

# Jeremiah 8

1 At that time<sup>H6256</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, they shall bring out<sup>H3318</sup> the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>, and the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of his princes<sup>H8269</sup>, and the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of the priests<sup>H3548</sup>, and the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of the prophets<sup>H5030</sup>, and the bones<sup>H6106</sup> of the inhabitants<sup>H3427</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup>, out of their graves<sup>H6913</sup>: 2 And they shall spread<sup>H7849</sup> them before the sun<sup>H8121</sup>, and the moon<sup>H3394</sup>, and all the host<sup>H6635</sup> of heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, whom they have loved<sup>H157</sup>, and whom they have served<sup>H5647</sup>, and after<sup>H310</sup> whom they have walked<sup>H1980</sup>, and whom they have sought<sup>H1875</sup>, and whom they have worshipped<sup>H7812</sup>: they shall not be gathered<sup>H622</sup>, nor be buried<sup>H6912</sup>, they shall be for dung<sup>H1828</sup> upon the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the earth<sup>H127</sup>. 3 And death<sup>H4194</sup> shall be chosen<sup>H977</sup> rather than life<sup>H2416</sup> by all the residue<sup>H7611</sup> of them that remain<sup>H7604</sup> of this evil<sup>H7451</sup> family<sup>H4940</sup>, which remain<sup>H7604</sup> in all the places<sup>H4725</sup> whither I have driven<sup>H5080</sup> them, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>.

4 Moreover thou shalt say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; Shall they fall<sup>H5307</sup>, and not arise<sup>H6965</sup>? shall he turn away<sup>H7725</sup>, and not return<sup>H7725</sup>? 5 Why then is this people<sup>H5971</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>H3389</sup> slidden back<sup>H7725</sup> by a perpetual<sup>H5329</sup> backsliding<sup>H4878</sup>? they hold<sup>H2388</sup> fast deceit<sup>H8649</sup>, they refuse<sup>H3985</sup> to return<sup>H7725</sup>. 6 I hearkened<sup>H7181</sup> and heard<sup>H8085</sup>, but they spake not aright<sup>H1696</sup>: no man<sup>H376</sup> repented<sup>H5162</sup> him of<sup>H5921</sup> his wickedness<sup>H7451</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, What have I done<sup>H6213</sup>? every one turned<sup>H7725</sup> to his course<sup>H4794</sup>, as the horse<sup>H5483</sup> rusheth<sup>H7857</sup> into the battle<sup>H4421</sup>. 7 Yea, the stork<sup>H2624</sup> in the heaven<sup>H8064</sup> knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> her appointed times<sup>H4150</sup>; and the turtle<sup>H8449</sup> and the crane<sup>H5483</sup> and the swallow<sup>H5693</sup> observe<sup>H8104</sup> the time<sup>H6256</sup> of their coming<sup>H935</sup>, but my people<sup>H5971</sup> know<sup>H3045</sup> not the judgment<sup>H4941</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 8 How do ye say<sup>H559</sup>, We are wise<sup>H2450</sup>, and the law<sup>H8451</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is with us? Lo, certainly<sup>H403</sup> in vain<sup>H8267</sup> made<sup>H6213</sup> he it; the pen<sup>H5842</sup> of the scribes<sup>H5608</sup> is in vain<sup>H8267</sup>. 9 The wise<sup>H2450</sup> men are ashamed<sup>H3001</sup>, they are dismayed<sup>H2865</sup> and taken<sup>H3920</sup>: lo, they have rejected<sup>H3988</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>; and what wisdom<sup>H2451</sup> is in them?<sup>23</sup> 10 Therefore will I give<sup>H5414</sup> their wives<sup>H802</sup> unto others<sup>H312</sup>, and their fields<sup>H7704</sup> to them that shall inherit<sup>H3423</sup> them: for every one from the least<sup>H6996</sup> even unto the greatest<sup>H1419</sup> is given<sup>H1214</sup> to covetousness<sup>H1215</sup>, from the prophet<sup>H5030</sup> even unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup> every one dealeth<sup>H6213</sup> falsely<sup>H8267</sup>. 11 For they have healed<sup>H7495</sup> the hurt<sup>H7667</sup> of the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup> slightly<sup>H7043</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Peace<sup>H7965</sup>, peace<sup>H7965</sup>; when there is no peace<sup>H7965</sup>. 12 Were they ashamed<sup>H3001</sup> when they had committed<sup>H6213</sup> abomination<sup>H8441</sup>? nay, they were not at all<sup>H954</sup> ashamed<sup>H954</sup>, neither could<sup>H3045</sup> they blush<sup>H3637</sup>: therefore shall they fall<sup>H5307</sup> among them that fall<sup>H5307</sup>: in the time<sup>H6256</sup> of their visitation<sup>H6486</sup> they shall be cast down<sup>H3782</sup>, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.

