will it be ere<sup>H3808</sup> thou be quiet<sup>H8252</sup>? put up<sup>H622</sup> thyself into thy scabbard<sup>H8593</sup>, rest<sup>H7280</sup>, and be still<sup>H1826</sup>. 7 How can it be quiet<sup>H8252</sup>, seeing the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath given it a charge<sup>H6680</sup> against Ashkelon<sup>H831</sup>, and against the sea<sup>H3220</sup> shore<sup>H2348</sup>? there hath he appointed<sup>H3259</sup> it.<sup>5</sup>