13 I will surely<sup>H622</sup> consume<sup>H5486</sup> them, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: there shall be no grapes<sup>H6025</sup> on the vine<sup>H1612</sup>, nor figs<sup>H8384</sup> on the fig tree<sup>H8384</sup>, and the leaf<sup>H5929</sup> shall fade<sup>H5034</sup>; and the things that I have given<sup>H5414</sup> them shall pass away<sup>H5674</sup> from them.<sup>4</sup> 14 Why do we sit still<sup>H3427</sup>? assemble<sup>H622</sup> yourselves, and let us enter<sup>H935</sup> into the defenced<sup>H4013</sup> cities<sup>H5892</sup>, and let us be silent<sup>H1826</sup> there: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup> hath put us to silence<sup>H1826</sup>, and given us water<sup>H4325</sup> of gall<sup>H7219</sup> to drink<sup>H8248</sup>, because we have sinned<sup>H2398</sup> against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 15 We looked<sup>H6960</sup> for peace<sup>H7965</sup>, but no good<sup>H2896</sup> came; and for a time<sup>H6256</sup> of health<sup>H4832</sup>, and behold trouble<sup>H1205</sup>! 16 The snorting<sup>H5170</sup> of his horses<sup>H5483</sup> was heard<sup>H8085</sup> from Dan<sup>H1835</sup>: the whole land<sup>H776</sup> trembled<sup>H7493</sup> at the sound<sup>H6963</sup> of the neighing<sup>H4684</sup> of his strong ones<sup>H47</sup>; for they are come<sup>H935</sup>, and have devoured<sup>H398</sup> the land<sup>H776</sup>, and all<sup>H4393</sup> that is in it; the city<sup>H5892</sup>, and those that dwell<sup>H3427</sup> therein.<sup>6</sup> 17 For, behold, I will send<sup>H7971</sup> serpents<sup>H5175</sup>, cockatrices<sup>H6848</sup>, among you, which will not be charmed<sup>H3908</sup>, and they shall bite<sup>H5391</sup> you, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 18 When I would comfort<sup>H4010</sup> myself against sorrow<sup>H3015</sup>, my heart<sup>H3820</sup> is faint<sup>H1742</sup> in me.<sup>7</sup> 19 Behold the voice<sup>H6963</sup> of the cry<sup>H7775</sup> of the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup> because of them that dwell in a far<sup>H4801</sup> country<sup>H776</sup>: Is not the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in Zion<sup>H6726</sup>? is not her king<sup>H4428</sup> in her? Why have they provoked me to anger<sup>H3707</sup> with their graven images<sup>H6456</sup>, and with strange<sup>H5236</sup> vanities<sup>H1892</sup>?<sup>8</sup> 20 The harvest<sup>H7105</sup> is past<sup>H5674</sup>, the summer<sup>H7019</sup> is ended<sup>H3615</sup>, and we are not saved<sup>H3467</sup>. 21 For the hurt<sup>H7667</sup> of the

daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup> am I hurt<sup>H7665</sup>; I am black<sup>H6937</sup>; astonishment<sup>H8047</sup> hath taken hold<sup>H2388</sup> on me. **22** Is there no balm<sup>H6875</sup> in Gilead<sup>H1568</sup>; is there no physician<sup>H7495</sup> there? why then<sup>H3588</sup> is not the health<sup>H724</sup> of the daughter<sup>H1323</sup> of my people<sup>H5971</sup> recovered<sup>H5927</sup>?<sup>9</sup>
